TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue up a six-game set with the Harrisburg Senators, Altoona is 13-9 against the Senators this year.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona rallied for a third straight win over Harrisburg with a 6-5 win on Friday night. **Andres Alvarez** swatted his 19th homer of the season and **Blake Sabol** gave the Curve the lead for good with an RBI triple in the seventh.

WE WALKIN' (OFF): **Malcom Nuñez's** walk-off homer on Thursday, August 18 marked the first time since May 30-31, 2018 that the Curve won back-to-back games on a walk-off. Altoona's seventh walk-off of the season is the most since 2016 (7) and three shy of the all-time mark of 10 set in 2005. The last walk-off home run for Altoona was exactly one year to the date, when **Daniel Amaral** hit a two-run shot in the ninth to defeat Somerset on August 18, 2021.

NICKY G IS BACK: Infielder **Nick Gonzales** picked up a season-high 4 hits including a walk-off double in the 10th inning of Altoona's 3-2 win over Harrisburg on Wednesday, August 17. After missing 10 weeks of the season with a right foot injury, Gonzales has picked up right where he left off at the plate batting .350/.458/.500 (7-for-20) with 3 2B, 1 RBI, 2 BB and 1-3 SB in 5 games since his return.

BOMBS AWAY: **Jared Triolo** has hit 3 lead-off homers in the last 9 days (8/10, 8/14 and 8/18) becoming just the 2nd player in franchise history to hit 3 lead-off homers in a career. **Alen Hanson** hit a franchise-best 4 lead-off homers in 2014. The Curve have now hit 6 lead-off home runs this season setting the franchise record.

SHACK ATTACK: **Aaron Shackelford** homered in four consecutive games for the Curve from August 7-12, all of which were two-run shots. Altoona's franchise record for consecutive games with a home run stands at 6 when **Brad Eldred** homered in each game from 4/26-5/2 in 2005. With his 22 homers on the season, Shackelford is the 10th player in franchise history to homer 20 times in a season, **Mason Martin** hit 22 homers in 2021 for the Curve. Martin was also the most recent Curve batter to homer in 4 straight games when he did so from 7/3-6 in 2021. **Shackelford is tied for 1st among Pirates MiLB with 23 HR (Matt Gorski) and ranks 2nd in the Eastern League with 23 Extra-Base Hits in the Second Half of the Season.**

IMMACULATE AGAIN: Right-hander **Luis Ortiz** fired the fourth immaculate inning in franchise history on Tuesday, August 9 in Altoona's 6-0 win over Binghamton. Ortiz became the first pitcher in franchise history to throw two immaculate innings. With his 13 strikeouts across two starts at Binghamton, Ortiz now has 108 strikeouts on the season; becoming the first Curve pitcher with 100 strikeouts in a season since **Taylor Hearn** in 2018. Should he stay on turn in the rotation, he would have 6 more starts in the regular season; giving him a solid chance to set the team's franchise record for strikeouts in a season (**Ian Snell**, 2004: 142). He would need to average 6 strikeouts per start the rest of the way to lock down the mark.

ENDY'S TIME: Prior to Altoona's series with Binghamton, the Pirates promoted the No. 5 prospect in the system according to MLB.com, **C Endy Rodriguez**. Named the South Atlantic League's Player of the Month in July after he batted .373/.489/.773 with 6 2B, 8 HR, and 21 RBI in 21 G, Rodriguez ranked highly in several categories in the South Atlantic League at the time of promotion: 7th in BA (.302), 8th in HR (16), 5th in OBP (.392), 2nd in SLG% (.544), 2nd in OPS (.936), 4th in H (96), T-2nd in 2B (23), T-2nd in XBH (42), 3rd in R (63). Rodriguez has picked up at least one hit in each of his first 8 games with the Curve, including multi-hit games in three of his last four games.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 142 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 28 games to play. Altoona has 3 players, **Jared Triolo** (23), **Liover Peguero** (22) and **Andres Alvarez** (20), with 20 stolen bases for the second time in franchise history: first since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

THE MEN FROM THE SENATE: Managed by Tripp Kiester, Harrisburg recently received a some reinforcements via trades at the deadline with the additions of OF Trey Harris (Ehrie Adrianza/Altanta) and OF Robert Hassell III (Juan Soto/San Diego). With other younger prospects like INF Darren Baker, OF Yasel Antuna and C Isreal Pineda; Harrisburg features a more balanced roster from the veteran-filled one that has played against Altoona 18 times already this year.

THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER: Ronald Herrera makes his fifth start of the season against Altoona, he's 2-2 with a 5.40 ERA (12 ER / 20.0 IP) against the Curve. Herrera previously starred for the Trenton Thunder (New York Yankees) in 2016 and 2017 where he was twice named EL Pitcher of the Week including in May of 2016 after he threw the first 8.0 innings of a combined no-hitter with Jonathan Holder against New Hampshire. Herrera was originally an Oakland A's farmhand in 2012, and has been traded three times in his career. The Yankees acquired him from the Padres for INF Jose Pirela in 2015. Herrera made two appearances in the big leagues with the Yankees going 0-1 with a 6.00 ERA (3 ER / 2.0 IP) in 2017.

2022: Began the season as a member of the Curve rotation... Struck out a season-high 8 batters on 5/10 vs. Somerset... Became the first Curve starter to finish 6.0 innings on 5/21 vs. Richmond in the team's 38th game... Was suspended for 4 games on 5/25 stemming from Altoona's on-field disagreement with Richmond on 5/22, activated to start on 5/29 at Harrisburg... Brought a perfect game into the 5th inning on 6/4 vs. Bowie before allowing an infield single to Adam Hall, allowed back-to-back walks and an RBI double to Cesar Pireto to finish the outing... Allowed 2 HR in an outing for the first time in his career on 6/10 at Reading... Threw the 3rd Immaculate inning in franchise history on 7/15 vs Richmond in the 2nd inning (Oddo Nunez, 9/4/21 and Jeff Bennett (6/7/03)... Became the first starter to work into the 8th inning on 8/3 vs Akron, allowed 1B and 2R HR to finish his outing... Allowed 2 HR in 3 straight starts (7/22-8/3)... Tossed the 4th immaculate inning in franchise history on 8/9 at Binghamton, first to ever do it twice... Became the first Curve pitcher to strike out 100 batters in a season since Taylor Hearn in 2018... Should he stay on turn in the rotation, he would have 6 more starts in the regular season; giving him a solid chance to set the team's franchise record for strikeouts in a season (Ian Snell, 2004: 142)...

2021: Spent the entire season in the rotation for Low-A Bradenton and helped lead them to the Low-A East Championship... Went 5-3 with a 3.09 ERA in 22 appearances, 19 starts... Finished the season ranked second in the Low-A Southeast and among Pirates minor leaguers with 113 strikeouts... Bradenton's pitchers set their franchise record with 1,288 strikeouts, the ninth-most in all of minor league baseball... Started on Opening Day for the Marauders and struck out five in 3.0 innings allowing just one run... Struck out seven batters in 4.0 innings in his second start of the season on May 11 at Dunedin... Finished the month of May with a 1.42 ERA (2 ER / 12.2 IP) and struck out 16
