TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game series with Bowie, a series that has massive postseason implications.

LAST TIME OUT: Bowie took a third straight win by winning a pitcher's duel, 4-1, on Friday night. Luis Ortiz struck out 10 in the defeat and Malcom Nuñez smashed a solo homer, his fourth with the Curve.

BIG TREE HIT BALL HARD: Infielder Jared Triolo is playing some of his best baseball on both sides of the ball as the season moves into late-August. Triolo is amid a 14-game on-base streak (8/9 - Present) in which he's batting: .351/.415/.649/1.064 with 3 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 6 RBI and 3-3 SB. Triolo scored a run in 8 straight games (8/14 - 8/25), the longest active streak in the Eastern League. In his last 52 games (6/21 - Present), Triolo has a .400 on-base percentage with 24 extra base hits. He's reached base safely in 19-of-20 games in August.

K-MAN: Right-hander Luis Ortiz has 126 strikeouts on the season; becoming the first Curve pitcher with 100 strikeouts in a season since Taylor Hearn in 2018. Ortiz struck out 10 Bowie Baysox on Friday, August 26, the first 10+ strikeout performance for the Curve since Roansy Contreras struck out 10 on 6/15/21 at Erie. Should Ortiz stay on turn in the rotation, he would have 4 more starts in the regular season; giving him a solid chance to set the team's franchise record for strikeouts in a season (lan Snell, 2004: 142). He needs just 16 strikeouts to match the record.

NICKY G IS BACK: Infielder Nick Gonzales picked up a season-high 4 hits including a walk-off double in the 10th inning of Altoona's 3-2 win over Harrisburg on Wednesday, August 17. After missing 10 weeks of the season with a right foot injury, Gonzales has reached base safely in each of his first 10 games since his activation batting: .257/.435/.429 (9-for-35) with 3 2B, 1 HR, 4 RBI, 9 BB

BOMBS AWAY: Jared Triolo hit 3 lead-off homers in the span of 9 days (8/10, 8/14 and 8/18) becoming just the 2nd player in franchise history to hit 3 lead-off homers in a career. **Alen Hanson** hit a franchise-best 4 lead-off homers in 2014. The Curve have now hit 6 lead-off home runs this season setting the franchise record.

SHACK ATTACK: Aaron Shackelford homered in four consecutive games for the Curve from August 7-12, all of which were two-run shots. Altoona's franchise record for consecutive games with a home run stands at 6 when Brad Eldred homered in each game from 4/26-5/2 in 2005. With his 24 homers on the season, Shackelford is the 10th player in franchise history to homer 20 times in a season, Mason Martin hit 22 homers in 2021 for the Curve. Martin was also the most recent Curve batter to homer in 4 straight games when he did so from 7/3-6 in 2021. Shackelford is 1st among Pirates MiLB with 24 HR (Matt Gorski) and ranks T-2nd in the Eastern League with 25 Extra-Base Hits in the Second Half of the Season.

ENDY'S TIME: Prior to Altoona's series with Binghamton, the Pirates promoted the No. 5 prospect in the system according to MLB. com, C **Endy Rodriguez**. <u>Rodrigurez picked up at least one hit in each of his first 12 games with the Curve, and drove in 13 runs, a</u> stretch broken on August 26 at Bowie in his 13th game.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 143 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 28 games to play. Altoona has 3 players, Jared Triolo (24), Liover Peguero (22) and Andres Alvarez (20), with 20 stolen bases for the second time in franchise history: first since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

THE MEN FROM THE SENATE: Managed by Kyle Moore, Bowie is right in the thick of the playoff race entering this series. Bowie features several top prospects ranked by MLB.com: OF Colton Cowser (#4), INF Coby Mayo (#7), INF Connor Norby (#12), RHP Chayce McDermott (#14), LHP Cade Povich (#15), INF Joey Ortiz (#19), INF Cesar Prieto (#21), and OF Hudson Haskin (#24).

THE FIRST TO LAY BY THE BAY: Garrett Stallings makes his third start of the season against Altoona on Saturday night. Stallings was drafted in the 5th round in 2019 by the LA Angels and traded along with RHP Jean Pinto for INF Jose Iglesias in December of 2020. A 24-year-old from Chesapeake, VA, Stallings played his college ball at the University of Tennessee after playing his high school ball at Grassfield HS which is about 25 minutes from Western Branch High School where Curve RHP Colin Selby attended high school. Stallings was the 2019 SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year and his older brother, Curtis, played Men's Volleyball at Long Beach State University.

CAREER NOTES

2022 Baseball America No. 29/MLB.com No. 19 Pirates prospect

2022: Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Threw 8.2 scoreless innings to start the season, holding opponents to a .077 batting average against before allowing 6 runs on 6 hits, including 2 HR (4 total) in the second inning of his third start of the season on 4/23 vs. New Hampshire... Threw 5.0 scoreless innings on 4/29 at Akron pitching in front of dozens of family and friends. Canal Park is just 35 minutes from his native Massillon, OH... Threw 14.2 scoreless innings in road games to start the year... His 31 strikeouts in May were tied for 6th-most by an Eastern League Pitcher (Burrows also had 31 K's in May)... Placed on IL on 6/4 (shoulder) and activated on 6/25, was the first time in his life that he's missed a start due to injury... Placed on Temporary Inactive List on 7/1 to be the Best Man in his older brother's wedding, activated on 7/6... Allowed just 2 baserunners in a season-best 6.0 inning outing on 8/10 at Binghamton... Has allowed 2R or fewer in 17-of-20 outings this season...

2021: Made his professional debut splitting the season between High-A Beloit and Double-A Pensacola in the Martins system... Combined to go 6-4 with a 4.18 ERA in 21 appearances, 20 starts... Led all Martins minor leaguers with 136 strikeouts, ranked second in walks with 49, and sixth in the organization with 99.0 innings pitched... Began the season with High-A Beloit and went 2-0 with a 2.79 ERA in four starts in the month of May, struck out 28 batters in 19.1 innings pitched... Struck out a career-high 11 batters in his fourth professional start on May 28 against Peoria, also allowed five hits and walked two in 4.1 innings... Lasted 3.1 innings or shorter in each of his first three starts in the month of June before picked up his third win of the season on June 19 at Peoria, allowing one run on two hits and one walk in 5.0 innings with five strikeouts... Went a career-high 6.0 innings on July 1 vs. Wisconsin and struck out seven, allowed two runs on four hits... Came out of the bullpen on July 13 against Quad Cities following a rehab start by Marlins RHP John Curtiss, picked up nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings... CURVE CUTS: Kyle Todd Nicolas... Attended Jackson High School in Ohio where he led the Polar Bears to a 30-2 record and state Championship as a senior... Was named Prep Baseball Report's Ohio Player of the Year in 2017... First team all-state and Federal League Co-Player of the Year as a senior... Went 8-0 with a 0.50 ERA and 78 strikeouts in 56 innings pitched in 2017. Threw 7.0 innings, struck out seven batters and held Lakota West to one run in the 5-1 state semifinal victory... Also played basketball for three years... Was high school teammates with Tigers prospect Dillon Dingler, they both played baseball and basketball for Jackson High School and won state championships in Baseball and Basketball as seniors... Kyle's father, Todd, coached the basket-ball team... His father played baseball at Youngstown State... Earned his degree from Ball State in Business Administration in three years...
