**Saturday:** After falling behind 2-0 after six, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies scored eight runs over the seventh and eighth and came back to defeat the Reading Fightin Phils 8-3 on Saturday night at FirstEnergy Stadium. Entering the seventh inning trailing 2-0, Carlos Cortes led off the frame with a triple into right field bringing Luke Ritter up to the plate. Ritter then launched a homerun into left field to tie the game at two. In the eighth, the Ponies exploded for six runs. Jake Mangum reached on an infield single and got to second on a throwing error. Cortes singled and Ritter walked which loaded the bases for Brandon McIlwain. McIlwain was hit by a pitch and the Ponies had a 3-2 lead. Hayden Senger worked a walk to increase the lead to 4-2 then the dagger came from Jeremy Vasquez. His bases-clearing double to left centerfield put Binghamton ahead 7-2. Then Nic Gaddis finished the frame with an RBI single of his own.

**Pitching Shines Again:** For the third straight night, the Ponies pitchers were able to keep the Reading bats in check. Starter Garrison Bryant went six innings giving up four hits and two runs with a walk and strikeouts as he endured a battle with Reading starter Andrew Painter. Jesus Vargas pitched the final three innings surrendering two hits and a run with two strikeouts earning his second win of the season.

**Packing a Punch:** Carlos Cortes have been hot as of late with a nine-game hit streak. The left-handed outfielder has five multi-hit games, two homers and seven RBI and a staggering 1.186 OPS during the current stretch. He also has a hit in 12 of his last 13 games and laced his third triple of the season to begin the seventh-inning rally on Saturday.

**Rit & BMac:** The duo of Luke Ritter and Brandon McIlwain has been solid and steady in the series against Reading. Through five games, Ritter has compiled two multi-hit games with six total hits, a home run and seven RBI. McIlwain has tallied a hit in every game so far with one multi-hit performance and an RBI.

**Coming Up:** The Ponies will begin the final series of the AA Subway Series at Mirabito Stadium against Somerset. Tuesday's game is scheduled for 6:35 PM and the Ponies lead the season series 7-5.

**Reid Brignac - Manager - 1st season with Binghamton - 3rd year in the Mets organization.** Brignac comes to Binghamton after serving as the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021. He appeared in parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

**Jerome Williams - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton** - Williams also held the same position on Brignac's staff with St. Lucie and is entering his fourth season in the Mets organization following a 20-year playing career. He pitched for 11 years in the major leagues with the Giants, Angels, Cubs, Cardinals, Rangers, Phillies, Nationals and Astros compiling a 52-66 record with a 4.59 ERA in 236 career games.

**Tommy Joseph - Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization.** Joseph joins Brignac and Williams in being promoted from the same position in St. Lucie to Double-A Binghamton. He is entering his second season with the Mets organization after retiring from his playing career following the 2020 season. He spent two seasons in the major leagues with the Phillies in 2016-17 hitting .247 with 43 home runs and 116 RBI in 249 major league games.

**Mariano Duncan - Bench Coach - 1st season with Binghamton** - arrives in the Southern Tier after serving as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) in 2020. He is entering his fourth year in the Mets organization. The former infielder played 12 major league seasons with the Dodgers, Reds, Phillies, Yankees, and Blue Jays. He was a member of two World Series champions (1990 Cincinnati Reds, 1996 New York Yankees) and was inducted into the Dominican Republic Baseball Hall of Fame in 2008.
