



Advance Ticket Sales

Tickets to future Tides games can be obtained at the Harbor Park Box Office Monday through Friday from 10:00 am - 5:00 pm. Tickets can also be purchased online at norfolktides.com, through Ticketmaster outlets or charge by phone at (800) 745-3000.

Air Horns

The use of an air horn or other artificial noise devices inside Harbor Park is prohibited by local ordinance.

Alcohol Management

Alcoholic beverages may not be brought into or removed from Harbor Park. Commonwealth of Virginia law prohibits the sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under the age of 21. Please note the following policies:

- Patrons will be required to show proper proof of age when purchasing alcoholic beverages at Harbor Park.
- Alcohol will not be served after the 7th inning stretch.
- The Norfolk Tides and Spectra Food Services reserve the right to deny the sale of alcoholic beverages to any patrons.
- Please do not attempt to drive intoxicated. If you need a cab for the drive home, a Tides staff member can call one for you at the Smithfield Foods Information Booth.

Autographs

As of now, players are not permitted to sign autographs for fans per MLB COVID rules and regulations. This is subject to change and any further updates from MLB will be communicated.

Backpacks and Other Bags

For your safety, backpacks, large bags and coolers are prohibited at Harbor Park. Diaper bags and other large purses are subject to search.

Banners and Signs

Fans may bring banners and signs to games. These banners must be in good taste and must not obstruct the view of anyone in the stands. Signs cannot advertise a business or a product, and any signs deemed inappropriate will be removed.

Cameras

Fans are permitted to bring cameras into Harbor Park, provided they do not interfere with other fan's enjoyment or obstruct the flow of traffic in the ballpark. Please note that it is illegal to sell or mass-produce any pictures shot at Harbor Park without the consent of the Norfolk Tides Baseball Club.

Conduct

Fans using foul or abusive language or appearing to be intoxicated will be ejected from the premises. Fans that enter the playing field or obstruct play at any time will be ejected from the ballpark and subject to arrest.

Customer Service

The Smithfield Information Center is located on the concourse by third base. Lost and found children, lost items, or suggestions and concerns will be handled from this location.

Harbor Park Information

First Aid

The Patient First Medical Station is located on the concourse behind section 208/210 on the first base side. Please report all injuries, accidents or illnesses requiring assistance to this location. Please do not leave Harbor Park without reporting any injury.

Foul Balls

Please be alert for balls that are batted or thrown into the stands. Do not chase foul balls in the stands or on the concourse. Types of nets that are used to collect or catch foul balls are prohibited. The Tides are not responsible for any injuries resulting from a ball batted or thrown into the stands. The Tides are not responsible for any injuries resulting from a bat leaving the field of play.

Gates Open

Fans may begin entering Harbor Park 65 minutes before the scheduled start time, unless otherwise noted.

Group Tickets

Groups of 20 or more can receive a special discount on tickets by booking at least 10 days in advance. For more information, visit norfolktides.com or call (757) 622-2222 Ext. 107.

landicap Seating

Harbor Park contains 250 handicap seats. In order to ensure that handicap seats are available, please attempt to purchase these seats in advance of game day.

Infants

Infants two years and younger are admitted free of charge. Strollers can be stored near the Smithfield Information Center on the concourse behind home plate.

Message Board Announcements

Fans may request a message board announcement by visiting norfolktides.com and filling out a form on the Scoreboard Announcements page. These announcements must be submitted at least 24 hours prior to first pitch of the designated game. The cost to submit a message is \$10, with all proceeds benefitting the Youth Baseball Fund.

Outside Food

No bottles, cans, coolers or outside food items will be permitted into Harbor Park. The only exception to this rule is for sealed plastic water bottles. Bottles where the seal is not intact are not allowed into Harbor Park.

Parking

The city of Norfolk charges \$6.00 per vehicle for home games at Harbor Park. The city of Norfolk reserves the right to raise that price at any time. Season-long parking passes can be purchased by calling (757) 622-2222.

Picnics

Groups of 50 or more can arrange a picnic in the Virginian-Pilot Picnic Area. These outings can be booked by calling (757) 622-2222 Ext. 107. For more information, visit norfolktides.com.

Rain Checks

In the event a game is postponed due to inclement weather or any other circumstance before it is officially completed (the losing team must have had at least five turns at bat), the Tides will exchange the rain check portion of your ticket for the best available ticket to any future non-restricted regular season home game. This exchange can be made at the Tides box office during business hours. There are no cash refunds. If you purchased tickets as part of a group, hold onto your tickets and return them to your group leader.

Restrooms

Restrooms are located throughout the concourse and in the picnic area. All restrooms are ADA accessible and are equipped with diaper changing stations. For those needing assistance, family restrooms are located on the 3rd base concourse.

Security

Uniformed security officers are stationed throughout the ballpark and in parking areas. Please notify them of any problems requiring attention while attending a game.

Smoking Areas

Smoking is prohibited in the seating areas, restrooms and on the concourse at Harbor Park. Smoking is allowed on all ramps and in designated areas on the suite level.

To provide a welcoming experience for all, the Norfolk Tides has implemented a Fan Code of Conduct. Out of respect for fellow guests, players, coaches, and ballpark staff,

ALL GUESTS ARE PROHIBITED FROM:

- Trespassing on the playing field at any time;
- Interfering with baseballs that are in play;
- Throwing or tossing objects;
- Using foul, obscene or derogatory language (see below) or gestures;
- Misusing or overconsuming alcohol, including, underage consumption;
- Behaving in a manner that is disruptive, unruly, or abusive;
- Accessing areas of the ballpark without a proper ticket, pass, or credential;
- Misusing tickets, passes, or credentials in any way; or
- Bringing prohibited items into the ballpark.

Derogatory language is defined as offensive language concerning a person's race, ethnicity, gender, religion, disability, age, sexual orientation, or national origin, and anyone using such language is subject to automatic ejection from the ballpark.

Violations of the Fan Code of Conduct will not be tolerated and may lead to ejection from the ballpark, a ban on attending future games, or other consequences. Guests who are found to have used derogatory language will be ejected from the ballpark.

RON JOHNSON | 1956-2021

The Norfolk Tides would like to dedicate this page to long-time manager Ron Johnson, who sadly passed away on January 26, 2021 at the age of 64 years old.

A native of Long Beach, California, Johnson was a manager in Minor League Baseball for 24 seasons, compiling a career record of 1,752-1,770 over that span. Known around Harbor Park as 'RJ', Johnson managed the Tides during the final seven seasons of his career from 2012-18 and amassed 491 wins in that time, making him both the winningest and longest-tenured manager in franchise history.

After leading Norfolk to winning campaigns in each of his first two seasons with the Tides in 2012 and 2013, Johnson led his team to a third winning season and a division title in 2015, and was named the International League's Manager of the Year – just the fifth manager to win the award in team history. He also received the Cal Ripken Sr. Player Development Award from the Orioles that season, an award presented to a minor league staff member who exemplifies the qualities of Ripken, the architect of "The Oriole Way."

A special time in Johnson's long managerial career came in 2017, when he had the opportunity to manage his son, Chris, marking the first time the Tides have ever had a son be managed by his father. That same season, Johnson was chosen by fans as the manager on Norfolk's 25-year All Harbor Park Team.

Prior to joining the O's system, Johnson served as the first base coach for the Boston Red Sox in 2010 and 2011. He managed in the Red Sox system from 2000-2009, a stint that included a playoff berth for Triple-A Pawtucket in 2008 after an 85-58 campaign. Johnson was a coach in the Kansas City Royals system from 1986-91 before taking his first managerial job in 1992. He posted six winning seasons in eight years managing in the Royals organization, and he guided three clubs to the postseason: Baseball City (1992), Wichita (1995) and Omaha (1999). He was named the 1995 Texas League Manager of the Year after guiding Double-A Wichita to the playoffs.

While in high school, Johnson turned down football scholarships to UCLA and Fresno State, choosing instead to play baseball at Fresno State. He was a First Team All-American in 1978 before being selected by the Kansas City Royals in the 24th round of the 1978 draft.


Johnson played in 22 Major League games over parts of three seasons with the Royals (1982-83) and Expos (1984), batting .261. When he was playing for Montreal, his locker was next to Pete Rose's.




Ron Johnson is the all-time winningest manager in Tides history with 491 wins.

Buck Showalter, the Orioles manager from 2010-18, frequently called Johnson "the best Triple-A manager in baseball," and he was admired by the countless players he coached throughout his career. Johnson helped mold dozens of major league All-Stars over the years, and his players have described him as a motivator whose personality and love of the game brought out the best in everyone.

Johnson and his wife Daphne have five children - Savannah, Christopher, Christian, Cheyanne and Bridget. He will truly be missed by all.



Buck Britton is entering his first year managing in Norfolk and his 13th season in the Orioles organization overall. In 2008, he was drafted by the Orioles in the 35th round out of Lubbock Christian University. Britton would go on to play seven seasons in Baltimore's organization, including four seasons with the Norfolk Tides (2010, 2012 - 2014). He played for the Los Angeles Dodgers organization in 2015 and the Minnesota Twins organization in 2016 before retiring as a player. In 2017, Britton came back to the Orioles organization as a hitting coach for the Single-A Delmarva Shorebirds. He was elevated to manager for Delmarva in the 2018 season and then became manager of the Bowie Baysox in 2019. With the season getting cancelled due to the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020, he coached at the Orioles Alternate Training Site but returned as manager for Bowie in 2021. In his three seasons as manager, Britton has 217 wins and 177 losses. Bowie reached their league championship series in both seasons Britton managed, totaling a 5-7 career playoff record. He won the Eastern League Manager of the Year Award in 2019.

As a player, Buck totaled 828 Minor League games and hit .270 with 59 home runs and 407 RBI. In his four seasons with the Tides, he played played 130 games and hit .245 with 44 runs, 22 doubles, 13 home runs and 62 RBI. He played 58 games at third base, 33 games at second, 18 games at first, six games in left field, and two games in right. He recorded a 21-game hitting streak with the Tides in 2013, tied for the third longest hitting streak in franchise history.

Britton was born in Panorama City, California and graduated from Weatherford High School (Texas). He played JUCO baseball at Lon Morris College and then played Division I baseball at Steven F. Austin University and Lubbock Christian University. Baltimore drafted Britton in 2008 in the 35th round of the MLB Draft from LCU. 





Justin Ramsey is entering his first season as Norfolk's Pitching Coach after serving as the Pitching Coach for Double-A Bowie in 2021. The 2022 season will be his third as a coach in professional baseball, where he was the pitching coach for Delmarva in 2019 and an Orioles Alternate Site coach in 2020. In 2019, Delmarva led the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.00), WHIP (1.18), and strikeouts (1,389), and allowed the fewest home runs (67). Under Ramsey's guidance, Delmarva set the South Atlantic League record for the most strikeouts in a single season and named 2019 South Atlantic League Coach of the Year.

Ramsey began his coaching career as an assistant coach at Sacramento City College (SCC) for six seasons from 2005 to 2010, spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Long Beach State from 2012 to 2014, and then as pitching coach for Nova Southeastern University (NSU) from 2015 to 2018 before joining the Orioles organization. At NSU, Ramsey helped his team reach four straight NCAA Division II Regional Tournament appearances, including the program's first ever NCAA Division II National Championship win in 2016.

Outside of college and MLB-affiliated baseball, Ramsey coached in the Northwood League and the Cape Cod League. In 2010, he served as the pitching coach for the La Crosse Loggers. Later on, he was the pitching coach for the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox of the Cape Cod League in 2013.

In his playing career, Ramsey started with two seasons at SCC from 2001-02. He then transferred to Oral Roberts, selecting them over Belmont, Western Kentuckey, UNLV and Fresno State. Ramsey was a closer and relief pitcher for Oral Roberts from 2003-04. A 2004 All-American, Ramsey posted a 7-0 record with 13 saves as a senior, posting a 2.91 ERA. A two-time All-Summit League selection, Ramsey led the Golden Eagles to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. He ranks fourth all-time with 18 career saves for Oral Roberts. After graduating as a Business Marketing major, he played three seasons for the Long Beach Armad of the independent Golden Baseball League from 2005 through 2007 while he coached at SCC.





Young has been in the recreational food business for more than 30 years since graduating from



HARBOR PARK

HARBOR PARK, with its outstanding view and sound design, was opened in 1993. The ballpark is located in downtown Norfolk on the Elizabeth River, and the Tides christened their new home on 4/14/93 with a 2-0 victory against the Ottawa Lynx.

Talks of a new stadium for the Tides began during the 1990 season. Several sites were discussed, and the area known as "Bessie's Place" in downtown Norfolk was selected due to the nationwide success of downtown ballparks. Ground was broken in February of 1992 and work began shortly after.

HOK Sports Facilities Group of Kansas City, Mo. (currently known as Populous) was chosen to design the crown jewel on the Norfolk waterfront. HOK Sports Facilities Group has also designed some of the finest major league parks, including Oriole Park at Camden Yards in Baltimore, PNC Park in Pittsburgh, Comerica Park in Detroit, PETCO Park in San Diego, Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia, Citi Field in New York and the new Yankee Stadium.

The design team, led by Earl Santee, elected to create a nautical image with shipyard cranelike light towers and arrays of colorful flags. However, it also had to fit into the downtown business scene, and the brick exterior of the stadium was selected for just that purpose.

Harbor Park features nearly 9,000 lower-deck seats, 2,800 upper-deck seats, and 400 seats in 24 luxury skyboxes. The park also features a 225-seat restaurant known as "Hits at the Park," a climate-controlled facility that offers a complete view of the playing field. Two LED video boards were installed in the right field scoreboard prior to the 2006 season, while three LED ribbon boards were installed prior to the 2013 season. New video boards were installed in left and right field prior to the 2022 season, setting the record for the most combined video-board space in all of Minor League Baseball. An additional party deck was built in right field prior to the 2014 season, with the center field fences moved in 10 feet. The picnic area in left field was completely renovated prior to the 2018 season. The Harbor Park field dimensions are 333 ft in LF, 400 ft in CF, and 318 ft in RF, and the capacity of the ballpark is 11,856.

The facility is owned by the City of Norfolk. Its construction was financed by rent paid by the Tides and other revenue from non-baseball events held in the facility. The total cost of construction for the stadium exceeded \$16 million.

Harbor Park was selected by Baseball America as the finest minor league facility in the United States in 1995.


