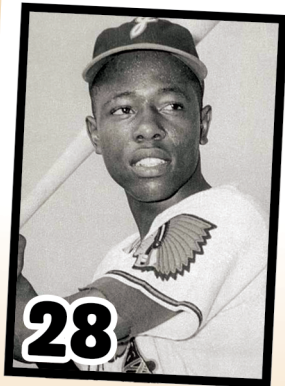

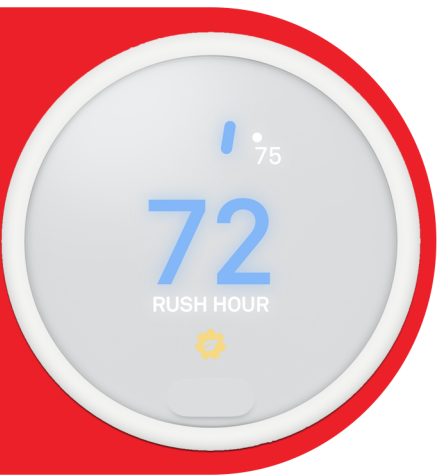

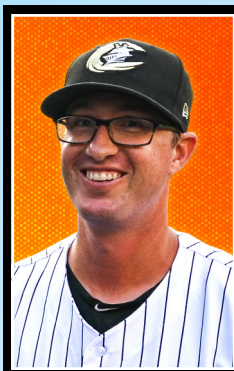

# CHARLOTTE KNIGHTS COACHING STAFF



## Wes Helms **MANAGER**

Gastonia, NC native Wes Helms is back in the Queen City for a second consecutive season to manage the Charlotte Knights for the 2022 season. A 1994 graduate of Ashbrook High School (Gastonia, NC), Helms made his managerial debut in 2021 with the Knights. Helms, 45, was originally slated to make his managerial debut with the Knights in 2020 before the season was cancelled in June (2020) due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Instead, he spent 2020 at the Chicago White Sox alternate training site in Schaumburg, IL.



## Matt Zaleski **PITCHING COACH**

Zaleski, 40, returns to the Knights after first being named Charlotte's pitching coach in 2020. He spent his first season as the team's pitching coach in 2021 after the 2020 season was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Arlington Heights, IL native spent six seasons as a pitcher with the Knights from 2009-2014. He appeared in 92 games with the Knights and is the all-time leader in franchise history in games started (74) and is second in franchise history in innings pitched (437.2). Overall, Zaleski appeared in a total of 316 games as a minor league pitcher (2004-14). As a pitching coach, he began his career with Great Falls in 2016. He later spent time with Kannapolis (2017) and Winston-Salem (2018-2019).

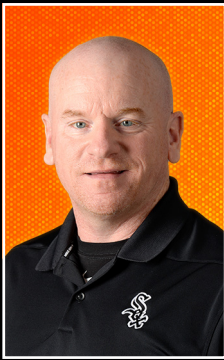






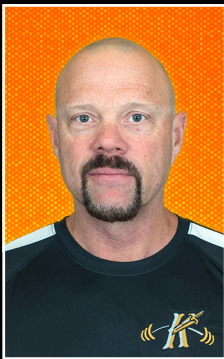
## Chris Johnson HITTING COACH

Johnson, 37, returns to the Knights and the Chicago White Sox organization for his second consecutive season. He joined the organization for the 2021 season. As a player, Johnson spent parts of eight seasons in the majors with Houston (2009-11, 2012), Arizona (2012), Atlanta (2013-15), Cleveland (2015) and Miami (2016). He was originally drafted by the Astros in the fourth round of the 2006 MLB Amateur Draft out of Stetson University. The Naples, FL native compiled a .275 career batting average in 839 major league games.



## Cory Barton TRAINER

A native of Needmore, PA, Barton returns to the Knights for the 2022 season after being named to Charlotte's staff for the first time in 2020. Before that, he spent time as a trainer in the Chicago White Sox organization with Birmingham (2018-19), the AZL White Sox (2014-17), Kannapolis (2013), Winston-Salem (2011-12) and Bristol (2005-10). He was named as the Appalachian League Trainer of the Year in 2007 and 2009.



## Shawn Powell PERFORMANCE COACH

Powell, a native of Brighton, IL, enters his 11th year in Chicago's system. He first joined Charlotte's staff for the 2016 season. Before his time with the Knights, Powell spent two seasons as the strength and conditioning coach with High-A Winston-Salem (2012 and 2015) and two seasons with Double-A Birmingham (2013-14) in the same capacity. In addition, he spent 13 years with the New York Yankees as a strength and conditioning coach (1989-99) and assistant to their front office (2004-05). He also worked for the NBA's New Jersey Nets (1999-2003). More recently, Powell worked with Darryl Strawberry on the book "Don't Give Up on Me" in 2017.

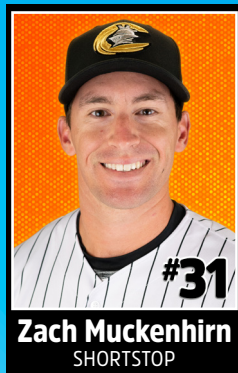
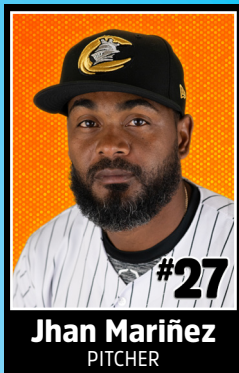

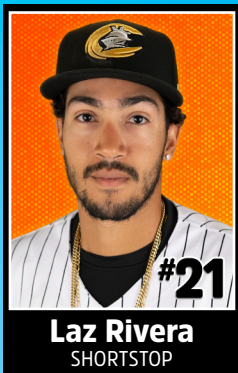

## **CHARLOTTE VS. MEMPHIS**

The Charlotte Knights welcome the Memphis Redbirds to Truist Field from Tuesday, April 12 to Sunday, April 16. This six-game series features the first-ever appearance by the Redbirds to Truist Field in Uptown Charlotte. The two teams will also meet in Uptown Charlotte for a six-game series from Tuesday, May 31 to Sunday, June 5. The Knights make one trip to Memphis this season from Tuesday, August 23 to Sunday, August 28.

## **SERIES FACTS**

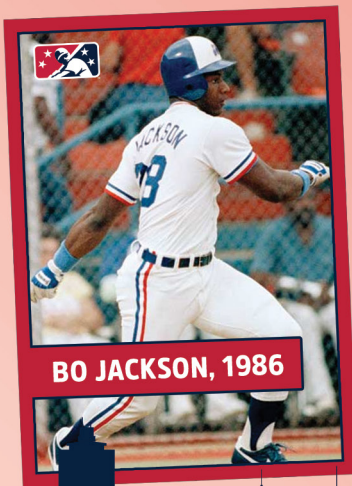
The Charlotte Knights and Memphis Redbirds met for the first-time ever as Triple-A affiliates last season. Memphis played host to the Knights in the final series of the 2021 season from Wednesday, September 29 to Sunday, October 3. The opening game of that series was the first time the two teams ever met as Triple-A affiliates. Before that, the last time a Charlotte team played a Memphis team was in 1992 when the teams were members of the Double-A Southern League. That year, the Knights, as an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, finished 2nd in their division - led by Steve Trachsel's 13 wins for the Knights pitching staff.

## 2021 HEAD-TO-HEAD

The Knights were 0-3 against Memphis in 2021 during the team's only series of the season, which took place at AutoZone Park in Memphis (September 29-October 3). The two teams were supposed to play a five-game series, but two of the games were postponed due to inclement weather. Infielders Jake Burger and Romy Gonzalez hit .300 apiece in the series. Gonzalez had drove home three of Charlotte's seven runs in the series.

## CHARLOTTE CONNECTION

Charlotte, NC native Mike Shildt managed the Memphis Redbirds for two seasons (2015-16). Shildt grew up working in the clubhouse for the Charlotte O's, the Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. His mom, Lib, was the team's administrative assistant. In 2016, Shildt made his Truist Field debut as he coached the Pacific Coast League All-Stars during the 2016 Triple-A All-Star Game in Charlotte. He managed the St. Louis Cardinals from 2018-2021 and was named National League Manager of the Year in 2019.

## **CHARLOTTE VS. JACKSONVILLE**

The Charlotte Knights welcome the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp to Truist Field from Tuesday, April 26 to Sunday, May 1. This six-game series is the first of two appearances by the Jumbo Shrimp to Truist Field this season. The 'Shrimp will also be in Uptown Charlotte from Tuesday, June 14 to Sunday, June 19. The Knights will make two trips to 121 Financial Ballpark in Jacksonville this season (Friday, July 2 to Sunday, July 24 and again from Tuesday, September 20 to Sunday, September 25).

## **SERIES FACTS**

Charlotte and Jacksonville consistently faced off when both franchises were members of the Southern League. From 1976 to 1987, the Charlotte O's, the Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, faced the Jacksonville Suns (1976-1984) and later faced the Jacksonville Expos (1985-87). The Charlotte O's was renamed to the Charlotte Knights in 1988 (the franchise was sold by the Crockett family to George Shinn after the 1987 season) and the Knights faced the Jacksonville Expos from 1988 to 1992 while Charlotte was a Double-A team in the Southern League. The Knights were the Double-A affiliate of the Orioles in 1988 and then the Chicago Cubs from 1989-92.

## 2021 HEAD-TO-HEAD

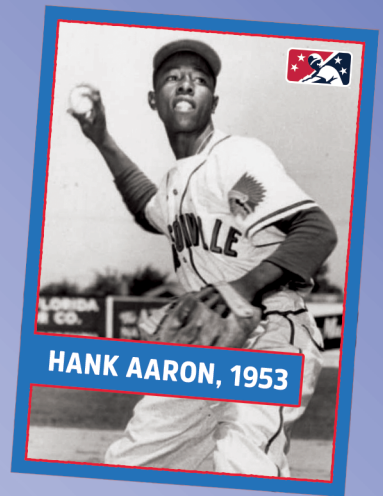
The Knights went 14-16 against the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp last season. As a team, the Knights hit .252 with 47 home runs and 141 RBIs against the Jumbo Shrimp last season. Outfielder Mikie Mahtook hit a team-best eight home runs against the Shrimp last year. Infielders Tim Beckham and Zach Remillard finished second with six home runs each. On the mound, right-handed pitchers Jonathan Stiever and Mike Wright both led the Knights with two wins apiece against the Redbirds.

## HANK AARON

In 1953 as a 19-year-old, Hall of Fame slugger Hank Aaron appeared in 137 games for the Jacksonville Braves, the South Atlantic League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. That season, Aaron hit .362 (208-for-574) with 115 runs scored, 36 doubles, 14 triples, 22 home runs, 125 RBIs and 13 stolen bases.

## MORE NOTABLE JACKSONVILLE ALUM

Hall of Fame pitchers Tom Seaver (1966) and Nolan Ryan (1967) pitched for the Jacksonville Suns when the team was the International League (Triple-A) affiliate of the New York Mets. In 1987, Hall of Famers Randy Johnson and Larry Walker were key members of the Jacksonville Expos (Double-A affiliate of the Montreal Expos). Johnson posted an impressive 11-8 record with a 3.73 ERA in 140.0 innings pitched. Walker hit .287 and led the team in home runs (26) and stolen bases (24). The Charlotte O's beat the Jacksonville Expos in the Southern League playoffs in 1987. From 2007-2008, Clayton Kershaw pitched in 18 games for the Jacksonville Suns (Los Angeles Dodgers' Double-A affiliate).

The 2021 season was the first for infielder Zach Remillard at the Triple-A level and the New York native found himself among the team leaders in several offensive categories. Now, the 28-year-old looks to take another step forward as he embarks on his second season with the Charlotte Knights in 2022.

## WHITE SOX ORGANIZATION

Originally drafted by the Chicago White Sox in the 10th round of the 2016 MLB June Amateur Draft, Remillard worked his way through the organization and earned a promotion to the Knights on May 19, 2021. At the time of his promotion from Double-A Birmingham, he was hitting .295 (13-for-44) with 13 runs scored, two doubles, one triple, one home run, seven RBIs and four stolen bases in 13 games with the Barons.

## KNIGHT TIME

Appearing in 82 games with the Charlotte Knights last season, the Coastal Carolina University product launched

12 home runs – good for the third-best mark on the team behind Mikie Mahtook (26) and Jake Burger (18). He also had success on the base paths and led the Knights in stolen bases with 10. Additionally, he finished third on the club in walks (27) and tied for fourth in runs scored (40).

### NOTABLE

Remillard entered the 2018, 2020 and 2021 seasons ranked by Baseball America as having the Best Infield Arm in the Chicago White Sox system. In 2019, he was named a Carolina League midseason and postseason All-Star thanks to a solid season with the Winston-Salem Dash in which he hit .289 (103-for-357) in 95 games.

### COLLEGE DAYS

A four-year starter at Coastal Carolina, Remillard excelled during his senior year in 2016 – which turned out to be a historic year for the Chanticleers. For the season, he hit .345 with 17 doubles, two triples, 19 home runs, 72 RBIs and 15 stolen bases over 72 games and helped guide the Chanticleers to a National Championship in 2016. The Chanticleers beat Arizona two games to one in the College World Series to earn the program's first NCAA National Championship.

# CELEBRATING THE HISTORY OF THE NEGRO LEAGUES

Since April 15, 2004, Major League Baseball has celebrated Jackie Robinson Day. Every year on that day, players from all around the majors -- and countless other teams from around Minor League Baseball -- honor the legacy of Jackie Robinson by wearing #42 on their jerseys. Even more so, they stand for what Jackie Robinson stood for when he broke the color barrier on April 15, 1947 -- equality.

Now, as the 75th anniversary of Jackie's debut is on the horizon, baseball is set to celebrate his achievements and the Knights are planning a big Negro Leagues Night this year at Truist Field.

In Charlotte, the Knights have honored the legacy of Jackie Robinson as well as the history of the Negro Leagues. Since 2014, the Knights have held a special Tribute to the Negro Leagues at the ballpark. At these games each season, all players on the Knights take the field in wear #42 on their jerseys and former players from the Negro Leagues come out to the ballpark to share their stories. In addition, a traveling museum is set up on the concourse by Ray Banks, a Negro Leagues historian. Local Negro Leagues historian, Michael Turner Webb, is also a part of the night to share the history of the Negro Leagues. It is truly a special game each year.

The Knights were scheduled to host their 7th Annual Negro Leagues Tribute during the 2020 season. With the 100th Anniversary of the Negro Leagues that year, the celebration was

one many looked for to attending. The team had many big plans for the game. Unfortunately, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the season was first postponed and then ultimately cancelled. In 2021, with restrictions and many protocols still in place, the night was not held for a second consecutive year. That all changes this year as the Charlotte Knights 7th Annual Negro Leagues Night is set for Friday, April 15 on the 75th anniversary of Jackie Robinson breaking the color barrier.

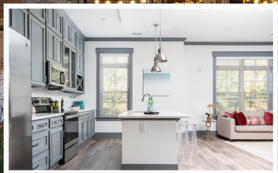
