BRONCOS

Our fight song defines our colors and our new identity is a return to our roots with historic shades of brown and gold. White serves as a third primary color, while dark gray and gray play supporting roles and provide contrast.

Other than plain text, black is not included as a color in our brand.









We proudly share one, unified primary mark as Western Michigan University. With a bold, strong statement made by our primary mark, we ride together as Broncos into competition, representing the best of Western.

As the primary logo of Western Michigan Athletics, every effort should be made to maintain the connection between the brand mark and word mark. The brand mark may only be used in a stand alone format when the application would render the word mark illegible.

BRAND MARK

WORD MARK







Several one-color options are available to support the primary, two-color logo.

Brown and gold one-color usages are both acceptable on white backgrounds, while brown and gold backgrounds should have the inverse color.

For black-and-white usage, the logo should always be white on a dark background. The logo should never be rendered in black.









In certain applications, it is acceptable to use the brand mark in lieu of the full primary mark. This should only be done if the mark is already paired with text or another WMU identifier, or if the application would render the Western Michigan text in the primary logo illegible.





SECONDARY MARK



Serving as a secondary logo, the brand mark paired with the Broncos word mark serves as a representation of our nickname which can be used in certain applications. It should only be used in settings where use of the "Western Michigan" word mark would be redundant. One-color versions are available with the same guidelines as the primary mark.







BRONCO SPIRIT MARK



The newest version of the iconic Bronco logo can be paired with both the "Western Michigan" and "Broncos" word marks. Available in two-color and one-color formats, the Bronco takes on new direction as it charges towards the finish line. It cannot be separated from the wordmark without permission.









#LetsRide is the official hashtag of all 16 Western Michigan athletics teams. WMUBroncos.com is the official athletics website of Western Michigan University.









Celebrating our roots in Kalamazoo and our representation of the State of Michigan, the Mitten Mark provides another unique way to represent our community. The logo can be used in a supporting role, but should not be used as a stand alone mark without approval.









To represent our 16 varsity sports, as well as cheer and dance programs, the primary brand and word mark may be paired with team-specific branding. This is the only instance in which a sport name should be attached to a logo. They should be used on white or dark backgrounds (not brown or gold).

DESIGN ELEMENTS



To support design elements for digital and social use, multiple supporting backgrounds can be used in graphic design along with WMU's brandmarks. In addition to brand colors as a stand alone background, a contrasted version of the Bronco Spirit Mark can be used to provide texture, as well as brown and gray concrete texture to provide added depth. The slash marks may be used to divide or offset elements.



CONFERENCE MARKS



Western is a proud member of both the Mid-American Conference and National Collegiate Hockey Conference. When using logos to represent the MAC and NCHC, Western Michigan uses the full-color, primary logos of each conference.









To preserve the integrity of Western Michigan's athletics marks, all logos usage should include proper clear space. The clear space should be roughly equivalent to a capital letter in the word mark. Colors and proportions of marks should be preserved in their original form at all times.

Logos should never be altered in any way, including but not limited to:









TITLING SIGNAGE UNIFORMS

adidas Half Block serves as athletics primary font for titling, signage and uniforms. It should not be used within copy text. It should only be used in all caps. It does not provide punctuation. Montserrat should be used when adidas Half Block does not provide the needed characters.

ABCDEFGHIJKLMNOP 1234567890

Montserrat serves as the primary copy font and may be used for titling when adidas Half Block does not suffice. Available under an Open Font License, Montserrat provides multiple options for weight and style. It should be used for all copy.
