VS. FARGO-MOORHEAD: The Monarchs took two of three games over the RedHawks back in May at Legends Field and took two of three in North Dakota on including a comeback win on July $24^{\text {th }}$ the same day Buck O'Neil went into the Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown. The Monarchs took three of four games Labor Day weekend to finish the season series at 7-3 in favor of "kay-see". In the American Association the RedHawks hold the advantage 47-40. The pair played last season in the American Association finals with Kansas City taking all three games. Kansas City is 41all time in the post season against Fargo-Moorhead.

UNDER JOE: Joe Calfapietra is $16-7$ as manager of the Monarchs/T-Bones in the post season.
HOME SWEET HOME: The Monarchs finished with the best home record again this season going 36-14 after going 44-11 last year. Under Joe Calfapietra the Monarchs/T-Bones have had the best home record in three of four seasons. The Monarchs are 7-3 at home in the post season but have won their last four in a row.

HALL IN POSTSEASON: Matt Hall picked up his third post season win on last Wednesday night at Lincoln. He is 3-0 in the playoffs in four starts passing Tommy Collier who has two playoff wins in franchise history with a no decision in KC win. Hall picked up a no descsion on Mondahy in Fargo but has allowed no earned runs in 12.1 innings this post season. Over the last two post seasons Hall has given up five earned runs in 24.1 innings for a 1.88 ERA with 28 strikeouts.

POST SEASON HISTORY: This is the Monarchs fourth straight post season trip and ninth as a franchise. KC sat out the 2020 season due to the pandemic but made the post season as a wild card in 2018, a division champion in 2019, 2021 and 2022. The Monarchs fourth straight playoff berth sets a new franchise record and breaks a tie with the 2008-2010 T-Bones who made it three straight years. The club was managed in 2008 and 2009 by Andy McCauley and 2010 by Tim Doherty. This current run has come all under the direction of field manager Joe Calfapietra.

## RED HOT MONARCHS

## (Regular and post season combined)

-Ryan Grotjohn has a six-game hitting streak and has 10 RBI in his last six games.
-Darnell Sweeney has hit safe in 8 of his last 10 games with 6 RBI in his last six.
-Kevin Santa has scored 10 runs in his last 10 games and closed the season hitting .385 with 6 RBI in his last 10.
-Brian Glowicki has allowed one earned run over his las seven innings with seven strikeouts

TOPS IN LONG BALLS AND STRIKEOUTS: The Monarchs led the league in home runs (165) and strikeouts as a pitching staff (967). The Monarchs are the fourth team in league history to achieve that status. The other three teams were the 2013 Wichita Wingnuts (107 HR/782 SO), 2016 Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks (121 HR/838 SO) and the 2019 Chicago Dogs ( 122 HR/895 SO).

LEAGUE LEADERS 2022: The Monarchs led the American Association at the plate hitting .293. The team also led in runs scored (696), home runs (165), OBP (.384) and OPS (.889). While the Monarchs are known for the long ball, they finished second in triples with 24. The team had 388 extra base hits his season. On the hill the club has the lowest ERA at 4.340 and tops in strike outs (967) and first in WHIP (1.38).

REIGN REBORN: The old Kansas City T-Bones franchise was sold to Mark Brandmeyer following the 2019 season. With the 2020 season postponed the ownership took the opportunity to rebrand the ball club. On January 21, 2021 \#reignreborn returned with the announcement from the Negro Leagues Museum President, Bob Kendrick, that a partnership had come together with the Kansas City T-Bones for the team to be known going forward as the "Kansas City Monarchs Baseball Club." The long-anticipated name change and terms of the agreement were revealed in a press conference at the museum with Kendrick, T-Bones owner, Mark Brandmeyer, NLBM Board members and city officials all in attendance. The team that took the field in the former T-Bone's stadium in 2021, now known as Legends Field are now known as the Kansas City Monarchs.

ABOUT THE MUSUEM: Established in a one-room office in 1990, the Negro Leagues Baseball Museum (NLBM) is a privately funded, not-for-profit organization dedicated to preserving and celebrating the rich history of African-American baseball and its profound impact on the social advancement of America. In 2006, the United States Congress designated the NLBM as "America's National Negro Leagues Baseball Museum."
Where History Touches Home-The Negro Leagues Baseball Museum (NLBM) is the world's only museum dedicated to preserving and celebrating the rich history of African-American baseball and its impact on the social advancement of America. The privately funded, 501 c 3 , not-for-profit is located in the heart of Kansas City, Missouri's Historic 18th \& Vine Jazz District. The NLBM operates two blocks from the Paseo YMCA where Andrew "Rube" Foster established the Negro National League in 1920. The NLBM opened its doors to the public in a tiny, one-room office space in 1991 with a dream of building a permanent facility that would pay rightful tribute to America's unsung baseball heroes. In November of 1997, under the leadership of its late chairman John "Buck" O'Neil, that dream became a reality when the NLBM moved into its new 10,000 square-foot home inside a cultural complex known as the Museums at 18 th \& Vine. Since that time, the NLBM has welcomed more than 2-million visitors and has become one of the most important cultural institutions in the world for its work to give voice to a once forgotten chapter of baseball and American history.

MONARCHS HISTORY: Kansas City Monarchs Owned by J.L. Wilkinson, a white businessman, the Monarchs were one of the best known and most successful black teams. The Monarchs captured a total of ten pennants, tying the Homestead Grays for the most flags by any Negro League team, and suffered only one losing season during their entire association with the Negro Leagues. And that season was during World War II, when the roster was decimated by the loss of players to military service. The Monarchs also hold the distinction of having won the first World Series ever played between opposing leagues, both in the initial World Series in 1924 between the Negro National League and the Eastern Colored League, and again in the reinstated World Series in 1942 between the Negro National League and the Negro American League.

A charter member of the Negro National League, they played through the 1930 season, winning pennants in 1923-1925 and 1929 while never experiencing a losing season. They narrowly missed a fourth straight pennant in 1926, when they won the first half title but lost a bitter nine game playoff to the Chicago American Giants by dropping a doubleheader on the last day. The Monarchs played in the first two World Series ever played, facing the Hilldale team on both occasions.

After dropping out of the league they played independent ball until joining the Negro American League as a charter member in 1937 and remaining even after the league lost its major status. During the first six seasons (1937-1942) they won five pennants, missing only in 1938. After the return of many of their best players, who had been called to service during World War II, they annexed another flag in 1946. In 1942, the first World Series since 1927 was played between the Monarchs and the Homestead Grays, with the Monarchs sweeping the Grays in four straight games. In 1946 the Monarchs lost a tough seven game Series to the Newark Eagles.

In 1948 the Monarchs won the second half of the split season but lost a seven game play off to the Birmingham Black Barons for the pennant and thereby missed a chance to appear in the last Negro World Series ever played. Following that World Series, the Negro National League folded and the Negro American League absorbed some of the franchises and expanded into division play. The Monarchs won the first half title in 1949 and annexed a division title in 1950. Wilkinson had sold the franchise after the 1948 season to Tom Baird, who continued to operate the Monarchs through the 1950s, but by then the league was strictly a minor league operation.

MONARCHS PLAYOFF FLASHBACK: Game 10 of the 1924 Colored World Series was legendary for Monarchs hurler Jose Méndez. Although still weak from surgery before the series and advised by a doctor not to exert himself, Méndez had already pitched 10 innings of relief in the first nine games, and upon the advice of Rube Foster named himself to start the final game. Game Ten became part of his legend. He matched Hilldale starter Scrip Lee zero for zero for seven full innings until Lee tired in the bottom of the eighth. Lee changed from his normal submarine delivery to an overhand style in that inning, and the Monarchs scored five runs off of him, including one by Méndez himself. The go ahead run came off the bat of Heavy Johnson who singled in Dobie Moore. When Hilldale went out in the ninth, the Monarchs had won the first Colored World Series. Lee, the losing pitcher in the Series finale, later umpired the opening game of the 1942 Colored World Series. For Méndez only four batters reached base during the game and not one runner went beyond second.

ON THE AIR: Dan Vaughan returns for his sixth season as the broadcaster for Kansas City's independent baseball team. This is his second as the "voice of the Monarchs" after holding the "Voice of the T-Bones" role from 2017-2020. Prior to coming to the metro Vaughan spent the previous four years with the Gary SouthShore RailCats in the American Association and in the Australian summer he is one of the voices of the Perth Heat of the Australian Baseball League during the USA winters. Since the rebrand of the Monarchs Vaughan has dived headfirst into the exciting content that the Negro Leagues Baseball Museum offers and the fantastic history of the Monarchs. Vaughan has two nightly pregame show features one called "Monarchs 101 with DV" and other "The Coors Light Flashback Moment" to look at the unique Monarchs baseball history during the broadcast. He can also be seen Monday through Friday in game days on "Monarchs Mocha" on Facebook and YouTube Live. The show is a look back at the game before and a preview of that night's game. He also will anchor a short Facebook and YouTube Live show on most nights home and away called Monarchs Live. The interactive radio broadcast can be heard on monarchsbaseball.com on the Monarchs Mixlr channel and the MixLR app. The pregame begins at $6: 30$ with Monarchs 101 with DV and "The Top Step with Manager Joe Calfapietra.

VIDEO STREAM: www.aabaseball.tv will carry all Monarchs games on the league broadcast site. The site features live games and also bonus as new this season Monarchs fans will be able to hear the Monarchs radio audio call of the road games with the sites dual stream.
