





So you've made it out of Extended Spring Training, congratulations! Now it's time to show what you've got in the Reds Rookie-level team in Goodyear, Arizona. These are what we call "Short Season" teams, because they only play 76 games during their season that starts in June and ends in September.

DAYTONA TORTUGAS

You're on the Daytona Tortugas, the Low Single-A affiliate of the Reds. Most of the time the players on the Tortugas have a year or two of experience after high school. It might have been professional or in college, but the Tortugas normally don't get players right out of high school and players usually have not played a season this long.

Players in the Reds system make it or break at this level as most are given a chance to prove their value to the team.

CHATTANOOGA LOOKOUTS

The prospects almost ready to make the jump to the big leagues are waiting with the Lookouts in Chattanooga, Tennessee. These players are polishing up their skills and working to eliminate weaknesses that are leaving them short of their ultimate goal. The defense is better, the batters hit harder, and the pitchers move faster.

A Major League team's hottest prospects are typically in Double-A, waiting for a chance at their shot to show what they can do.



LARRY WARD

The 2022 season marks Larry's 34th with the Lookouts. Since 1989, "The Voice" has been telling the story of Lookouts baseball to thousands of loyal listeners in the Tennessee Valley. In June of 2016 Larry was inducted into the Southern League Hall of Fame for his years of service and contributions to the Southern League and the game of baseball. Larry was the first Southern League Broadcaster to receive this honor. During the off-season, Larry is the voice of the UTC Lady-Mocs basketball team. Larry was inducted into the Greater Chattanooga Sports Hall of Fame in 2005 and the Tennessee Radio Hall of Fame in 2022.





Q&A With Adam Brett Walker II



Lookouts outfielder Adam Brett Walker II played in Chattanooga in 2015 and set the team's all-time single-season home run record with 31 home runs. Adam also helped lead that team to their first Southern League Championship in 27 years. Last year Adam joined the Yomiuri Giants of the Nippon Professional Baseball league and hit 23 home runs.

1. What was your most memorable moment with the Lookouts?

There were a lot of awesome memories but #1 will be winning the Championship. That team was so much fun and winning at Home made it even better! That summer will always be at the top of my baseball memories.

2. Who is your role model?

My role model was my cousin Damion Easley. He had an amazing career in the MLB. Going to games and watching him play sparked my love for the game. Being able to see someone living your dream helps you believe it is possible.

3. What advice do you have for the younger generation of baseball players?

My advice would be to learn to have fun practicing. If you enjoy being on the field outside of games you will always keep growing as a player. Work hard in practice so you can just have fun during the game!
