Here is what Head Coach Clint Peay, forward Malcolm Fry, and midfielder Brandonn Bueno had to say following the team's 5-1 win against Philadelphia Union II:

### **Revolution II Head Coach Clint Peay:**

North Texas SC vs. MNUFC2

### On the mentality to respond after conceding early:

Peay: "It's great. I mean, we've talked about the idea that things aren't always going to go your way. It's not about trying to change what just happened, it's about how do you respond to that. The guys have been great all year so far with that, and credit to them, they just kept fighting, kept pushing, and were able to get back into it."

### On getting balance with five different goal scorers:

Peay: "It's great. Obviously when all different people are scoring, the confidence of the group rises, and guys feel more emboldened in games to know that they have the ability to find the back of the net."

# **Revolution II Forward Malcolm Fry:**

On early season success:

Fry: "Before we went out, I was saying 3-0-0 sounds way better than 2-1-0. It's fun. I know Jake [Rozhanksy] was talking about how important that is, and you always set goals for yourself, but you know what really matters is at the end of the season, how we're performing. But like the same thing with the five goals: when you're 3-0-0, it's never a bad thing. So, we're trying not to read too much into it, trying not to get too ahead of ourselves, but as you can imagine, you can hear it, it's a good vibe in there. So, we're trying to keep the energy going."

# **Revolution II Midfielder Brandonn Bueno:**

On the team's third consecutive win:

Bueno: "It was great. We started off a little bit slow, then after we got into the game the boys started connecting, and what we trained all week, we were able to execute it during the game, so it was great."

### On his emotions after scoring his first professional goal:

Bueno: "Great. All the hard work I've been putting in through the years, it's just an amazing feeling and an even better birthday gift to be honest."

# **MATCH PREVIEW VS. COLUMBUS CREW 2**

**COLUMBUS, Ohio** – New England Revolution II (3-0-0; 9 pts.) continues its 2023 MLS NEXT Pro season on Sunday, April 16, with a visit to Columbus Crew 2 (1-0-1; 5 pts.) at Historic Crew Stadium. The 1 p.m. match will stream live on MLS Season Pass on the Apple TV app.

Revolution II improved to 3-0-0 for the first time in team history on Monday with a 5-1 win over Philadelphia Union II at Gillette Stadium. Homegrown midfielder **Esmir Bajraktarevic** and forward **Jordan Adebayo-Smith** each scored their second goals of the season, while **Damian Rivera** and **Malcolm Fry** both opened their 2023 accounts. Midfielder **Brandonn Bueno** notched his first professional goal in the victory, earning a penalty kick opportunity in the 89th minute to secure New England's first five-goal performance since the team's inaugural season in 2020. Goalkeeper **Nico Campuzano** made three saves in the win, improving his goals against average to a 1.33 rate on the season.

"Before we went out, I was saying 3-0-0 sounds way better than 2-1-0," forward Malcolm Fry said following the victory. "It's fun. I know Jake [Rozhanksy] was talking about how important that is, and you always set goals for yourself, but you know what really matters is at the end of the season, how we're performing. But like the same thing with the five goals: when you're 3-0-0, it's never a bad thing. So, we're trying not to read too much into it, trying not to get too ahead of ourselves, but as you can imagine, it's a good vibe in there, so we're trying to keep the energy going."

New England is set to face the reigning MLS NEXT Pro Cup Champion and hopes to improve upon its 0-2-0 all-time record against Columbus Crew 2 this weekend. Revolution II's attack ranks as the most in-form unit in MLS Next Pro, as New England currently leads the league with 10 goals and seven assists through the first three games of the season. Following the win over Philadelphia II, New England was awarded MLS NEXT Pro Team of the Matchday honors for week three.

### LAST TIME OUT: REVS ROUT PHILADELPHIA TO REMAIN UNDEFEATED

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – New England Revolution II (3-0-0, 9 pts.) earned a 5-1 victory against Philadelphia Union II (0-3-0, 0 pts.) at Gillette Stadium on Monday afternoon to remain unbeaten in the 2023 MLS Next Pro season. New England's attack featured five different goal scorers in the victory as Damian Rivera, Jordan Adebayo-Smith, Esmir Bajraktarevic, Malcolm Fry, and Brandonn Bueno all found the back of the net. In net, goalkeeper Nico Campuzano made three saves to help seal New England's first-ever 3-0-0 start in team history.



Philadelphia netted the first goal of the contest, when Stefan Stojanovic scored on a penalty kick in the 10th minute. From there, it was all New England as Revolution II evened the score in the 21st minute on Rivera's right-footed shot into the net. Revolution II doubled their score in the 29th minute as Jacob Akanyirige sent a through ball up the center of the field to Adebayo-Smith who flicked it past Philadelphia's Brooks Thompson for the 2-1 lead.

New England maintained command of the match in the second half, notching three goals. Bajraktarevic tallied his second goal in as many games after Campuzano sailed the ball from the top of the box to Adebayo-Smith, who passed it to the 18-year-old midfielder for the left-footed finish in the 49th minute.

Fry made his way onto the scoresheet, moving his way through two Philadelphia defenders at the right side of the box, sending a right-footed shot just under the cross bar for his first tally of the season. Bueno sealed the scoring after drawing a penalty in the box and capitalizing on a penalty kick in the 89th minute.

### **10 GOALS IN THREE GAMES: ACADEMY PRODUCTS LEADING THE WAY**

Of New England's seven goal scorers so far this season, four are graduates of the Revolution Academy. Esmir Bajraktarevic, Brandonn Bueno, Malcolm Fry, and Damian Rivera have helped lead Revs II to a league-leading 10 goals scored through the first three matches of the 2023 season.

Bajraktarevic made his pro debut with Revolution II in August 2021 and signed his Homegrown deal in May 2022. Since then, the 18-yearold midfielder has made 30 appearances, netting three goals and two assists at the MLS NEXT Pro level.



Bueno and Fry both made their pro debuts with New England's second team last season with Fry tallying his first professional goal in September 2022 vs. Orlando City B. Bueno earned his first pro tally last weekend, drawing a penalty in the box and burying the penalty kick opportunity vs. Union II in the 89th minute of the match.

Rivera signed his Homegrown contract in November 2019 and continues to dominate with Revolution II when called upon, logging a goal and assist vs. Union II on Monday.

Fry and Rivera each own one assist so far this season with another Academy standout tallying a helper early in the season. 15-year-old Peyton Miller became the youngest player to make his pro debut with Revs II on March 26 vs. Atlanta United 2 and recorded his first pro assist on Rivera's goal vs. Union il on April 10.



New England's firepower has also been bolstered by Jordan Adebayo-Smith's two goals while Pierre Cayet and Jake Rozhansky each own one goal on the year from the team's season opener. # PAVING THE PATHWAY: BUENO AND FRY BECOME FIRST 2023 SIGNINGS

At the start of the offseason, Revolution II made two signings directly from the Revolution Academy in Malcolm Fry and Brandonn Bueno.



Fry, 17, signed on October 28, 2022 and was a standout in the Revolution Academy since he joined the program in 2019. The Groton, Mass. native scored six goals in 12 games with the Under-17 team in 2021-22, before joining the Under-19s ahead of the postseason. Fry scored the game-winning goal in the U-19s regular season finale to send the squad to the MLS NEXT Cup Playoffs, where he scored three goals, including the winning tally in the U-19 Quarterfinals, as he helped the Revolution secure its first national championship title.

Fry made his professional debut with New England's second team on March 27, 2022, totaling eight appearances on the season. He scored his first professional goal in his first career start on September 2 vs. Orlando City B.



Bueno, 18, joined the Revolution Academy in 2016 and was also a part of the U-19 MLS NEXT Cup Championship-winning team last year, scoring two goals across 19 games played in the regular season. The midfielder made seven appearances and logged 100 minutes with Revolution II in 2022, registering his professional debut on July 31 vs. Toronto FC II.

Fry and Bueno became the seventh and eighth Academy players to sign with Revolution II since the team's inaugural season alongside Esmir Bajraktarevic, Noel Buck, Hikaru Fujiwara, Colby Quiñones, Dennis Ramirez, and Meny Silva.

# MAX WEINSTEIN SIGNS WITH REVOLUTION II

On March 20, the club announced the second-team signing of the Revolution Academy's U-19 goalkeeper, Max Weinstein, as the 17th professional signing of the 2023 season.



After participating in one of the club's Elite Player Pathway camps, Weinstein joined the Revolution Academy in 2020 and was part of the U-19 MLS NEXT Cup Championship-winning team last summer. He started all five playoff matches, backstopping New England to its first MLS NEXT national title, while winning Goalkeeper of the Tournament honors after securing a clean sheet in the Final. The 18-year-old made his professional debut with New England's second team on July 31, 2022 vs. Toronto FC II and went on to make 33 saves across eight MLS NEXT Pro starts in net.

# CLINT PEAY



Clint Peay is in his fourth season as the first head coach of Revolution II, the New England Revolution's developmental side that began play in USL League One in 2020, following his appointment to the position on Nov. 20, 2019. Peay brings more than 18 years of coaching experience to the club with a focus on youth player development including an eight-year tenure working in the U.S. Youth National Team program and 10 years as a collegiate head coach and assistant.

Peay spent the 2019 season as an assistant coach with USL Championship side North Carolina FC, where he worked alongside Dave Sarachan and helped guide the club to an Eastern Conference playoff berth. An experienced scout and evaluator of up-and-coming talent, Peay worked on U.S. Soccer's technical staff from 2012-19, beginning as a member of the Under-17 staff. He was later named head coach of the U-14 Boys' National Team in 2016, before advancing to manage the U-15 Boys' National Team in 2018, where he succeeded current Revolution Assistant Coach Dave van den

Bergh in that role.

Prior to joining U.S. Soccer, Peay built his resume over four coaching stints at the collegiate level, including four seasons as head coach at Richmond University from 2009-12. He began his coaching career as an assistant at Georgetown University in 2003, before moving on to Davidson College from 2004-07, where he helped the Wildcats to back-to-back appearances in the conference final in his first two seasons. He later worked as an assistant coach with George Mason in 2008, helping guide the Patriots to the Colonial Athletic Association conference title in 2008.

A proven winner at the game's highest levels, Peay enjoyed a decorated playing career spanning a decade from his collegiate days at the University of Virginia (1991-95) through five MLS seasons with D.C. United (1996-2000).



# MARCELO SANTOS ASSISTANT COACH

Marcelo Santos is in his fourth season as assistant coach of Revolution II and his fourth with the club, having spent 2018-19 as a head coach in the New England Revolution Academy. Before being promoted to the Revolution II staff, Santos was head coach of the Under-19 team after serving as the head coach of the Under-17 team during the 2017-18 season.

Prior to joining the Revolution Academy, San-

tos served as an assistant for Marquette University, where he coached for 10 seasons. He also spent years as a U.S. Soccer Federation network scout, responsible for identifying and evaluating potential U.S. Youth National Team players in Milwaukee and Chicago, conducting training evaluations for U.S. Development Academy clubs, and conducting training centers for players with international potential.

Santos joined Marquette as a volunteer assistant in 2008 and served in that role for four seasons prior to being promoted to full-time assistant on head coach Louis Bennett's staff. While coaching at Marquette, Santos saw the Eagles claim two BIG EAST regular season titles (2011, 2013), a BIG EAST tournament championship (2013), and two NCAA tournament appearances (2012, 2013). In 2011, Marquette's coaching staff was named BIG EAST Coaching Staff of the Year. At least a dozen of Santos' players went on to play professionally including Columbus Crew SC defender Axel Sjöberg, Austin Bold FC midfielder Calum Mallace, New York City FC goalkeeper Luis Barraza, New York Red Bulls defender Patrick Seagrist, and former LAFC, Seattle Sounders, and current MLS Pool goalkeeper Charlie Lyon.

In 2016, Santos served as head coach of Kokomo Mantis FC of the Premier Development League. In their lone season, Santos led Mantis FC to a 4-6-4 record and fourth place finish in the Heartland Division of the PDL Central Division.



# YUTA NOMURA GOALKEEPER COACH

Yuta Nomura is in his fourth season as the goalkeeper coach for Revolution II, the New England Revolution's developmental side, following his appointment to the position on Feb. 3, 2020. Nomura spent the 2017-19 seasons tutoring goalkeepers on the coaching staff at the University of Central Arkansas in NCAA Division I.

In Nomura's first season at Central Arkansas, he was part of a coaching staff than collectively won the Missouri

sas, he was part of a coaching staff than collectively won the Missouri Valley Conference Coaching Staff of the Year award. Central Arkansas finished 8-6-4 overall in 2018, including 4-1-1 in conference play. Nomura helped guide UCA to a 2018 Missouri Valley Conference title and a berth in the D-I NCAA Men's Soccer Tournament. After switching to the Sun Belt Conference in 2019, Nomura stayed on staff to help guide the Bears to a Sun Belt Conference regular season title with a 4-1 league record and a 10-7-1 finish overall.

Prior to his coaching days, the native of Tokyo, Japan spent parts of two seasons playing professionally in Sweden for BK Olympic, based out of Malmö, from 2017-18. In his first season, he helped lead the club to promotion back to the Västra Götaland followed by a ninth-place finish in Tier 4 for the 2018 season.

Nomura played collegiately for NAIA school Lindsey Wilson College in Columbia, Kentucky where he majored in communications. As a freshman in 2011, Nomura started all 23 games for the Blue Raiders, leading the team to an NAIA National Title and an undefeated season. That year, he set career-highs in save percentage (.838), shutouts (14), goals allowed (12), and saves (62).

# CURT ONALFO TECHNICAL DIRECTOR



Curt Onalfo is entering his fifth season as Technical Director of the New England Revolution after his appointment to the position on June 2, 2019. In his role, Onalfo works closely with Sporting Director Bruce Arena managing the club's day-to-day soccer operations, including oversight of Revolution II, the Revolution Academy, and the scouting department.

Since arriving in New England, Onalfo spearheaded the launch of Revolution II ahead of its inaugural season in USL League One in 2020, elevating the club's player development process by providing a fully defined pathway from the Academy to the professional ranks, facilitating growth through higher-level competition and a professional structure. In its three seasons, Revolution II paved the way for 42 players to make their professional soccer debuts, including 25 current and former Revolution Academy members.

Onalfo has overseen a renaissance in the club's Academy following the establishment of the new MLS NEXT Academy league. In two seasons, the Revolution Under-15 team reached the 2021 MLS NEXT Cup Quarterfinals and the Revolution Under-19 side won the 2022 MLS NEXT Cup National Championship. In addition, eight Revolution Academy players have signed directly to Revolution II and three additional players have been inked to Homegrown Player contracts with the first team side.

The Sao Paulo, Brazil native and Ridgefield, Conn. Product brings his experience to the Revolution following an extensive coaching and playing career in Major League Soccer and with the United States Men's National Team. He owns 13 years of MLS coaching experience, highlighted by stints as head coach of D.C. United (2010), the Kansas City Wizards (2007-09), and the LA Galaxy (2017).

While continuing as an assistant with the Galaxy, he also served as the inaugural head coach of USL Championship side LA Galaxy II from 2014-16, where he led the club to a Western Conference title in 2015. When he departed "Los Dos" to take over head coaching duties with the Galaxy first team, his overall record with the developmental side finished at 46-29-20.

On the international level, Onalfo spent six years as an assistant coach for the United States Men's National Team under Bruce Arena. He served as an assistant for the USMNT from 2002-07 – including at the 2002 and 2006 FIFA Men's World CupTM – and also worked as an assistant with the U.S. Under-23 MNT in 2002. Prior to joining the Revolution, he most recently assisted the U.S. Under-20 Men's National Team from 2018 through May 2019, including in Poland at the FIFA U-20 Men's World CupTM, and briefly served as acting head coach of the U-19 side for a training camp in January 2019.

Onalfo, 51, entered the coaching ranks an assistant with D.C. United in 2000

following his retirement. He remained with the Black and Red until September 2002, briefly serving as interim head coach in 2001. After his time in the U.S. Men's National Team setup, Onalfo was appointed head coach of the Kansas City Wizards shortly after the 2006 FIFA Men's World Cup. He led Kansas City for two-and-a-half seasons, compiling a 27-29-22 record, and helped the club reach the postseason twice, including a Western Conference Finals appearance in 2007. In December 2009, Onalfo was named head coach of D.C. United, where he would remain for eight months before departing the club.

After starring as a defender at Ridgefield High School in Connecticut, Onalfo

played collegiately for Bruce Arena at the University of Virginia from 1987-1990. In four seasons as a defender with the Cavaliers, he earned a pair of All-ACC First Team selections and helped the team win the 1988 ACC Championship. Onalfo was selected by the LA Galaxy in the inaugural MLS Draft and would make 13 appearances for the club in 1996, helping it reach the first ever MLS Cup. The defender went on to register 23 appearances across four seasons in MLS, spending additional time with San Jose (1997) and D.C. United (1998-99). He recorded one international cap with the U.S. Men's National Team and featured extensively at the youth level, including the 1989 FIFA World Youth Championship, the 1991 Pan American Games, and the 1992 Summer Olympics.

Onalfo's journey took a detour soon after the 1992 Olympics, when a diagnosis of stage three Hodgkin's disease at the age of 24 disrupted his career and nearly ended his life. After surviving his arduous battle with cancer, Onalfo resumed his playing career with Connecticut and then Mexican side Tampico FC, before joining the Galaxy for the inaugural MLS season.

# BRUCE ARENA SPORTING DIRECTOR



Bruce Arena is in his fifth season as Sporting Director and Head Coach of the New England Revolution after his appointment to the position on May 14, 2019. The five-time MLS Cup winner is the eighth head coach in club history and oversees all soccer operations for the New England Revolution, including head coaching duties, roster management, scouting, and the oversight of Revolution II and the Revolution Academy.

In his first four seasons at the helm in New England, Arena has led the side to three MLS Cup Playoff appearances. His .601 winning percentage with New England entering 2022 is the best of any manager in the club's history. In 2021, Arena won his record fourth Supporters' Shield, the first in Revolution history, after guiding the team to 22 wins, 73 points, and 2.15 points per game – all MLS records. For his efforts, Arena was awarded with his league-leading fourth MLS Coach of the Year honor.

In 2022, Arena became the all-time winningest head coach in MLS history. New England's victory on March 5, 2022 gave Arena his 241st career victory in MLS regular season play, surpassing Sigi Schmid for the most in league history. Arena reached 250 career wins on October 1, 2022, the first coach in the history of MLS to do so.

In 2020, his first full season in New England, Arena led the Revolution to the Eastern Conference Final. Arena's impact in New England was immediatley evident upon his arrival in Foxborough. Arena made his return to the MLS postseason in 2019 by leading one of the most remarkable turnarounds in league history. After a 2-8-2 start had the Revolution sitting in last place in MLS, Arena went unbeaten in his first eight games at the helm and helped New England reach the postseason, ending a three-year drought for the club. The team's historic renaissance came despite Arena only making one in-season addition to the roster, bringing in Argentine striker Gustavo Bou via a club-record transfer in July.

The Long Island, N.Y. native joined the Revolution with one of the most decorated coaching careers in American soccer history that has spanned more than 40 seasons at the collegiate, professional, and international levels. Arena's MLS resume includes a record five MLS Cup titles, four Supporters' Shields, seven conference championships, one U.S. Open Cup title, and one Concacaf Champions' Cup. He has reached the MLS Cup final in seven of his 16 seasons coaching in the league. Arena has earned three MLS Coach of the Year selections, tied for the most all-time, first winning the honor in 1997 with D.C. United before being recognized in 2009 and 2011 with the LA Galaxy.

With 285 combined regular season and postseason wins in MLS entering the 2022 season, and a regular season record of 250-147-124 (.598), Arena is the league's all-time winningest head coach and owns the best winning percentage in MLS history. Arena is the league's all-time leader in MLS Cup Playoff games coached with 55 (35-13-7), while his 35 playoff wins are also the most in league history.

On the international stage, Arena, 71, coached the U.S. Men's National Team over two separate stints from 1998-2006 and 2016-17, amassing the most wins in the program's history with a record of 81-35-32. He led the Stars and Stripes to a Quarterfinal finish in the 2002 FIFA Men's World Cup – the country's best showing since 1930 – as well an appearance in the 2006 FIFA Men's World Cup. Arena also guided the U.S. Men's National Team to more Gold Cup titles than any other coach, capturing the continental trophy three times in 2002, 2005, and 2017.

Before his time in the professional ranks, Arena began his head coaching career with one season at the University of Puget Sound (1976), before being named the head coach at the University of Virginia in 1978. During his decorated 18-year tenure at Virginia, he led the Cavaliers to five NCAA Division-1 National Championships, including four in a row from 1991-94, as well as six ACC Men's Soccer titles (1988, 1991-95). While at Virginia, Arena coached a number of American soccer legends, including Claudio Reyna, John Harkes, and current D.C. United Head Coach Ben Olsen.

In 1996, Arena received an offer to lead the United States Under-23 Men's National Team in the 1996 Summer Olympics in Atlanta. Shortly after the Olympics, he assumed the head role with D.C. United, where he led the Black-and-Red to a 61-35 record, including the first two MLS Cup titles in 1996 and 1997, and the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup title in 1996.

Following the 1998 FIFA Men's World Cup in France, the United States Soccer Federation turned to Arena, who helped the team qualify for the 2002 FIFA Men's World Cup. In the tournament, Arena's team recorded an impressive win over powerhouse Portugal and topped Mexico, 2-0, in the Round of 16 en route to thenation's first appearance in the Quarterfinals in a 72-year span. That same year, Arena led the USMNT to the Concacaf Gold Cup title, one of his three triumphs in the competition. In 2005, Arena won his second Concacaf Gold Cup ahead of the 2006 FIFA Men's World Cup in Germany. In the 2006 tournament, the United

States earned a 1-1 draw against Italy, but a 2-1 defeat to Ghana sent the USMNT home early.

The next season, Arena took charge of the New York Red Bulls, where he spent the end of the 2006 season and all of the 2007 campaign. In 2008, Arena joined the LA Galaxy for what would be an incredible nine-year tenure that included three MLS Cups in a four-year span and two Supporters' Shields in 2010 and 2011. Following his decorated career with the Galaxy, Arena rejoined the U.S. Men's National Team in November 2016. In his second run as head coach, he lost only two out of 18 games at the helm, though the United States fell short of qualification for the 2018 FIFA Men's World Cup. A 2010 National Soccer Hall of Fame inductee, Arena was named the 2015 Werner Fricker Builder Award recipient, earning U.S. Soccer's highest honor for his more than 40 years of service to the game.

A talented lacrosse player, Arena grew up on Long Island and would go on to attend Nassau Community College, where he played both lacrosse and soccer. Arena then transferred to Cornell University in 1971, where as a goalkeeper, he led his team to the 1972 NCAA College Cup Final Four and earned the tournament's Most Valuable Defensive Player award. During the 1973 season, Arena contributed as an assistant coach with Cornell, before then accepting a head coaching positionat the University of Puget Sound.

Off the field, Arena has authored a number of books and is a member of the NJCAA Lacrosse Hall of Fame, after receiving induction in 2008. He and his wife, Phyllis, live in Boston. Arena's son, Kenny, was an assistant coach under his father with the LA Galaxy from 2014-16 and is now an assistant coach with FC Cincinnati.
