



It is with great pleasure that we welcome you to beautiful Truist Field in Uptown Charlotte. As we begin our tenth year in this nationally-renowned ballpark and 25th year as affiliates of the Chicago White Sox, we're excited about the season ahead for the 2023 Charlotte Knights. Even more than usual, there's a lot of new things that you'll get to experience over the next several months.

When it comes to Truist Field itself, there are changes large and small that will help enhance your experience here before, during, and even after the game. Prior to each game, you'll notice enhanced entertainment, new food and beverage areas, and, of course, brand new merchandise with the refreshed, Charlotte Blue logo. The entertainment will include live music and activities each night as soon as you walk through the main gates at Mint and MLK. As you enjoy them, you can pick up your favorite beverage and snack at our new Grab & Go stand immediately to the right of the entrance gates. Before or during the game, be sure stop by the Knights Team Store to check out the wide selection of new logo hats, jerseys, t-shirts, and more.

On the field, the Knights will be under the direction of new manager, Justin Jirschele. The Wisconsin native played for the Knights in 2014-15 and most recently guided the Double-A Birmingham Barons in the White Sox system. He's looking forward to leading the Knights into contention for the 2023 International League title. As he does, it will be even more important for the Knights to get off to a good start as the league season will be split into two halves. The team with the best record in the league after the games of June 24 will be the first half champion. With that crown, the first half winner will get the right to host a three-game league championship series September 26-28.

In a final note, construction is being finished on The Paper Mill Pub here at Truist Field. Once completed, fans will be able to enjoy beverages and food offerings in the renovated space before and after Knights' games. The Pub will also be open year-round and provide an option for people living in the neighborhood and those in Uptown attending sporting events and other entertainment options. We look to be open in a matter of weeks, so get ready to check out the newest hangout on successive trips to Truist Field and Uptown.



Matt Zaleski PITCHING COACH

Zaleski, 41, returns to the Knights in 2023 as the team's pitching coach. This will be Zaleski's fourth season as the Knights' Pitching Coach. He began his coaching career in 2016 as pitching coach for Great Falls (Rookie). He later spent 2017 as the pitching coach for Kannapolis and the 2018-19 seasons as pitching coach at Winston-Salem. Before his time as a pitching coach, the Arlington Heights, IL native appeared in a total of 316 games as a minor league pitcher (2004-14). He spent six of his 11 minor league seasons as a pitcher with the Knights from 2009-2014. He is the all-time leader in Knights franchise history in games started (74) and he also ranks second in franchise history in innings pitched (437.2).

Seitzer, a native of Overland Park, KS, enters his fifth season with the White Sox organization and first with Charlotte in 2023. The 33-year-old spent the 2022 season with Kannapolis as the team's hitting coach. Previously, he spent one season as the hitting coach at Double-A Birmingham (2021) and one season in the same capacity at Great Falls (2019). As a player, the University of Oklahoma product played eight seasons in the minors from 2011-18 and combined to hit .270 (636-for-2359). His final two playing seasons were spent in the White Sox organization (2017-18). His father, former All-Star Kevin Seitzer, played 12 major league seasons with Kansas City, Milwaukee, Cleveland and Oakland.

The Charlotte Knights began a new era in franchise history back on Tuesday, November 1, 2022 by unveiling a brand refresh featuring a new logo set and jerseys for the 2023 season. In front of nearly 600 season membership holders and corporate partners, the Knights showed off the new logo, colors and on-field jerseys. Members of the 2022 Charlotte Knights team, pitchers Mike Wright and Jason Bilous, as well as Chicago White Sox assistant outfield/baserunning coordinator, Mike Daniel, donned the new uniforms in front of the excited crowd of fans.

Highlighting the team's brand refresh are a new primary logo, new home/road cap logo and an alternate helmet cap logo. In all, the Knights unveiled three new jerseys [home, road and alternate], three new on-field caps and a new identity fit for the Queen City. The team's brand

refresh showcases blue, a color synonymous with three other professional teams in Charlotte – the Carolina Panthers, Charlotte FC and the Charlotte Hornets. Knights Blue is the signature piece of the brand refresh. The logo also continues to feature Knights Gold, Knights Silver and Knights Black, colors synonymous with royalty.

“As we prepare to enter our tenth year back in the city of Charlotte, we thought it was the right time to make an even stronger connection,” said Knights’ General Manager Rob Egan. “It began with opening this beautiful ballpark in Uptown in 2014, continued with changing our official abbreviation to CLT in 2021, and is furthered by modernizing our brand and aligning with the palette of professional sports teams in Charlotte. Our new primary color, Knights Blue, is the right fit at the right time. It’s All Charlotte!”

The brand refresh was brought to life by David Ruckman of David C. Ruckman Creative. The development process began in November of 2021 when Ruckman started the early design phases with members of the Knights front office. Ruckman stated, “Words cannot express my gratitude at this point. “Even after my nine years working with the Charlotte Knights, we still find new ways to work, have fun and be creative together. It doesn’t get any better than that.”

KNIGHTS SPOTLIGHT

Justin Jirschele

Justin Jirschele, who played for the Charlotte Knights over parts of two seasons (2014-15), will manage the Charlotte Knights for the 2023 campaign. Jirschele, 32, is the 24th manager in franchise history and the third former Knights player to manage the team joining both Joel Skinner and Nick Capra. Skinner, the all-time winningest manager in franchise history, played for the Knights in 1994 and managed the club for four seasons from 2012-2015. Capra played for the Knights in 1995 and managed the team for three seasons from 2002-2004.

A native of Clintonville, WI, Jirschele enters his seventh season in the Chicago White Sox organization and first as manager of the Knights. He made his Double-A managerial debut in 2021 with the Birmingham Barons and guided the club to a 62-56 record, falling just a half game shy of clinching a postseason berth. In two






