MATCH PREVIEW: Following their first win of the 2022 USL Championship campaign on March 23, LA Galaxy II (1-2-0, 3 points) travel to face Indy Eleven at Michael A. Carroll Stadium on Saturday, April 2 at 4:00 p.m. PT. The match against Indy will feature a live stream on ESPN+.

In the win over Rio Grande Valley FC Toros on March 23, Taylor Davila scored the game-winning goal, his first of the season, while goalkeeper Eric López tallied two saves and a shutout in his first appearance of 2022. Notably, Davila was named to the USL Championship Team of the Week for Week 3 after tallying the game-winning goal. In its last match, Indy Eleven played Louisville City FC to a 1-1 draw on March 26.

During the 2021 USL Championship regular season, LA Galaxy II (11-15-6, 39 points) finished in sixth place in the Western Conference's Pacific Division, missing out on qualifying for the playoffs by three points. As a team, Los Dos finished tied for sixth in the league in goals scored (55). Judd finished the season as the club's leader in goals scored (17) in 32 games played, finishing sixth in the league in that category. Josh Drack led the team and ranked tied for fifth in the league in assists (9). Notably, Judd's 18 career goals scored in 35 games played (30 starts) for Galaxy II ranks sixth in team history.

LA Galaxy II Head Coach Yoann Damet begins his first season managing the club, after being announced on Jan. 28, 2022. Damet most recently served as an assistant coach for the U-20 United States National Team that participated in the Revelations Cup in November of 2021.

Eighteen players have contracts with LA Galaxy II. Five of those players are products of the LA Galaxy Academy: Alex Alcalá, Taylor Davila, Adrian Gonzalez, Eric López and Victor Valdez.

Eight new additions have been signed to LA Galaxy II ahead of the 2022 campaign: goalkeeper Eric López, defenders Dante Campbell, Liam Doyle and Chandler Vaughn, midfielders Hamza Barry, Callum Johnson and Duhaney Williams and forward Michael Salazar. Johnson and Vaughn were originally drafted by the LA Galaxy in the 2022 MLS SuperDraft. Doyle (San Antonio FC) and Salazar (Memphis 901 FC) join from the USL Championship, while Campbell joins Galaxy II from Toronto FC II. Williams was signed as a free agent on March 11 and played for Loyola Marymount University.

Sunday's match marks the first-ever meeting between LA Galaxy II and Indy Eleven. In 237 games played in the USL Championship dating back to their inaugural campaign in 2014, LA Galaxy II hold a record of 91-94-52. The 2022 USL Championship campaign marks LA Galaxy II's ninth and final season in the USL Championship before moving to MLS NEXT Pro in 2023.

LA Galaxy II Postgame Notes: LA Galaxy II 1, Rio Grande Valley FC Toros 0 – Wednesday, March 23, 2022

LOS ANGELES (Wednesday, March 23, 2022) – Playing their third match of the 2022 USL Championship Regular Season, LA Galaxy II earned their first victory of the year with a 1-0 shutout win over Rio Grande Valley FC Toros at Dignity Health Sports on Wednesday night. Taylor Davila scored the game-winning goal, his first of the season, while goalkeeper Eric López tallied two saves and a shutout in his first appearance of 2022.

Goal-Scoring Plays

LA – Taylor Davila, 45th minute: After Rio Grande Valley defender Jesus Vazquez was whistled for a handball inside the penalty area, Preston Judd’s right-footed shot was parried away by Toros goalkeeper Colin Martin. Taylor Davila was first to the rebound and fired his shot into the back of the net.

Postgame Notes

- The win over Rio Grande Valley FC marked LA Galaxy II’s first win of the 2022 campaign.
- Head Coach Yoann Damet won his first match in charge of LA Galaxy II.
- Wednesday’s match marked the 11th match played all-time between LA and Rio Grande Valley, with *Los Dos* leading the series 6-0-5.
- LA Galaxy II have scored in three of their three games, no team has done so more often in the USL Championship this season.
- Eric López registered two saves and notched his first shutout of the season in the win over RGVFC.
- Taylor Davila tallied his first goal of the 2022 campaign.
- Davila finished the match with a game-high four chances created.
- Owen Lambe finished the match with a game-high three tackles won.
- Three LA Galaxy II players made season debuts: Eric López, Ascel Essengue and Axel Picazo.
- Duhaney Williams made his first professional start for LA Galaxy II.
