IXI NEWS & NOTES

- ★ Despite both teams' inaugural seasons coming in 2014, tonight's matchup marks the first time the two clubs have faced off. LA Galaxy II was founded in 2014 and began play in the USL Championship (then called the USL Pro) that same year, while Indy Eleven was founded in 2013, but didn't join the USL Championship until the 2018 season after four years in the NASL. This will also mark the squads' last meeting, as LA Galaxy II are set to join the MLS Next PRO Div. III league in 2023.
- ★ Fans will see a familiar face suited up for LA Galaxy II on Saturday, as defender Liam Doyle will return to Carroll Stadium. Doyle appeared in three games for the Boys in Blue during the 2021 season after being loaned here from USL Championship side San Antonio FC on September 13. Indy's roster includes one ex "Los Dos" performer in midfielder Bryam Rebellón. The Colombian footballer played for LA Galaxy II during the 2016 season, appearing in 24 contests and scoring twice.
- ★ Indy Eleven has split its previous eight home openers with a 2W-2L-4D all-time mark. That ledger includes four consecutive draws during its first stint at Carroll Stadium in the NASL era and a 0-2 defeat to FC Tulsa in last year's return to "The Mike" after a three-season run at Lucas Oil Stadium.
- ★ Three players missed last weekend's match for Indy Eleven against Louisville City FC, as MF Neveal Hackshaw and DF Noah Powder departed midweek to join their Trinidad and Tobago National Team mates, while DF Alex McQueen did the same for Grenada. "Hack" and Powder played in friendlies against Barbados and Guyana while McQueen's Grenada took on Gibraltar (yes, like the rock) and Andorra.
- ★ U.S. Open Cup play will begin for Indy Eleven this upcoming Tuesday, April 5. The club will host St. Louis City SC II in its opening match of the tournament. Specially-priced tickets for the match can be bought for \$5 & \$11 at the Carroll Stadium Box Office and at indyeleven.com/tickets.

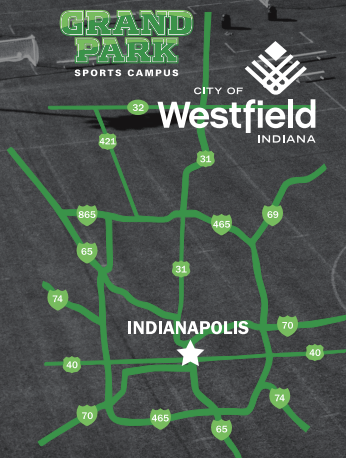

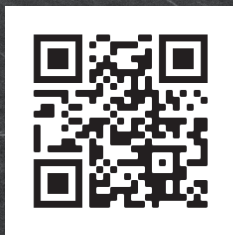

Boys in Blue, Old and New

Get to Know the 2022 Edition of Indy Eleven

The ninth edition of Indy Eleven for this 2022 USL Championship season features some familiar faces - but many more new ones, several of whom have already introduced themselves on the field through the squad's first three matches. With so many changes, a rundown of the roster is in order to familiarize fans with the comings and goings for Indiana's Team this past offseason ...

Coach Brings Quartet in Tow: The Boys in Blue welcome a new head coach this season in Mark Lowry, who became the fourth permanent head coach in club history last November. The England native has spent the last three years with El Paso Locomotive FC, which improved its record across each of their first three seasons of play. Prior to that, Lowry became familiar with Carroll Stadium as the head coach of the NASL's Jacksonville Armada FC in 2016-17.

Of the 29 players currently on the roster, Lowry brought 17 new faces to the Circle City for 2022. While many of those additions were unfamiliar, he does have some longtime lieutenants in tow both on the field in defender Mechack Jérôme and midfielder Bryam Rebellón and on the sideline in Assistant Coach Matt Williams and Director of Sports Performance Gabe Zapponi. All four were a part of Lowry's setups in both Jacksonville and El Paso, the latter where they helped Locomotive FC to three straight playoff appearances - including spots in the Western Conference Finals in 2019 & 2020.



KNOW YOUR BOYS IN BLUE

Familiar Faces: Although, we have a lot of new faces joining the team for the 2022 campaign, you'll still recognize some of the dozen returnees – especially Indy's seven "senior" roster players. That group Indy's two captains – Spanish midfielder Ayoze and Trinidad & Tobago international Neveal Hackshaw. Ayoze's five assists last season helped him lead the squad in the category for the fourth time in as many seasons, proving the team's elder statesman still has plenty in the tank. After performing as one of the league's top outside defenders, fans will get to see Hackshaw in a new role at the deep lying spot in Lowry's diamond midfield formation.

Like Ayoze, defender Karl Quimette returns to the Boys in Blue for a club-record tying fifth consecutive season, equaling club original Brad Ring in longevity with Indiana's Team. Alongside Karl are defenders A.J. Cochran and Butler grad Jared Timmer, both of whom will spend their second season with the team.

Manuel Arteaga returns as the only forward from the 2021 campaign to rejoin the Eleven. Last season Arteaga accumulated 10 goals and two assists, making him the lead scorer for the Boys in Blue. Arteaga will look for service from veteran English midfielder Nicky Law (three goals, one assist in 2021), with both returning for year two in blue.

New Boys in Blue: Seventeen new players are a lot for a team to take on during offseason. However, their indoctrination has been swift, as 12 made their debut in Indy Eleven's 2022 opener on March 12 at Loudoun United FC – eight in the starting XI and four off the bench in the second half. Those that have not yet seen the field in the first three games of the regular season did so across the team's eight preseason friendlies, allowing all newcomers to get some familiarity with each other and Lowry's new system.

Elliot Panicco may already be a familiar name with the fans, especially after the first meet up with rival Louisville City FC last Saturday, when Panicco's five saves helped land him on the USL Team of the Week. Panicco made a good first impression at Loudoun too, as he was nominated for the USL Save of the Week after making a PK save late in the match. Panicco enters the weekend tied for second across the USL Championship with 11 saves from three matches.

Also in Indy's defensive unit, Alex McQueen and Noah Powder join Mechack Jérôme as those who look to be major contributors. McQueen is an England native and Grenada international who will return this weekend after playing twice for the Spice Boys last week in Europe. Powder started the squad's first two games, but he along with Hackshaw were absent from the LouCity draw after being called up to Trinidad & Tobago's National Team. Jérôme is no newcomer to his international duty either, as his 77 appearances rank third for Haiti all-time.

Indy Eleven's roster has also added many new midfielders, including Indy's own Justin Ingram, who has started in two of the three matches so far. Along with him is Norwegian playmaker Jonas Fjeldberg, who has also appeared in all three matches and was voted by fans as the Man of the Match against Tampa Bay in Week 2. Raul Aguilera is familiar with Lowry after playing under the Eleven's new sideline boss with Orlando City's Academy team, the duo reuniting after nearly a decade. Finally, Sam Brown responded well in his first start of the season last weekend in Louisville, and the former Real Monarchs midfielder is expected to continue challenging for minutes while providing experienced depth in his fourth professional season.

Joining Arteaga up top is Stefano Pinho, a name the Indy Eleven faithful should remember after the two-time NASL Most Valuable Player terrorized the Eleven during stints with Minnesota United and Fort Lauderdale Strikers during Indy's early seasons. Brown's Real Monarchs teammate Aris Briggs has started two of three contests and will be tasked alongside Pinho in producing in attack while Arteaga starts the season rehabbing from a late preseason injury. Newcomer Rodney Michael impressed enough during the preseason and became the latest member of the squad less than two weeks ago.

Academy Players: The Indy Eleven also sees a mix of old (relative term) and new in its crop of seven Academy Contract players. Returning to the team after contributing to its 2021 USL Academy League Championship squad are goalkeeper Alex Svetanoff, defender Ecris Revolorio, and midfielders Aiden Benitez and Diego Sanchez. The latter three return for a second season while the Crown Point native Svetanoff is in his third stint with the senior team. Accompanying those returning players are a few newcomers in defender Bryce Warhaft and forwards Luca Iaccino and Palmer Ault - who has already made two late-game appearances.

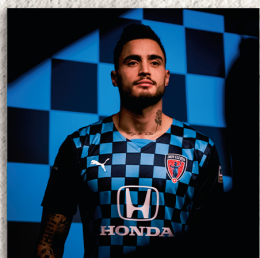

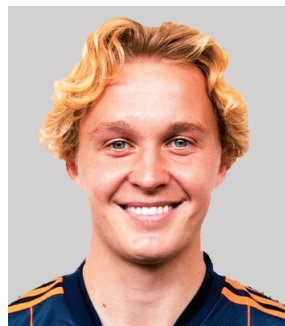

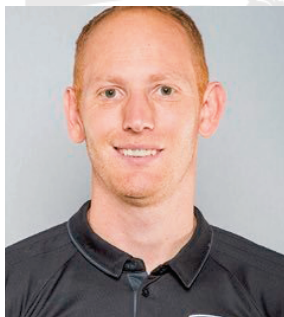
