He was named the top goalkeeper in the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference on three occasions and was named to three All-Atlantic Region Teams.

Hunter returns for his fourth season as the Riverhounds star goalkeeper. Gilstrap, the USL-2 Goalkeeper of the Year in 2010, helped the Riverhounds produce the stingiest defense in the USL-2 during the 2010 campaign, by allowing the fewest goals in the League. A veteran of the USL Division, Gilstrap joins the Riverhounds coming from the Cleveland City Stars. Gilstrap was drafted with the 13th overall pick in the 2006 USL-1 Draft by Miami FC. He then transferred to the Cleveland City Stars in 2007, appearing in 20 regular season games in two seasons with the team, leading them to the USL Second Division championship in

2008. In 2009, Gilstrap finished among the top seven goalkeepers in four statistical categories, including saves and shutouts.

His dedication to the club, specifically within the Riverhounds Academy, has made him a fan-favorite in Pittsburgh. Katic will be looked at to provide tenacity in the back. Before coming to the Riverhounds, Katic was top defender for the Springfield Demize and he also played for the Chicago Fire, both in the USL Premier Developmental League. He came to the United States from Croatia to attend Western Illinois University, where he majored in marketing and was a two-year starter and captain. In 2006, Katic was honored as n NJCAA All-American after he scored 5 goals and had 8 assists. In college, Katic was selected to the All-Summit League Second Team, named to the All-Summit League All-Tournament Team and to the NSCAA/Adidas All-Midwest Regional Team.

His rookie campaign was spent with the Minnesota Thunder in 2009, with having 20 appearances. In the 2012 season, the Hounds used Costanzo's tenacious style of play in the center of the field which allowed him to have creativity and record 2 goals and 1 assist. Costanzo went to Thomas Jefferson High School where he led the team to three consecutive state championship games.

In his three seasons at Liberty, Amoo recorded 37 goals in 58 games and earned Big South honors each year.

Kerr then returned to Germany and played 19 matches and scored 4 goals for SC Wiedenbrück of the Fußball-Regionalliga West.
