YESTERDAY: After a rainout on Friday night, the Flying Squirrels opened the 2023 season with a doubleheader sweep over the Fightin Phils. In Game 1, the Fightin Phils opened an early 3-0 lead, but the Flying Squirrels closed the gap with an RBI double by **Patrick Bailey** in the third. **Luis Matos** tied the game with a two-run homer in the fifth inning. **Ismael Munguia** broke the tie in the sixth with a bases-loaded walk. **Blake Rivera** closed out the save in the seventh for a 4-3 win. **Ryan Murphy** picked up the win after working two scoreless innings with five strikeouts. In Game 2, the Flying Squirrels took a 2-0 lead in the first inning with a pair of bases-loaded walks. **Tyler Fitzgerald** extended the lead to 3-0 with an RBI single in the fifth inning. **Nick Zwack** struck out nine batters over four scoreless innings and **Wil Jensen** worked through the fifth and sixth without allowing a run. Reading put up two runs against **Randy Rodriguez** in the seventh, but **Juan Sanchez** worked out of a jam to close out a 3-2 win.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels wrap up a three-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series marks Reading's only trip to The Diamond in 2023. The Flying Squirrels will visit FirstEnergy Stadium for six games from June 28-July 3. The Flying Squirrels are searching for their first three-game sweep against the Fightin Phils since April 13-15, 2018 at The Diamond.

OPENING WITH THE FIGHTIN PHILS: Yesterday's opener marked the first time the Flying Squirrels have opened the season against Reading. Overall, the Flying Squirrels are now 4-6 when beginning the season against an opponent from the Northeast Division (formerly the Eastern Division). Richmond is 3-2 when opening against an affiliate of a National League club, with the only previous meetings coming against Hartford (Colorado Rockies) in 2016, 2017, 2019 and 2021. Richmond has now hosted Reading for three home openers and is 3-0 in those games.

TWO-FOR-TWO: With a doubleheader sweep on Saturday, the Flying Squirrels are 2-0 to begin the 2023 season. In the franchise's 13 seasons, they have started with a 2-0 record four times (2015, 2019, 2022 and 2023). The only 3-0 start for the Flying Squirrels came to open the 2019 season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS embark on a new season this weekend after qualifying for the postseason in 2022 for the first time in eight years, winning the Eastern League Southwest Division first-half title before being eliminated in the Division Series by Erie. Richmond went 66-71 overall, posting a 40-29 mark in the first half and a 26-42 record in the second half. Last year's team also set a franchise record with 169 homers, passing the previous mark of 127 set in 2021.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS went 61-77 last season, including a 29-40 record in the first half and a 32-37 mark in the second half. Reading's roster including five of Baseball America's top-30 Phillies prospects, including Mick Abel (No. 2), Johan Rojas (No. 5), Andrew Baker (No. 6), Ethan Wilson (No. 9) and Carlos De La Cruz (No. 20). Baseball America also rates Baron Radcliff as the organization's best power hitter and Rojas as the best defensive outfielder. MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects list includes Abel (No. 2), Rojas (No. 6), De La Cruz (No. 9), Wilson (No. 14) and Baker (No. 17). Philadelphia's No. 1 prospect, Andrew Painter, begins the year on Reading's 60-day IL.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Mason Black** makes his Double-A debut. A native of Scranton, Pa., Black was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University, where he was the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year as a junior. He made his professional debut last season with the Low-A San Jose Giants, posting a 1.57 ERA in eight starts. Black led the minors with a 0.35 ERA for the month of May last season and earned a promotion to High-A Eugene on May 24. For the season, he ranked fourth in the Giants organization with 136 strikeouts last year and was named an MLB.com Giants Organization All-Star. Black is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. **For more on Black, see page two.**

FOR READING: Left-hander Josh Hendrickson makes his season debut. He pitched at four levels in Philadelphia's system last year, including five starts with Reading. He has made 19 appearances, including 16 starts, with the Fightin Phils in his career dating back to 2021, going 4-6 with a 4.70 ERA. Hendrickson, a native of Perth, Australia, attended the University of San Diego and was selected in the 38th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Phillies. He was an MLB.com Phillies Organization All-Star in 2021 after working through three levels of the Phillies system in his first full professional season.

ZWACK AND ROLL: In his Double-A debut in Game 2 of Saturday's doubleheader, **Nick Zwack** recorded nine strikeouts over four scoreless innings while allowing one baserunner. His nine punchouts were tied for the second-most for a Flying Squirrels pitcher in his Double-A debut, even with **Chase Johnson** on August 21, 2015 and **Kyle Harrison** on May 27, 2022. **Eric Surkamp** holds the franchise record with 10 from his debut on April 8, 2011.

GOING DEEP: With his two-run homer in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader, **Luis Matos** became the seventh player in franchise history to hit a home run in the Flying Squirrels' season-opener. **Mario Lissou** was the first with a two-run homer in 2014 at New Britain. **Ryder Jones** and **Ricky Oropesa** each homered in a loss at Hartford in 2016, the only multi-homer game for Richmond in a season-opener. **Chris Shaw** hit a two-run homer at The Diamond in 2017 against the Yard Goats. In 2018, **Dylan Davis** homered at Trenton. Last year at Bowie, **Brett Auerbach** became the first Flying Squirrels player in four years to hit a home run on Opening Day.

FULL MUNGUIA: After missing the entire 2022 season with an injury, **Ismael Munguia** got off to a hot start in his Double-A debut on Saturday. In Game 1 of the doubleheader, he led off the bottom of the first inning with a single to center for his first Double-A hit. He finished the game 2-for-3 with a walk, an RBI and a run scored. In Game 2, he went 1-for-3 with a walk and a run scored, reaching base five times in the doubleheader.

FAMILIAR FACES: This year's Opening Day roster includes 14 players who have previously spent time with the Flying Squirrels. Returners include pitchers **Matt Frisbee**, **Ryan Murphy**, **Kai-Wei Teng**, **Evan Gates**, **Randy Rodriguez**, **Wil Jensen**, **Chris Wright** and **Blake Rivera**, catcher **Brandon Martorano** and infielders **Tyler Fitzgerald**, **Carter Aldrete**, **Brett Auerbach**, **Riley Mahan** and **Simon Whiteman**.

FRESH FACES: Thirteen players on the Opening Day roster will be playing for Richmond for the first time. Newcomers to Richmond include pitchers **Nick Zwack**, **Erik Miller**, **Carson Seymour**, **Mason Black**, **Nick Swiney**, **Raymond Burgos**, **Michael Stryffeler**, **Juan Sanchez**, catchers **Andy Thomas** and **Patrick Bailey**, infielder **Hayden Cantrelle** and outfielders **Luis Matos** and **Ismael Munguia**. Of these players, only Miller and Stryffeler have previous experience at the Double-A level.

SQUIRRELS AROUND THE WORLD: The Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster includes players from five different countries. Two players, **Luis Matos** and **Juan Sanchez** were born in Venezuela. **Randy Rodriguez** is a native of the Dominican Republic. **Ismael Munguia** became the second player in team history born in Nicaragua with his debut on Saturday. **Raymond Burgos** was born in Puerto Rico and **Kai-Wei Teng** is from Taiwan. Twenty-one players are natives of the United States, spanning 16 different states, including a team-high four from California.

HOW THEY GOT HERE: Eighteen players were originally signed or drafted by the San Francisco Giants. Eleven players were selected in the MLB Draft, four were signed as international free agents and three were signed as non-drafted free agents. Two players were signed as minor league free agents after starting their careers in other organizations. **Riley Mahan**, previously with the Miami Marlins organization, was signed last May. **Raymond Burgos** signed in December after reaching free agency following seven years as a member of the Cleveland Guardians organization. Seven players were acquired via trade. **Kai-Wei Teng** came in a deal with the Minnesota Twins in 2019. **Hayden Cantrelle** was swapped from the Marlins in 2022. **Carson Seymour** and **Nick Zwack** came to the Giants in a trade with the New York Mets at the trade deadline last year, the same day **Andy Thomas** and **Michael Stryffeler** were traded from the Seattle Mariners. **Erik Miller** was traded from the Philadelphia Phillies in January.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Luis Matos** is ranked second in batting average (.600), tied for second in homers (1), second in OBP (.714), second in SLG (1.200), second in OPS (1.914), and tied for second in runs scored (4). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for third in batting average (.500), third in OBP (.667) and ninth in OPS (1.167). **Ismael Munguia** is tied for third in batting average (.500) and tied for fifth in OBP (.625). **Nick Zwack** is tied for second in strikeouts (9), 10th in BAA (.077) and tied for third in WHIP (0.25).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, **Luis Matos** (No. 5), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Erik Miller** (No. 15), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Nick Swiney** (No. 24), **Patrick Bailey** (No. 27) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Bailey (No. 11), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
