**SUNDAY:** The Flying Squirrels wrapped up the first series of the 2023 season and beat the Reading Fightin Phils, 7-3, at The Diamond. The win capped a three-game sweep. Reading took a 2-0 lead in the first inning with a homer by McCarthy Tatum. Cody Roberts added an RBI single in the second to open a 3-0 lead for the Fightin Phils. The Flying Squirrels scored five runs in the third to take the lead. **Brett Auerbach** hit an RBI single, **Patrick Bailey** scored on an error, **Brandon Martorano** tied the score with a sac fly, **Simon Whiteman** hit a go-ahead single and **Ismael Munguia** reached on an error to bring home **Hayden Cantrelle**. In the sixth, Auerbach added another RBI single and **Tyler Fitzgerald** hit an RBI double to open the lead to 7-3. **Mason Black** started and allowed three runs over four innings. **Nick Swiney** picked up his first Double-A win with three scoreless relief innings. **Matt Frisbee** and **Raymond Burgos** worked through the final two innings to close out the sweep.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels open a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. Tonight is Harrisburg's home opener. The only other season the Senators have played their first home series against the Flying Squirrels was 2021, with each team winning three games. Richmond won the first three, including a no-hitter by **Matt Frisbee** and three relievers on May 13, 2021. This year, the Flying Squirrels visit Harrisburg for two series. The will also play a three-game set at FNB Field from July 13-16 out of the All-Star Break. The Senators come to Richmond twice for two six-game series from June 20-25 and August 15-20.

**THREE'S COMPANY:** With a three-game sweep over the Fightin Phils last weekend, the Flying Squirrels are 3-0 to begin the 2023 season. In the franchise's 13 seasons, they have started with a 3-0 record one other time (2019). The Flying Squirrels have never started a season with a 4-0 record.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** continue the a new season this weekend after qualifying for the postseason in 2022 for the first time in eight years, winning the Eastern League Southwest Division first-half title before being eliminated in the Division Series by Erie. Richmond went 66-71 overall, posting a 40-29 mark in the first half and a 26-42 record in the second half. Last year's team also set a franchise record with 169 homers, passing the previous mark of 127 set in 2021.

**THE SENATORS** opened the season dropping two-of-three at Somerset last Friday and Saturday. Harrisburg's season-opener was rained out last Thursday. They lost, 6-5, on Friday before alternating shutouts in a doubleheader split on Saturday. In 2022, the Senators went 52-85, the worst record in the Eastern League. They went 30-39 in the first half and 22-46 in the second half. Harrisburg's roster includes six of Baseball America's Top-30 Nationals prospects, including Jackson Rutledge (No. 9), Mitchell Parker (No. 14), Evan Lee (No. 23), Drew Millas (No. 25), Gerardo Carrillo (No. 26) and Tim Cate (No. 28). The Senators' roster also features four of MLB.com's Top-30 Nationals prospects, including Jackson Rutledge (No. 11), Mitchell Parker (No. 24), Gerardo Carrillo (No. 28) and Drew Millas (No. 30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his season debut. Last year, he led the Eastern League and set a Richmond franchise record with 169 strikeouts. Over the last 2021 and 2022 seasons, Teng combined for 311 strikeouts, which was the fourth-most in the minor leagues during that span. For 2022 in his first Double-A season, Teng went 6-12 with a 5.22 ERA. He tied the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for the most starts in a season with 28. A native of Taiwan, Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins before being traded to the Giants at the deadline in 2019 along with RHP Prelander Berroa for RHP Sam Dyson. Prior to the 2023 season, Teng pitched for Chinese Taipei in the World Baseball Classic at Taichung Intercontinental Stadium in his hometown. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

**FOR HARRISBURG:** Left-hander Alex Troop makes his season debut. He spent most of last season with the Senators, going 7-5 with a 4.81 ERA in 20 outings (17 starts) and also worked one relief appearance for Triple-A Rochester. He made four appearances, including two starts, against Richmond in 2022. He made a start against the Flying Squirrels at FNB Field on June 15 and allowed one run over 4.2 innings. In his lone start at The Diamond, Troop set a season high with 10 strikeouts over five innings on September 1, allowing four runs on five hits. Troop was selected by the Nationals in the ninth round of the 2017 MLB Draft out of Michigan State. He first reached Double-A with Harrisburg near the end of the 2021 season. For his Double-A career, Troop is 7-5 with a 4.39 ERA in 39 appearances (17 starts).

**FULL MUNGUIA:** After missing the entire 2022 season with an injury, **Ismael Munguia** got off to a hot start in his Double-A debut on Saturday. In Game 1 of the doubleheader, he led off the bottom of the first inning with a single to center for his first Double-A hit. He finished the game 2-for-3 with a walk, an RBI and a run scored. In Game 2, he went 1-for-3 with a walk and a run scored, reaching base five times in the doubleheader.

**FAMILIAR FACES:** This year's Opening Day roster includes 14 players who have previously spent time with the Flying Squirrels. Returners include pitchers **Matt Frisbee, Ryan Murphy, Kai-Wei Teng, Evan Gates, Randy Rodriguez, Wil Jensen, Chris Wright** and **Blake Rivera**, catcher **Brandon Martorano** and infielders **Tyler Fitzgerald, Carter Aldrete, Brett Auerbach, Riley Mahan** and **Simon Whiteman**.

**FRESH FACES:** Thirteen players on the Opening Day roster will be playing for Richmond for the first time. Newcomers to Richmond include pitchers **Nick Zwack, Erik Miller, Carson Seymour, Mason Black, Nick Swiney, Raymond Burgos, Michael Stryfeler, Juan Sanchez**, catchers **Andy Thomas** and **Patrick Bailey**, infielder **Hayden Cantrelle** and outfielders **Luis Matos** and **Ismael Munguia**. Of these players, only Miller and Stryfeler have previous experience at the Double-A level.

**SQUIRRELS AROUND THE WORLD:** The Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster includes players from five different countries. Two players, **Luis Matos** and **Juan Sanchez** were born in Venezuela. **Randy Rodriguez** is a native of the Dominican Republic. **Ismael Munguia** became the second player in team history born in Nicaragua with his debut on Saturday. **Raymond Burgos** was born in Puerto Rico and **Kai-Wei Teng** is from Taiwan. Twenty-one players are natives of the United States, spanning 16 different states, including a team-high four from California.

**HOW THEY GOT HERE:** Eighteen players were originally signed or drafted by the San Francisco Giants. Eleven players were selected in the MLB Draft, four were signed as international free agents and three were signed as non-drafted free agents. Two players were signed as minor league free agents after starting their careers in other organizations. **Riley Mahan**, previously with the Miami Marlins organization, was signed last May. **Raymond Burgos** signed in December after reaching free agency following seven years as a member of the Cleveland Guardians organization. Seven players were acquired via trade. **Kai-Wei Teng** came in a deal with the Minnesota Twins in 2019. **Hayden Cantrelle** was swapped from the Marlins in 2022. **Carson Seymour** and **Nick Zwack** came to the Giants in a trade with the New York Mets at the trade deadline last year, the same day **Andy Thomas** and **Michael Stryfeler** were traded from the Seattle Mariners. **Erik Miller** was traded from the Philadelphia Phillies in January.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Tyler Fitzgerald** is ranked tied for second in batting average (.500), fifth in OBP (.600) and seventh in OPS (1.225). **Patrick Bailey** is tied for seventh in batting average (.429), tied for sixth in SLG (.714), eighth in OPS (1.214) and tied for first in doubles (2). **Luis Matos** is tied for eighth in SLG (.700), 10th in OPS (1.200), tied for fifth in total bases (7) and tied for first in runs scored (5). **Nick Zwack** is tied for second in strikeouts (9), eighth in BAA (.077) and tied for second in WHIP (0.25). **Nick Swiney** is 10th in BAA (.100).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, **Luis Matos** (No. 5), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Erik Miller** (No. 15), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Nick Swiney** (No. 24), **Patrick Bailey** (No. 27) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Bailey (No. 11), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
