YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Senators, 7-6. The Senators walked off in the bottom of the ninth when Trey Harris scored on a passed ball. The Flying Squirrels opened a 1-0 lead in the first inning with an RBI single by **Patrick Bailey**. The Senators tied the game, 1-1, in the third with a sac fly by Leonel Valera. Richmond scored four in the fourth to take a 5-1 lead. Two runs scored on a passed ball to give Richmond a 3-1 lead. **Hayden Cantrelle** and **Luis Matos** capped the inning with RBI singles. Harrisburg closed within three runs in the fourth with a solo homer by Omar Meregildo. RBIs by Valera and Antuna in the fifth brought the Senators within a run. Will Frizzell tied the game, 5-5, in the sixth with a solo homer and Meregildo gave Harrisburg its first lead of the series with an RBI single in the seventh. Down, 6-5, in the eighth, **Carter Aldrete** evened the score with an RBI single.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators. Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The only other season the Senators have played their first home series against the Flying Squirrels was 2021, with each team winning three games. Richmond won the first three, including a no-hitter by **Matt Frisbee** and three relievers on May 13, 2021. This year, the Flying Squirrels visit Harrisburg for two series. The will also play a three-game set at FNB Field from July 13-16 out of the All-Star Break. The Senators come to Richmond twice for two six-game series from June 20-25 and August 15-20.

STRONG START: With a three-game sweep over the Fightin Phils last weekend and a win in the series opener at Harrisburg, the Flying Squirrels had their first 4-0 start in franchise history. The previous best unbeaten start was a 3-0 record to begin the 2019 season. With a 4-1 record through five games, Richmond has matched its best start to a season in team history, even with the 2013 and 2021 seasons. The only 5-1 start in franchise history came in 2021.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS continue the a new season this weekend after qualifying for the postseason in 2022 for the first time in eight years, winning the Eastern League Southwest Division first-half title before being eliminated in the Division Series by Erie. Richmond went 66-71 overall, posting a 40-29 mark in the first half and a 26-42 record in the second half. Last year's team also set a franchise record with 169 homers, passing the previous mark of 127 set in 2021.

THE SENATORS opened the season dropping two-of-three at Somerset last Friday and Saturday. Harrisburg's season-opener was rained out last Thursday. They lost, 6-5, on Friday before alternating shutouts in a doubleheader split on Saturday. In 2022, the Senators went 52-85, the worst record in the Eastern League. They went 30-39 in the first half and 22-46 in the second half. Harrisburg's roster includes six of Baseball America's Top-30 Nationals prospects, including Jackson Rutledge (No. 9), Mitchell Parker (No. 14), Evan Lee (No. 23), Drew Millas (No. 25), Gerardo Carrillo (No. 26) and Tim Cate (No. 28). The Senators' roster also features four of MLB.com's Top-30 Nationals prospects, including Jackson Rutledge (No. 11), Mitchell Parker (No. 24), Gerardo Carrillo (No. 28) and Drew Millas (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Carson Seymour** takes the mound for his second Double-A start. He made his debut as Richmond's Opening Day starter on Saturday against Reading at The Diamond and allowed three runs (one earned) over four innings. A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 1.19 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 17 by MLB.com. **For more on Seymour, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Jackson Rutledge makes his second Double-A start. He was the Senators' Opening Day starter on Friday at Somerset and allowed three runs over 4.2 innings in a no-decision. Last year, he made 20 starts for Low-A Frederick, going 8-6 with a 4.90 ERA. Rutledge began his collegiate career at the University of Arkansas before transferring as a sophomore to San Jacinto College in Texas. He had committed to play at the University of Kentucky before being selected by the Nationals in the first round (17th overall) in the 2020 MLB Draft. He is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Nationals prospect and No. 11 by MLB.com.

MATOS MANIA: Through his first five Double-A games, **Luis Matos** has picked up seven hits and five RBIs, leading the team in both categories. He went 3-for-4 with a two-run homer in his Double-A debut in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader. In the first two games of the current series in Harrisburg, Matos has driven in three runs. His only two strikeouts of the season came in Sunday's game against Reading.

PATTY BARRELS: **Patrick Bailey** has reached base in each of his first four Double-A games. He picked up an RBI double in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader against Reading for his first Double-A hit. He reached base three times on Sunday, picking up another doubles and adding a walk. He went hitless but walked in Tuesday's win. On Wednesday, he had two opposite-field singles while batting left-handed. Bailey is batting .364 (4-for-11, 2 2B) left-handed and .200 (1-for-5) right-handed.

TAKE A WALK: Although he has not yet picked up his first Double-A hit, **Andy Thomas** is tied for first in the Eastern League with six walks, even with New Hampshire's Damiano Palmegiani. His 42.9 walk percentage is the highest in the circuit. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest League in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58).

FAMILIAR FACES: This year's Opening Day roster includes 14 players who have previously spent time with the Flying Squirrels. Returners include pitchers **Matt Frisbee**, **Ryan Murphy**, **Kai-Wei Teng**, **Evan Gates**, **Randy Rodriguez**, **Wil Jensen**, **Chris Wright** and **Blake Rivera**, catcher **Brandon Martorano** and infielders **Tyler Fitzgerald**, **Carter Aldrete**, **Brett Auerbach**, **Riley Mahan** and **Simon Whiteman**.

FRESH FACES: Thirteen players on the Opening Day roster will be playing for Richmond for the first time. Newcomers to Richmond include pitchers **Nick Zwack**, **Erik Miller**, **Carson Seymour**, **Mason Black**, **Nick Swiney**, **Raymond Burgos**, **Michael Stryffeler**, **Juan Sanchez**, catchers **Andy Thomas** and **Patrick Bailey**, infielder **Hayden Cantrelle** and outfielders **Luis Matos** and **Ismael Munguia**. Of these players, only Miller and Stryffeler have previous experience at the Double-A level.

SQUIRRELS AROUND THE WORLD: The Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster includes players from five different countries. Two players, **Luis Matos** and **Juan Sanchez** were born in Venezuela. **Randy Rodriguez** is a native of the Dominican Republic. **Ismael Munguia** became the second player in team history born in Nicaragua with his debut on Saturday. **Raymond Burgos** was born in Puerto Rico and **Kai-Wei Teng** is from Taiwan. Twenty-one players are natives of the United States, spanning 16 different states, including a team-high four from California.

HOW THEY GOT HERE: Eighteen players were originally signed or drafted by the San Francisco Giants. Eleven players were selected in the MLB Draft, four were signed as international free agents and three were signed as non-drafted free agents. Two players were signed as minor league free agents after starting their careers in other organizations. **Riley Mahan**, previously with the Miami Marlins organization, was signed last May. **Raymond Burgos** signed in December after reaching free agency following seven years as a member of the Cleveland Guardians organization. Seven players were acquired via trade. **Kai-Wei Teng** came in a deal with the Minnesota Twins in 2019. **Hayden Cantrelle** was swapped from the Marlins in 2022. **Carson Seymour** and **Nick Zwack** came to the Giants in a trade with the New York Mets at the trade deadline last year, the same day **Andy Thomas** and **Michael Stryffeler** were traded from the Seattle Mariners. **Erik Miller** was traded from the Philadelphia Phillies in January.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Luis Matos** is tied for fourth in hits (7) and tied for third in runs scored (5). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for first in triples (1). **Andy Thomas** is tied for first in walks (6). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for fourth in strikeouts (10). **Nick Zwack** is tied for sixth in strikeouts (9), tied for fourth in BAA (.077) and tied for first in WHIP (0.25). **Ryan Murphy** is tied for fifth in innings pitched (6.0).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, **Luis Matos** (No. 5), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Erik Miller** (No. 15), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Nick Swiney** (No. 24), **Patrick Bailey** (No. 27) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Bailey (No. 11), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
