YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 4-3, snapping a three-game win streak. The SeaWolves opened a 2-0 lead in the first with two-out, RBI singles by Mario Feliciano and Josh Crouch. **Ismael Munguia** scored on an error to close the score to 2-1 in the bottom of the first. In the second, Colt Keith hit a two-run homer to push Erie ahead, 4-1. Richmond scored a run on a groundout in the third to close within two. In the fifth, **Simon Whiteman** scored on a balk to close the gap to 4-3. Richmond put the tying run on second in the ninth, but Austin Bergner recorded the final outs for his first save. Richmond reliever **Erik Miller** pitched 3.2 scoreless innings with four strikeouts. **Michael Stryffeler** threw 1.2 scoreless innings and **Blake Rivera** worked 1.1 innings without allowing a run.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Today marks the fifth of 24 games between the Flying Squirrels and the SeaWolves this season, tied for the most Richmond will play against any opponent. Richmond travels to Erie for a six-game series from May 9-14 and again from September 12-17. The SeaWolves return to The Diamond for a six-game series from May 30-June 4. This series marks a rematch of last year's Southwest Division Series, which Erie swept in two games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won four-of-the-last-six games and are in second place in the division, a half-game behind Akron. After starting the season 4-0 for the first time in team history, Richmond dropped four-of-the-next-five games to finish last week's series in Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels offense leads the league batting average (.260), runs scored (79), RBIs (67), OBP (.369) and OPS (.753) and rank second in hits (109). The Richmond pitching staff leads the league in strikeouts (143).

THE SEAWOLVES snapped a three-game losing streak with Friday's one-run win. They split last week's series against Altoona, picking up two walk-off wins. Erie's pitching staff ranks second in the league in strikeouts (142). Erie's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Wilmer Flores (No. 3), Ty Madden (No. 4), Colt Keith (No. 5), Dylan Smith (No. 17), Wenceel Perez (No. 19), Josh Crouch (No. 22), Brant Hurter (No. 26) and Gage Workman (No. 27). Flores (No. 3), Keith (No. 4), Madden (No. 5), Perez (No. 8), Smith (No. 15), Hurter (No. 21), Crouch (No. 24), Austin Bergner (No. 27) and Workman (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his third start of the season and his first at home. He enters tonight's start ranked tied for seventh in the Eastern League with 17 strikeouts. He opened his season with four scoreless innings on April 11 at Harrisburg and struck out 10 batters. Last time out, he worked 3.2 innings and allowed four runs in a loss at Harrisburg on Sunday afternoon. Last year, Teng led the Eastern League and set a Richmond franchise record with 169 strikeouts. Over the last 2021 and 2022 seasons, Teng combined for 311 strikeouts, which was the fourth-most in the minor leagues during that span. For 2022 in his first Double-A season, Teng went 6-12 with a 5.22 ERA. He tied the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for the most starts in a season with 28. A native of Taiwan, Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins before being traded to the Giants at the deadline in 2019 along with RHP Prelander Berroa for RHP Sam Dyson. Prior to the 2023 season, Teng pitched for Chinese Taipei in the World Baseball Classic at Taichung Intercontinental Stadium in his hometown. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Sawyer Gipson-Long makes his third start and fourth appearance of the year. He last pitched on Sunday against Altoona and allowed one run over five innings with nine strikeouts in a win. In his previous start last Tuesday against the Curve, he allowed four runs in four innings. Gipson-Long was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the sixth round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Mercer. He was traded to the Detroit Tigers on August 2, 2022 for RHP Michael Fulmer. After the trade, he made seven starts last season for the SeaWolves, going 2-2 with a 4.54 ERA. Gipson-Long has made one other start in his career against the Flying Squirrels, allowing two runs over 4.2 innings on September 13, 2022 at The Diamond in a no-decision. This year, Gipson-Long is tied for second in the Eastern League in wins (2) and ranks sixth in WHIP (0.91).

HOME SWEET HOME: On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 6-1 at The Diamond. This year was the second time the team has started 6-0 at home in franchise history. In 2018, the Flying Squirrels started 6-0 before also losing their seventh game at home. The only remaining team in the minors undefeated at home this year are the High-A Eugene Emeralds (3-0).

MATOS MANIA: **Luis Matos** has reached base in each of his first 12 Double-A games. His 12-game on-base streak is tied for the longest in the Eastern League this year. Matos has reached base 21 total times with 13 hits and eight walks. He hit a homer in his Double-A debut in Game 1 of the Flying Squirrels' season-opening doubleheader on April 8 against Reading. In this week's series, Matos is batting .385 (5-for-13) with two doubles, two walks, one RBI and four runs scored. For the year, Matos has struck out just four times in 52 plate appearances.

ALRIGHT, ALDRETE: **Carter Aldrete** had his eight-game hitting streak snapped on Friday, but worked a walk to extend his on-base streak to 10 games, which is tied for the fifth-longest active streak in the league. During the streak, Aldrete is batting .343 (12-for-35) with two homers, two doubles, six walks and 10 RBIs. He is currently tied for third in the Eastern League with 10 RBIs. He hit his first two homers of the year last week in Harrisburg. After homering 13 times in his first two professional seasons, Aldrete clubbed 21 homers in 2022, including 15 with High-A Eugene and six with the Flying Squirrels.

PATTY BARRELS: **Patrick Bailey** has picked up at least one hit in eight-of-11 games played this season. On Tuesday, Bailey hit his first Double-A homer and tied a team record with five hits, going 5-for-5 with a walk and three RBIs. It was the 10th five-hit game by a Flying Squirrels batter in team history. He walked twice on Friday. Bailey is ranked fifth in the Eastern League in batting average (.357), sixth in 10th (.438) and tied for third in hits (15).

TAKE A WALK: **Andy Thomas** is tied for second in Eastern League with 12 walks. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest League in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58). He has worked at least one walk in seven-of-his-10 games played so far this season.

SIMON SAYS: In his last nine games, **Simon Whiteman** has reached base 17 times, posting a .515 on-base percentage, which is the highest in the Eastern League. He has picked up nine hits and eight walks since April 11. He reached base four times last Wednesday, including his first home run of the year and three walks. He homered again in the opener of the series on Tuesday. Whiteman has reached base in 10 consecutive games, which is tied for the fifth-longest active streak in the Eastern League. For the year, he is ranked sixth in OBP (.450), ninth in OPS (.981) and tied for fourth in runs scored (10).

OLD FRIENDS: Erie's roster includes former Flying Squirrels outfielder Diego Rincones, who signed with the Tigers as a free agent in December. Rincones played 142 games with Richmond over the 2021 and 2022 seasons, batting .269 (140-for-520) with 20 homers and 80 RBIs. Three total former Flying Squirrels are playing with other teams in the Eastern League this year. Pitcher Gray Fenter, who was with Richmond last season and with Bowie in 2021, is now with Somerset. First baseman Frankie Tostado, a member of the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for Harrisburg.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Patrick Bailey** ranks fifth in batting average (.357), 10th in OBP (.438) and tied for third in hits (15). **Carter Aldrete** is tied for third in RBIs (10). **Simon Whiteman** is sixth in OBP (.450), ninth in OPS (.981) and tied for fourth in runs scored (10). **Ismael Munguia** is tied for third in hits (15) and tied for first in runs scored (12). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for first in triples (2). **Andy Thomas** is tied for second in walks (12). **Kai-Wei Teng** is ranked tied for seventh in strikeouts (17). **Carson Seymour** is tied for sixth in BAA (.171).

WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Colt Keith is eighth in batting average (.340), tied for sixth in RBIs (9), second in OPS (1.084), second in hits (17) and tied for third in total bases (27). Gage Workman is ninth in OBP (.439), fourth in SLG (.645), tied for first in triples (2), Brant Hurter is tied for fourth in ERA (0.75), tied for sixth in BAA (.171), Sawyer Gipson-Long is tied for second in wins (2) and sixth in WHIP (0.91). Ty Madden is tied for fifth in strikeouts (18).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, **Luis Matos** (No. 5), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Erik Miller** (No. 15), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Nick Swiney** (No. 24), **Patrick Bailey** (No. 27) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Bailey (No. 11), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
