YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels shut out the SeaWolves, 2-0. **Kai-Wei Teng** started and struck out eight over four scoreless innings, allowing one hit with no walks. **Nick Swiney** picked up his second win after throwing four scoreless innings. **Evan Gates** earned his second save with a scoreless ninth. **Hayden Cantrelle** broke the scoreless tie in the fifth with an RBI double. **Carter Williams**, making his Double-A debut, tripled in a run for his first Double-A hit in the seventh.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Today marks the sixth of 24 games between the Flying Squirrels and the SeaWolves this season, tied for the most Richmond will play against any opponent. Richmond travels to Erie for a six-game series from May 9-14 and again from September 12-17. The SeaWolves return to The Diamond for a six-game series from May 30-June 4. This series marks a rematch of last year's Southwest Division Series, which Erie swept in two games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won five-of-the-last-seven games and are in first place in the division, a half-game ahead of Akron. After starting the season 4-0 for the first time in team history, Richmond dropped four-of-the-next-five games to finish last week's series in Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels offense leads the league batting average (.251), runs (81), RBIs (60), OBP (.359) and OPS (.731) and ranks second in hits (112). The Richmond pitching staff leads the league in strikeouts (156).

THE SEAWOLVES have lost four-of-five in the series. They split last week's series against Altoona, picking up two walk-off wins. Erie's pitching staff ranks second in the league in strikeouts (149). Erie's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Wilmer Flores (No. 3), Ty Madden (No. 4), Colt Keith (No. 5), Dylan Smith (No. 17), Wenceel Perez (No. 19), Josh Crouch (No. 22), Brant Hurter (No. 26) and Gage Workman (No. 27). Flores (No. 3), Keith (No. 4), Madden (No. 5), Perez (No. 8), Smith (No. 15), Hurter (No. 21), Crouch (No. 24), Austin Bergner (No. 27) and Workman (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Landen Roupp** makes his season debut. In his first full professional season in 2022, Roupp climbed three levels in the Giants system. He began the year working primarily as a reliever with Low-A San Jose, going 5-2 with a 2.59 ERA in 14 outings. Roupp moved to High-A Eugene in late-June for seven starts, going 3-0 with a 1.67 ERA. He was promoted to Richmond on August 18 for the remainder of the season and went 2-1 with a 3.76 ERA in five starts. Roupp made one start against the SeaWolves last year, allowing two runs over five innings in his final outing of the year on September 15 at The Diamond. Roupp was selected by the Giants in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of UNC Wilmington, where he was the 2021 CAA Pitcher of the Year. **For more on Roupp, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander **Wilmer Flores** makes his fourth start of the year. He started the first game of the series on Tuesday at The Diamond and tied a career high with seven runs allowed over 2.2 innings. After working four scoreless innings as Erie's Opening Day starter on April 6 at Akron, he was hit with a loss in his start on April 12 against the Curve, allowing six runs. He first reached Double-A with Erie last season and made 19 starts, going 6-4 with a 3.01 ERA. He has made three starts against the Flying Squirrels in his career, all at The Diamond, combining to go 1-1 with a 5.92 ERA (9 ER/13.2 IP/19 SO/6 BB). His two highest strikeout performances of 2022 came against the Flying Squirrels, striking out eight batters in both starts. Flores attended Arizona Western College, making just six relief appearances prior to signing as a free agent with the Tigers in 2020. In 2021, Flores pitched his first professional season, going 6-4 with a 3.68 ERA in 14 outings between the FCL and Low-A Lakeland. Flores is the younger brother of Giants infielder Wilmer Flores.

HOME SWEET HOME: On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 7-1 at The Diamond. This year was the second time the team started 6-0 at home in franchise history. In 2018, the Flying Squirrels started 6-0 before also losing their seventh game at home. Richmond's 7-1 record at The Diamond is tied with the High-A Beloit Snappers for the second-best home record in the minors. The only remaining team in the minors undefeated at home this year are the High-A Eugene Emeralds (5-0).

HEY, HAYDEN: **Hayden Cantrelle** has hit safely in eight-of-his-last-nine games, batting .303 (10-for-33) with three doubles, four RBIs and nine runs scored while adding three stolen bases. For the season, Cantrelle is tied for fourth in the Eastern League with 10 runs scored.

WELCOME, CARTER WILLIAMS: In his Double-A debut on Saturday night at The Diamond, **Carter Williams** picked up an RBI triple for his first Double-A hit in the Flying Squirrels' 2-0 win over the SeaWolves. He opened the season with High-A Eugene and picked up four hits in three games played before being promoted on Saturday. Last year, Williams hit .336 over 80 games between Low-A San Jose and Eugene.

MATOS MANIA: **Luis Matos** has reached base in each of his first 13 Double-A games. His 13-game on-base streak is tied for the longest in the Eastern League this year. Matos has reached base 22 total times with 13 hits and nine walks. He hit a homer in his Double-A debut in Game 1 of the Flying Squirrels' season-opening doubleheader on April 8 against Reading. In this week's series, Matos is batting .313 (5-for-16) with two doubles, three walks, one RBI and four runs scored. For the year, Matos has struck out just five times in 56 plate appearances.

PATTY BARRELS: **Patrick Bailey** has picked up at least one hit in eight-of-12 games played this season. On Tuesday, Bailey hit his first Double-A homer and tied a team record with five hits, going 5-for-5 with a walk and three RBIs. It was the 10th five-hit game by a Flying Squirrels batter in team history. He walked twice on Friday. Bailey is ranked seventh in the Eastern League in batting average (.326) and tied for third in hits (15).

TAKE A WALK: **Andy Thomas** is tied for fourth in Eastern League with 12 walks. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest League in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58). He has worked at least one walk in seven-of-his-11 games played so far this season.

SIMON SAYS: In his last 10 games, **Simon Whiteman** has reached base 17 times, posting a .472 on-base percentage, which is the third-highest in the Eastern League. He has picked up nine hits and eight walks since April 11. He reached base four times last Wednesday, including his first home run of the year and three walks. He homered again in the opener of the series on Tuesday. Whiteman had reached base in 10 consecutive games prior to Saturday. For the year, Whiteman is ranked ninth in the Eastern League in on-base percentage (.419) and tied for fourth in runs scored (10).

OLD FRIENDS: Erie's roster includes former Flying Squirrels outfielder Diego Rincones, who signed with the Tigers as a free agent in December. Rincones played 142 games with Richmond over the 2021 and 2022 seasons, batting .269 (140-for-520) with 20 homers and 80 RBIs. Three total former Flying Squirrels are playing with other teams in the Eastern League this year. Pitcher Gray Fenter, who was with Richmond last season and with Bowie in 2021, is now with Somerset. First baseman Frankie Tostado, a member of the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for Harrisburg.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Patrick Bailey** ranks seventh in batting average (.326) and tied for third in hits (15). **Carter Aldrete** is tied for fourth in RBIs (10). **Simon Whiteman** is ranked ninth in OBP (.419) and tied for fourth in runs scored (10). **Ismael Munguia** is tied for third in hits (15) and tied for second in runs scored (12). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for first in triples (2). **Andy Thomas** is tied for fourth in walks (12). **Hayden Cantrelle** is tied for fourth in runs scored (10). **Kai-Wei Teng** is first in strikeouts (25), tied for fourth in BAA (.150) and fifth in WHIP (0.86). **Nick Swiney** is tied for second in wins (2). **Evan Gates** is tied for sixth in saves (2). **Carson Seymour** is tied for seventh in BAA (.171).

WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Colt Keith is sixth in batting average (.352), eighth in OBP (.419), ninth in SLG (.537), 10th in OPS (.956), second in hits (19) and third in total bases (29). Gage Workman is tied for fourth in SLG (.588), seventh in OPS (.997) and tied for first in triples (2). Mario Feliciano is tied for fourth in doubles (5).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, **Luis Matos** (No. 5), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Erik Miller** (No. 15), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Nick Swiney** (No. 24), **Patrick Bailey** (No. 27) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). *MLB.com's* Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Bailey (No. 11), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
