SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost the series finale against the SeaWolves, 6-5, in 10 innings. The SeaWolves tied the game, 5-5, in the ninth with an RBI single by Colt Keith. Daniel Cabrera hit a go-ahead single in the top of the 10th. Yaya Chentouf held the Flying Squirrels scoreless in the bottom of the 10th. The SeaWolves opened the scoring in the fourth with an RBI double by Diego Rincones. Riley Mahan hit a solo homer to tie the game, 1-1, in the fifth. The SeaWolves moved back in front, 2-1, in the sixth with a run scoring on a double play. Patrick Bailey gave the Flying Squirrels a 3-2 lead in the sixth with a two-run single. Mahan extended the lead to 4-2 with his second solo homer in the seventh. Keith homered and Rincones hit a sac fly in the eighth to tie the score. Brett Auerbach hit an RBI single to give the Flying Squirrels a 5-4 lead in the eighth. Landen Roupp made his first start of the season and worked three scoreless innings with six strikeouts.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today marks the first of 24 games between the Flying Squirrels and the Baysox this season, tied for the most Richmond will play against any opponent. The Flying Squirrels return to Prince George's Stadium for a six-game series from June 13-18. The Baysox visit The Diamond for a six-game set from July 4-9 and again from August 8-13.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won five-of-the-last-eight games and are in first place in the division, one game ahead of Akron. After starting the season 4-0 for the first time in team history, Richmond dropped four-of-the-next-five games before taking four-of-six last week against the SeaWolves. The Flying Squirrels offense ranks first in the Eastern League in batting average (.252), runs (86), hits (122), RBIs (74), OBP (.354) and OPS (.732). They also rank tied for second in total bases (183). The Richmond pitching staff leads the Eastern League in strikeouts (170).

THE BAYSOX have lost five-of-their-last-six games, including four-of-five in last week's series in Altoona. Bowie's pitching staff currently holds the second-lowest ERA in the Eastern League (3.18). Bowie's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 prospects, including Coby Mayo (No. 10), Heston Kjerstad (No. 12), Cade Povich (No. 13), Justin Armbruester (No. 20), Chayce McDermott (No. 23), Cesar Prieto (No. 25), John Rhodes (No. 27) and Carlos Tavera (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes Kjerstad (No. 5), Mayo (No. 9), Povich (No. 12), Prieto (No. 17), McDermott (No. 18) and Rhodes (No. 20).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Carson Seymour takes the mound for his fourth Double-A start. Last time out, he allowed two runs over 3.2 innings on Wednesday against the SeaWolves in a no-decision. A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 1.19 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 17 by MLB.com. **For more on Seymour, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Connor Gillispie makes his second start and fourth appearance of the season. He previously made a start on April 7 at Hartford and worked three scoreless innings. He has pitched out of the bullpen for his last two outings, allowing one run over four innings in both of them, including a win last Wednesday at Altoona. Gillispie attended The Miller School near Charlottesville, where he was a three-time all-state selection. He played three seasons at VCU in Richmond and recorded 118 strikeouts as a junior in 2019, the fourth-most in a season in program history. Gillispie was selected by the Orioles in the ninth round of the 2019 MLB Draft. He spent each of his first three seasons with the Aberdeen IronBirds, 2019 as a short-season team and the last two at High-A, before joining the Baysox this year. Last season, he went 8-5 with a 3.79 ERA in 25 outings (14 starts).

PLAY THE HITS: In last week's six-game series against the SeaWolves, the Flying Squirrels scored 46 runs (7.8 per game) and collected 62 hits (10.3 per game), leading the Eastern League in both categories. The team combined to hit a league-best .297. The Flying Squirrels scored 36 runs over the first three games of the series.

HEY, HAYDEN: Hayden Cantrelle has hit safely in nine-of-his-last-10 games, batting .297 (11-for-37) with three doubles, four RBIs and nine runs scored while adding three stolen bases. For the season, Cantrelle is tied for seventh in the Eastern League with 10 runs scored.

WELCOME, CARTER WILLIAMS: In his Double-A debut on Saturday night at The Diamond, Carter Williams picked up an RBI triple for his first Double-A hit in the Flying Squirrels' 2-0 win over the SeaWolves. He opened the season with High-A Eugene and picked up four hits in three games played before being promoted on Saturday. Last year, Williams hit .336 over 80 games between Low-A San Jose and Eugene.

MATOS MANIA: Luis Matos has reached base in each of his first 14 Double-A games. His 14-game on-base streak is tied for the longest in the Eastern League this year, even with Erie's Colt Keith. Matos has reached base 25 total times with 15 hits and 10 walks. He hit a homer in his Double-A debut in Game 1 of the Flying Squirrels' season-opening doubleheader on April 8 against Reading. In last week's series, Matos hit .350 (7-for-20) with three doubles, four walks, one RBI and six runs scored. For the year, Matos has struck out just five times in 61 plate appearances. He is tied for sixth in the league in hits (15) and tied for fourth in runs scored (11).

PATTY BARRELS: Patrick Bailey has picked up at least one hit in nine-of-13 games played this season. Last Tuesday, Bailey hit his first Double-A homer and tied a team record with five hits, going 5-for-5 with a walk and three RBIs. It was the 10th five-hit game by a Flying Squirrels batter in team history. He picked up two hits on Sunday and drove in two runs. Bailey is ranked sixth in the Eastern League in batting average (.340) and third in hits (17).

TAKE A WALK: Andy Thomas is tied for sixth in Eastern League with 12 walks. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest League in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58). He has worked at least one walk in seven-of-his-11 games played so far this season.

SIMON SAYS: In his last 11 games, Simon Whiteman has reached base 18 times, posting a .450 on-base percentage, which is the fifth-highest in the Eastern League. He has picked up 10 hits and eight walks since April 11. Whiteman had reached base in 10 consecutive games prior to Saturday. Overall this year, Whiteman is ranked tied for fourth in the league with 11 runs scored.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Patrick Bailey ranks seventh in batting average (.340) and third in hits (17). Carter Aldrete is tied for sixth in RBIs (10). Luis Matos is tied for sixth in hits (15) and tied for fourth in runs (11). Ismael Munguia is tied for sixth in hits (15) and third in runs (12). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for first in triples (2). Andy Thomas is tied for sixth in walks (12). Simon Whiteman is tied for fourth in runs scored (11). Hayden Cantrelle is tied for seventh in runs scored (10). Kai-Wei Teng is first in strikeouts (25). Evan Gates is tied for seventh in saves (2).

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Cesar Prieto is first in batting average (.397), fourth in OBP (.435), first in hits (23) and fourth in total bases (30). Heston Kjerstad is tied for first in homers (5), second in SLG (.608), eighth in OPS (.981), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (7), third in total bases (31) and tied for first in runs scored (13). John Rhodes is tied for third in RBIs (11), Chayce McDermott is third in ERA (0.68) and sixth in WHIP (0.90). Justin Armbruester is seventh in ERA (1.26). Nolan Hoffman is tied for seventh in saves (2). Garrett Stallings is tied for seventh in innings pitched (15.0), seventh in BAA (.473) and third in WHIP (0.73).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, Luis Matos (No. 5), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Erik Miller (No. 15), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Nick Swiney (No. 24), Patrick Bailey (No. 27) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Bailey (No. 11), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
