YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 4-2, to open the series. Bowie scored two runs in the third to take a 2-0 lead. **Riley Mahan** brought in a run with an RBI groundout in the fifth to close the score to 2-1. **Simon Whiteman** tied the game, 2-2, in the seventh with an RBI infield single. In the eighth, **Patrick Bailey** gave the Flying Squirrels their first lead of the game with a solo homer and **Andy Thomas** added another solo home run to open a 4-2 lead. **Raymond Burgos** stranded a runner in the ninth to pick up his first Double-A save. **Will Jensen, Juan Sanchez** and Burgos combined for six scoreless relief innings for the Flying Squirrels.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today marks the second of 24 games between the Flying Squirrels and the Baysox this season, tied for the most Richmond will play against any opponent. The Flying Squirrels return to Prince George's Stadium for a six-game series from June 13-18. The Baysox visit The Diamond for a six-game set from July 4-9 and again from August 8-13. The Flying Squirrels are 7-6 this year against opponents from the Southwest Division.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won six-of-the-last-nine games and are in first place in the division, two games ahead of Akron, Erie and Harrisburg. After starting the season 4-0 for the first time in team history, Richmond dropped four-of-the-next-five games before taking four-of-six last week against the SeaWolves. The Flying Squirrels offense ranks first in the Eastern League in batting average (.251), runs (90), hits (122), RBIs (78), OBP (.350) and OPS (.736). They also rank second in total bases (200). The Richmond pitching staff leads the Eastern League in strikeouts (177).

THE BAYSOX have lost four straight and six-of-their-last-seven games, including four-of-five in last week's series in Altoona. Bowie's pitching staff currently holds the second-lowest ERA in the Eastern League (3.24). Bowie's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 prospects, including Coby Mayo (No. 10), Heston Kjerstad (No. 12), Cade Povich (No. 13), Justin Armbruester (No. 20), Chayce McDermott (No. 23), Cesar Prieto (No. 25), John Rhodes (No. 27) and Carlos Tavera (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes Kjerstad (No. 5), Mayo (No. 9), Povich (No. 12), Prieto (No. 17), McDermott (No. 18) and Rhodes (No. 20).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Nick Zwack** makes his fourth Double-A start. Last time out, he allowed two runs over two innings against Erie on Thursday. He was selected in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets out of Xavier and traded to the Giants last August as part of the deal for Darin Ruf. After starting the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, Zwack earned a promotion to High-A Brooklyn, where he went 5-1 with a 1.84 ERA in 14 outings, landing him a South Atlantic League Post-Season All-Star selection. He closed the season with six starts for High-A Eugene following the trade. Zwack, a native of Minneapolis, played his college career at Xavier, where he was a First-Team All-Big East selection in 2021 as a senior. **For more on Zwack, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Connor Gillispie makes his second start and fourth appearance of the season. He previously made a start on April 7 at Hartford and worked three scoreless innings. He has pitched out of the bullpen for his last two outings, allowing one run over four innings in both of them, including a win last Wednesday at Altoona. Gillispie attended The Miller School near Charlottesville, where he was a three-time all-state selection. He played three seasons at VCU in Richmond and recorded 118 strikeouts as a junior in 2019, the fourth-most in a season in program history. Gillispie was selected by the Orioles in the ninth round of the 2019 MLB Draft. He spent each of his first three seasons with the Aberdeen IronBirds, 2019 as a short-season team and the last two at High-A, before joining the Baysox this year. Last season, he went 8-5 with a 3.79 ERA in 25 outings (14 starts).

STARTING STRONG: The Flying Squirrels lead the Southwest Division with a 10-6 record this year, which is tied for the second-best start in team history through 16 games. The Flying Squirrels also started 10-6 in 2014 and 2021. The only year with a better record to open the season with 2018, when the team was 11-5. This year, Richmond went 4-0 to start the season, the longest unbeaten streak to start a year in franchise history.

HITZ-GERALD: With his triple on Tuesday at Bowie, **Tyler Fitzgerald** became the first player in the Eastern League this year with three three-base hits. He is also leading the league in BABIP (.429) this season. In the Eastern League, Fitzgerald is ranked tied for fourth in hits (16), eighth in SLG (.528), 10th in OPS (.921), first in triples (3) and sixth in total bases (28).

HEY, HAYDEN: **Hayden Cantrelle** has hit safely in nine-of-his-last-10 games, batting .297 (11-for-37) with three doubles, four RBIs and nine runs scored while adding three stolen bases. For the season, Cantrelle is tied for ninth in the Eastern League with 10 runs scored.

WELCOME, CARTER WILLIAMS: In his Double-A debut on Saturday night at The Diamond, **Carter Williams** picked up an RBI triple for his first Double-A hit in the Flying Squirrels' 2-0 win over the SeaWolves. He opened the season with High-A Eugene and picked up four hits in three games played before being promoted on Saturday. Last year, Williams hit .336 over 80 games between Low-A San Jose and Eugene.

MATOS MANIA: **Luis Matos** has reached base in each of his first 15 Double-A games. His 15-game on-base streak is tied for the longest in the Eastern League this year, even with Erie's Colt Keith. Matos has reached base 26 total times with 15 hits and 11 walks. He hit a homer in his Double-A debut in Game 1 of the Flying Squirrels' season-opening doubleheader on April 8 against Reading. In last week's series, Matos hit .350 (7-for-20) with three doubles, four walks, one RBI and six runs scored. For the year, Matos has struck out just six times in 65 plate appearances. His 9.2-percent strikeout rate is the fourth-lowest among qualified Eastern League batters.

PATTY BARRELS: **Patrick Bailey** has picked up at least one hit in 10-of-14 games played this season. Last Tuesday, Bailey hit his first Double-A homer and tied a team record with five hits, going 5-for-5 with a walk and three RBIs. It was the 10th five-hit game by a Flying Squirrels batter in team history. He picked up two hits on Sunday and drove in two runs. He added an eighth-inning, go-ahead homer in Tuesday's 4-2 win over the Baysox to begin this week's series. Bailey is ranked fifth in the Eastern League in batting average (.333) and third in hits (18).

TAKE A WALK: **Andy Thomas** is tied for third in Eastern League with 14 walks. He leads the Eastern League with a 26.9-percent walk rate. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest League in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58). He has worked at least one walk in seven-of-his-11 games played so far this season.

SIMON SAYS: In his last 12 games since April 11, **Simon Whiteman** has reached base 20 times, posting a .455 on-base percentage, which is the third-highest in the Eastern League in that span. He has picked up 12 hits and eight walks since April 11. Whiteman had reached base in 10 consecutive games prior to Saturday. Overall this year, Whiteman is ranked tied for ninth in batting average (.302), eighth in OBP (.412) and tied for fifth in runs scored (11).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Patrick Bailey** is ranked fifth in the Eastern League in batting average (.333) and third in hits (18). **Simon Whiteman** is tied for ninth in batting average (.302), eighth in OBP (.412) and tied for fifth in runs scored (11). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for fourth in hits (16), eighth in SLG (.528), 10th in OPS (.921), first in triples (3) and sixth in total bases (28). **Andy Thomas** is tied for third in walks (14). **Ismael Munguia** is tied for third in runs scored (12). **Luis Matos** is tied for fifth in runs scored (11). **Hayden Cantrelle** is tied for ninth in runs scored (10). **Kai-Wei Teng** is second in strikeouts (25). **Carson Seymour** is tied for first in games started (4). **Evan Gates** is tied for seventh in saves (2).

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Cesar Prieto is first in batting average (.402), fourth in OBP (.439), seventh in OPS (.955), first in hits (25) and third in total bases (32). Heston Kjerstad is tied for first in homers (5), fourth in SLG (.564), ninth in OPS (.923), fourth in total bases (31) and tied for first in runs scored (13). John Rhodes is third in RBIs (12). Coby Mayo is tied for seventh in total bases (27).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, **Luis Matos** (No. 5), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Erik Miller** (No. 15), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Nick Swiney** (No. 24), **Patrick Bailey** (No. 27) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Bailey (No. 11), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
