YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 9-3. **Hayden Cantrelle** opened the scoring with an RBI double in the second and **Carter Williams** hit a two-run homer to open a 3-0 lead for the Flying Squirrels in the second. In the bottom of the inning, Heston Kjerstad closed the score to 3-1. **Carter Aldrete** hit an RBI single in the third and **Andy Thomas** added another RBI single in the fifth to extend the lead to 5-1. Kjerstad hit a solo homer in the fifth move the score to 5-2. Jacob Teter brought the Baysox within two runs with an RBI single in the sixth, but the Flying Squirrels responded with four runs in the seventh to pull away, 9-3. **Ismael Munguia** scored on a passed ball, Thomas doubled in a run, Aldrete hit an RBI double and Cantrelle added an RBI single in the frame. **Evan Gates** closed the game with 2.1 scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today marks the third of 24 games between the Flying Squirrels and the Baysox this season, tied for the most Richmond will play against any opponent. The Flying Squirrels return to Prince George's Stadium for a six-game series from June 13-18. The Baysox visit The Diamond for a six-game set from July 4-9 and again from August 8-13. The Flying Squirrels are 8-6 this year against opponents from the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels are 6-4 in games following a win.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won seven-of-the-last-10 games and are in first place in the division, 2.5 games ahead of Akron and Altoona. After starting the season 4-0 for the first time in team history, Richmond dropped four-of-the-next-five games before taking four-of-six last week against the SeaWolves. The Flying Squirrels offense ranks first in the Eastern League in batting average (.256), runs (99), hits (143), RBIs (86), OBP (.354), SLG (.396) and OPS (.750). The Richmond pitching staff leads the league in strikeouts (186) and have the EL's second-best ERA (3.41).

THE BAYSOX have lost five straight and seven-of-their-last-eight games, including four-of-five in last week's series in Altoona. Bowie's pitching staff currently holds the third-lowest ERA in the Eastern League (3.54). Bowie's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 prospects, including Coby Mayo (No. 10), Heston Kjerstad (No. 12), Cade Povich (No. 13), Justin Armbruster (No. 20), Chayce McDermott (No. 23), Cesar Prieto (No. 25), John Rhodes (No. 27) and Carlos Tavera (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes Kjerstad (No. 5), Mayo (No. 9), Povich (No. 12), Prieto (No. 17), McDermott (No. 18) and Rhodes (No. 20).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Mason Black** makes fourth Double-A start. Last time out, he was charged with a loss after allowing four runs (two earned) over 2.1 innings against the SeaWolves on Friday. A native of Scranton, Pa., Black was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University, where he was the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year as a junior. He made his professional debut last season with the Low-A San Jose Giants, posting a 1.57 ERA in eight starts. Black led the minors with a 0.35 ERA for the month of May last season and earned a promotion to High-A Eugene on May 24. For the season, he ranked fourth in the Giants organization with 136 strikeouts last year and was named an MiLB.com Giants Organization All-Star. Black is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. **For more on Black, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Justin Armbruster makes his fourth start of the season. He last pitched last Thursday at Altoona and worked 5.1 scoreless innings in a no-decision, allowing three hits. He was the Opening Day starter for the Baysox on April 6 at Hartford and threw five scoreless innings to pick up a win. Armbruster was selected by the Orioles in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of New Mexico. He was promoted to Double-A last June and closed the year going 4-1 with a 3.69 ERA in 14 outings (10 starts) for the Baysox. Following the season, he was named an MiLB.com Orioles Organization All-Star. On the year, Armbruster is ranked seventh in the Eastern League in ERA (1.26).

STARTING STRONG: The Flying Squirrels lead the Southwest Division with an 11-6 record this year, which the second-best start in team history through 17 games. The only year with a better record to open the season with 2018, when the team was 12-5. That year also had the team's best start through 18 games at 12-6. This year, Richmond went 4-0 to start the season, the longest unbeaten streak to start a year in franchise history.

RISPY BUSINESS: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .319 (53-for-166) with runners in scoring position, which leads the Eastern League. Richmond also has the best batting average in the league with runners in scoring position and two outs at .320 (24-for-75). With runners on base, the Flying Squirrels are leading the EL with a .311 average (83-for-267).

HITZ-GERALD: With his triple on Tuesday at Bowie, **Tyler Fitzgerald** became the first player in the Eastern League this year with three three-base hits. He added three hits in Wednesday's win over the Baysox, including a double, and scored three runs. On the year, Fitzgerald is third in the Eastern League in hits (19), tied for third in extra-base hits (8), tied for third in runs scored (13), tied for fourth in batting average (.333), fifth in total bases (32), sixth in SLG (.561), sixth in OPS (.985), seventh in OBP (.424). He is also leading the league in BABIP (.462) this season.

HEY, HAYDEN: **Hayden Cantrelle** has hit safely in 10-of-his-last-11 games, batting .317 (13-for-41) with four doubles, six RBIs and 10 runs scored while adding three stolen bases. For the season, Cantrelle is tied for seventh in the Eastern League with 11 runs scored.

WELCOME, CARTER WILLIAMS: In his Double-A debut on Saturday night at The Diamond, **Carter Williams** picked up an RBI triple for his first Double-A hit in the Flying Squirrels' 2-0 win over the SeaWolves. On Wednesday at Bowie, he clubbed his first Double-A homer, a two-run shot. He opened the season with High-A Eugene and picked up four hits in three games played before being promoted on Saturday. Last year, Williams hit .336 over 80 games between Low-A San Jose and Eugene.

MATOS MANIA: **Luis Matos** has reached base in each of his first 16 Double-A games. His 16-game on-base streak is the longest in the Eastern League this year. Matos has reached base 27 total times with 15 hits and 12 walks. He hit a homer in his Double-A debut in Game 1 of the Flying Squirrels' season-opening doubleheader on April 8 against Reading. In last week's series, Matos hit .350 (7-for-20) with three doubles, four walks, one RBI and six runs scored. For the year, Matos has struck out just six times in 65 plate appearances (8.6 percent).

PATTY BARRELS: **Patrick Bailey** was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on Thursday night. With Richmond, he picked up at least one hit in 10-of-his-14 games played. Last Tuesday, Bailey hit his first Double-A homer and tied a team record with five hits, going 5-for-5 with a walk and three RBIs. It was the 10th five-hit game by a Flying Squirrels batter in team history. He picked up two hits on Sunday and drove in two runs. He added an eighth-inning, go-ahead homer in Tuesday's 4-2 win over the Baysox to begin this week's series. At the time of the promotion, Bailey was ranked fifth in the Eastern League in batting average (.333) and third in hits (18).

TAKE A WALK: **Andy Thomas** is tied for fourth in Eastern League with 14 walks. He leads the Eastern League with a 24.6-percent walk rate. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest League in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58). He has worked at least one walk in seven-of-his-12 games played so far this season. In the first two games of this week's series, he has hit .571 (4-for-7) with a homer, a double and three RBIs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Patrick Bailey** is ranked tied for fourth in batting average (.333) and tied for fourth in hits (18). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for fourth in batting average (.333), seventh in OBP (.424), sixth in SLG (.561), sixth in OPS (.985), third in hits (19), first in triples (8), fifth in total bases (32) and tied for third in runs scored (13). **Carter Aldrete** is tied for fourth in RBIs (14). **Andy Thomas** is tied for fourth in walks (14). **Ismael Munguia** is tied for third in runs scored (13). **Kai-Wei Teng** is third in strikeouts (25). **Evan Gates** is tied for seventh in saves (2).

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Cesar Prieto is first in batting average (.394), fifth in OBP (.437), eighth in OPS (.937), first in hits (26) and fourth in total bases (33). Heston Kjerstad is first in homers (6), tied for first in SLG (.644), fourth in OPS (1.021), second in extra-base hits (9), tied for first in total bases (38) and first in runs scored. John Rhodes is tied for fourth in RBIs (12). Coby Mayo is tied for third in extra-base hits (8) and tied for eighth in total bases (29). Justin Armbruster is seventh in ERA (1.26).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, **Luis Matos** (No. 5), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Erik Miller** (No. 15), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Nick Swiney** (No. 24), **Patrick Bailey** (No. 27) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Bailey (No. 11), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
