# TODAY'S STARTER

**SPENCER SCHWELLENBACH | RIGHT-HANDED PITCHER | #33**

## BIO

**CURRENT NOTES:** Making first career affiliated appearance as GreenJackets OD starter

**CAREER:** Spencer Schwellenbach was a 2nd round pick of the Braves out of Nebraska in 2021, falling despite being a projected first rounder due to reports of a potential injury during workouts. The Braves were thrilled that he fell to them, and signed him despite knowing he would likely need the Tommy John surgery which sidelined him for the entire 2022 season. Out of Saginaw, Michigan, Schwellenbach was a 34th round pick of the Guardians in 2018, but elected to fulfill his commitment to the Cornhuskers. In college, Schwellenbach was a dominant two-way player his senior year after featuring solely as an infielder his first three years. He held opponents to a .198 batting average with a dominant fastball, recording 10 saves and a remarkable ERA of 0.57. He also hit .284, with 9 stolen bases and 9 home runs. Those stat lines led to him being named as the Big 10 2021 Player of the Year, a first-team All-American, the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year, a Golden Spikes semifinalist, and more. He is expected to feature as a pitcher.

**CURRENT NOTES:** Named to Augusta's opening day roster after making 9 appearances (8 starts) with the GreenJackets in 2022

**2022:** Started season with Augusta, making two appearances before being sent down to the FCL Braves. Following 8 dominant starts in the complex, Bautista returned to Augusta, where he recorded wins in the final three starts of the season and two straight quality starts to end the year. Opponents hit .383 against him in Augusta, the highest of any GreenJackets pitcher, arguably inflated by his second start of the year, when he gave up 8 runs on 9 hits in one inning of work. However, he was dominant in the FCL, holding opponents under .200 and fanning 45 batters in 37.1 innings of work. In 2022, he had a 1.83 ground-out to air-out ratio, the highest of his career. He induced the most double-plays of any pitcher in Augusta in 2022, with 8.

**CAREER:** Signed by Braves as an international FA in 2018. From the age of 16 to 18, he pitched in the Dominican league, working as a reliever in 2018 before transitioning into a starting role in 2019. He pitched 40 innings in the Complex in 2021, making 12 appearances with a 5.98 ERA.

**CURRENT NOTES:**

**2022:** Bryant began the 2022 season on the injured list, before getting activated and sent to the FCL in July. He went for 18 innings across 9 appearances, fanning 16 and not surrendering a home run.

**CAREER:** Played at Pensacola State in 2018 and 2019, making 26 appearances across two years. Committed to his home-state school, Alabama, but elected to sign with the Braves. He was previously drafted twice, once in the 39th round by the Rangers in 2017 and again in the 34th round in 2018. Drafted in the 25th round in 2019, signed for \$100,000. Threw 24 innings in the FCL in his draft year, starting 7 of his 11 games. In 2021, Bryant spent the entire season in Augusta, compiling a record of 0-5 while battling injuries.

#### CURRENT NOTES:

**2022:** After signing in July, De Grandpre pitched 3 scoreless innings in the FCL, giving up just one hit. In 3 games in Augusta, he gave up 9 runs in 5.2 innings, but did strike out 8. This will be his first full season in affiliated ball after splitting time last year between the JUCO, MLB Draft League, and FCL/Carolina League ranks.

**CAREER:** Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 13th round of the 2022 draft out of powerhouse JUCO Chiploa in Florida, where he was their number one starter. In 18 starts his sophomore year, De Grandpre had an 8-4 record with a 2.80 ERA. He fanned 89 batters in 70.2 innings, and only allowed 7 extra base hits over the course of the season. While playing in the MLB Draft League for the West Virginia Power, he struck out 26 batters in 16 innings, catching the attention of many teams. He signed over slot for \$237,500 and reported to the FCL, rather than attend Arizona State, where he had previously committed. Grew up in Quebec, and attended Ecole Secondaire Fadette in Saint-Hyacinth, QC.

#### CURRENT NOTES:

**CAREER:** Murphy was a two-sport standout, also playing QB and WR for his high school team. During his senior year, he gave up just 10 hits in 58.1 innings while striking out 137 – more than 2 batters per inning. He tossed four no-hitters and two perfect games, while also hitting .548 with 10 homers. He was a projected top-100 pick as a two-way player, but his pitching elevated him to first-round status. He was named the 2022 Illinois Gatorade Player of the Year and was originally committed to Notre Dame, but after being selected 20th overall by the Braves he elected to sign for \$2,560,000. He pitched 5 scoreless innings in the FCL, striking out seven, before giving up six runs in seven innings on just five hits with ten punchouts in three Augusta starts late in the season.

#### CURRENT NOTES:

**CAREER:** 8th rounder out of Cal Poly in 2022. Played for Cal Poly's club team his freshman and sophomore year. He walked onto the varsity squad his junior year, making 5 appearances for the varsity team over the next two years, but in 2022 (his final year) he made 31 appearances, notching 11 saves and striking out 69 in 54 innings. Signed underslot and made 6 appearances in the FCL, going 6.2 innings in that time. Was teammates at Cal Poly with Brooks Lee, current #31 overall prospect and 8th overall pick of the Twins. Majored in Civil Engineering, and jokes that he throws "99% fastballs."

#### CURRENT NOTES:

**CAREER:** Signed as an international free agent out of Columbia for \$75,000 in January of 2022. Was utterly dominant in the DSL as 16 and then 17 year old, becoming a DSL All-Star and pitching 44 innings across 11 games. He struck out 50 batters in that time, with a WHIP of 1.02 and limiting opponents to a .217 batting average. At the age of 17 years, 9 months, and 17 days old on Opening Day, Fuentes becomes just the fifth 17 year old to appear on an opening day roster in affiliated baseball since 2017, and the youngest player since Eguy Rosario in 2017 to feature for an affiliated club. He will turn 18 in June.

**CAREER:** Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in Competitive Balance Round-A as the 35th overall pick in the 2022 Draft. Was the picked acquired by the Braves from the Kansas City Royals in return for prospects Drew Waters, Andrew Hoffman, and C.J. Alexander. Pitched at Bainbridge High School in Washington who finished his senior season with a 0.39 ERA, 0.45 WHIP, 75 K, and 4 BB in 35.1 innings on the mound, allowing just 2 runs on 12 hits on the season as he helped lead his team to the Washington State Tournament. Lost just one game in his entire High School which occurred his freshman year. Had originally committed to UCLA prior to being selected in the Braves.

#### CURRENT NOTES:

**CAREER:** Drafted by the Braves in the 14th Round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Southern Mississippi, was the last of the Braves' 22 picks to sign (\$140,000). Began his college career at Pearl River Community College in Poplarville, Mississippi where he pitched for two years. Appeared in just four games on the mound in 2020 due to the shortened COVID Season. Impressed in 2021 with 41 strikeouts in 30.2 innings, allowing just 22 hits and 11 runs during the campaign. Transferred to Southern Mississippi for the 2022 season and had a breakout year with 50 strikeouts and just 9 walks in 43.2 innings out of the bullpen as the team's closer, finishing the season with a team-best 12 saves and a 2-2 record. Made one appearance in the FCL, recording a three-pitch inning, before making four appearances out of Augusta's bullpen, giving up 17 hits in 10 innings.

Had a 1.15 WHIP and 58 strikeouts in 59 innings, notching 9 saves in 12 save opportunities. Stranded 16 of 21 inherited runners on the season. Had a 0.90 ERA his final year in college at as a grad student at LIU, where he recorded 5 saves and only gave up 3 runs in 30 innings pitched. **CAREER:** Drafted by the Braves in the 6th round of the 2022 draft out of Hanover HS in Mechanichsville, VA, and signed for a way overslot \$697,500 rather than attend Old Dominion. His senior year, Keller went 6-0 with a 0.58 ERA and struck out 75 hitters, allowing just nine hits and nine walks in 36 innings.
