ABOUT LA GALAXY II

LA Galaxy II is coming off a 3-1 win against Oakland Roots on July 1, a victory that helped "Los Dos" move into sixth place in the Western Conference standings. LA Galaxy II can in part thank Owen Lambe for the three points. He helped his team with one assist, had two chances created, completed 53 of 56 passes and made three clearances, ultimately landing him on the USL Championship Week 17 Team of the Week. Coach Yoann Damet's team has now won two in a row after also beating Miami FC June 25. It has been somewhat of an inconsistent start to the 2022 season for LA Galaxy II as it went on a pattern of winning a match then losing or playing to a draw on the next.

This is the third time LA Galaxy II faces SD Loyal this season. SD Loyal won the first meeting 2-1 on March 12 at Torero Stadium. Los Dos overcame a 2-0 deficit with a pair of stoppage time goals to save a point and draw 2-2 against SD Loyal on May 28. LA Galaxy has not beaten SD Loyal in its last six attempts.

LOOKING AHEAD AT THE MATCH

SD Loyal comes into Saturday's match against LA Galaxy II after overcoming its toughest challenge of the season. Falling a man down and still defeating one of the best teams in the league to celebrate the Fourth of July, SD Loyal's 3-2 come-from-behind victory over Colorado Switchbacks FC solidified Coach Landon Donovan's team as a top contender in the USL Championship. SD Loyal persisted through its sudden adversity, implementing its fluid brand of attacking soccer. The club's effort paid off when Evan Conway scored the eventual game-winning goal in the 81st minute. "A lot of teams would have probably backed off and said let's play to get a tie here but our guys wanted to keep going and win the game. It was a great performance from everyone," Donovan said about the win

SD Loyal hopes to continue the same type of performance, this time at home against another Western Conference rival in LA Galaxy II. SD Loyal comes into Saturday's match in third place, only two points behind second place Colorado Springs and six behind first place San Antonio FC. This is the second time LA Galaxy II will play at Torero Stadium this season. SD Loyal won the first meeting 2-1 in the season opener on March 12. The Week 1 match had a dramatic finish as striker Thomas Amang scored the first goal for the home side and later was involved in a play that resulted in a LA Galaxy II own goal that was eventually the game-winner for SD Loyal.

ABOUT SD LOYAL

SD Loyal is in its third season after becoming an expansion and playing in its inaugural season in the USL Championship in 2020. It is coming off its first ever playoff appearance, a 2-0 loss against San Antonio FC in the first round. It was SD Loyal's first season playing more than 20 games with a revamped schedule that included 32 matches, mostly against teams in its geographical region. SD Loyal finished third in the Pacific Division with a 14-12-6 record and 48 points in a season that had several milestones.

It's first season in 2020 was a turbulent one for the club due the COVID-19 pandemic. It got to play its inaugural game in front of a sold-out home crowd then competition came to a halt in March. The league revamped the schedule and resumed play in July. SD Loyal went on to a 6-5-5 record under first-year coach Landon Donovan, finishing in fourth place in the Group B standings.

It finished the season with a forfeit in its regular season finale against Phoenix Rising FC after SD Loyal players walked off the pitch after a homophobic slur was used against one of its players before halftime. SD Loyal was in position to make a push for the playoffs before the forfeit. It was the second forfeit by SD Loyal in 2020. Donovan's team also forfeit a match against L.A. Galaxy II after a racial slur was used against one of its players.

Launched on June 19, 2019, San Diego Loyal is one of the newest members of USL Championship Western Conference. San Diego Loyal plays for America's Finest City and is led by some of the best in sport. The Club is led by Chairman Andrew Vassiliadis, who is the youngest principal owner in USL Championship. Team operations are led by President Ricardo Campos. The Executive Vice President of Soccer Operations Landon Donovan, one of the most decorated soccer players in the U.S., leads the technical side as both EVP and Team Manager. San Diego Loyal is built on four core pillars – Completion, Commitment, Connection, Camaraderie. San Diego Loyal holds training camps at the Chula Vista Elite Athlete Training Center.

Home matches are played at Torero Stadium located on the University of San Diego campus. It has hosted numerous important soccer events including the U.S. Women's National team and MLS clubs LA Galaxy, Chivas USA and Club Tijuana. It's also the temporary home to National Women's Soccer League's expansion team San Diego Wave FC.

Regarded as one of the greatest U.S. soccer players in history, Landon Donovan brings his extensive knowledge of the game to San Diego Loyal's technical staff. During his 19-year professional career, Donovan's accomplishments span both his time domestically and internationally. In total, he played for five professional teams covering three leagues: Bayer 04 Leverkusen and Bayern Munich (Bundesliga); Everton (Premier League); San Jose Earthquakes and LA Galaxy (Major League Soccer). He played in six MLS Cups, the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup and earned two MLS Supporters' Shields. Individually, he was named to an MLS record 14-consecutive MLS All-Star games from 2001-2014, was honored with the Landon Donovan MVP Award in 2009 and won the Golden Boot in 2008, as well as being one of just two players to be named MLS Cup MVP twice. He still leads the MLS record books in assists (136), playoff goals (25) and co-leads MLS in playoff assists (14). He is second to Chris Wondolowski with most regularseason goals at 145. Donovan's contributions to the U.S. Men's National Team continues to dominate the record books. He leads the USMNT in goals (57), assists (58), second in appearances (157) and is the only American player to surpass both 50 goals and 50 assists in his career. He was the fastest American to earn 100 caps and played for the U.S. in three FIFA World Cups. His individual awards include the 1999 FIFA U-17 World Championship Golden Ball Award, FIFA's Best Young Player of the 2002 World Cup, the CONCACAF Gold Cup MVP in 2013, a Gold Cup Best XI selection four times and U.S. Soccer Athlete of the Year a record four times.

Miller is in his third season with SD Loyal as the associate head coach. Miller joined the team in 2020 after serving as head coach of the Spring Arbor University men's soccer program for six seasons, where his accomplishments included an overall record of 86-32-15, one league champi-onship title, two regular season titles and being named 2018 Crossroads League Coach of the Year. Miller was also the general manager and head coach of Lansing United – a former mem-ber of the Premier Development League (PDL) – and, in 2019, was the inaugural head coach of USL League One expansion side Lansing Ignite FC.
