ABOUT OAKLAND ROOTS SC

Oakland Roots is coming off a 1-1 draw against Detroit City FC. It was it's second consecutive point after another draw the previous week but Oakland has won only one match in its last five.

LOOKING AHEAD AT THE MATCH

SD Loyal returned to its winning ways with a 3-1 road victory against El Paso Locomotive FC Saturday. It's a quick turnaround for coach Landon Donovan's team as it now prepares to host Oakland Roots SC on Wednesday in another Western Conference matchup. The midweek clash marks one of just three remaining regular season home matches for SD Loyal as the club vies for the top spot in the conference. SD Loyal comes into the match in second place with a 16W-6L-4D record and 52 points, five behind first place San Antonio FC. Donovan's team continues to punish the opposition with a versatile attack and efficient goal scoring. Against El Paso, it was team-leading scorer Kyle Vassell who opened the floodgates, followed by Thomas Amang and Evan Conway.

"We created a ton of chances," Donovan said about the match. "We've said it all along, if teams are going to leave us 2v2 in the back, with Vassell and Amang or Andrew (Carleton) and Amang, Vassell and Tumi (Moshobane) or whomever, then you just go kill them and score goals. The goals come when you create a lot of chances."

SD Loyal is the top scoring team in the league with 56 goals, five better than Colorado Springs Switchbacks FC. It hopes to continue finding the net against Oakland, a team that has allowed 36 goals this season. But Donovan and his squad are not taking this next match lightly.

LAST TIME THEY MET

Collin Martin and Grant Stoneman scored in the second half but it wasn't enough as SD Loyal allowed a last second goal in a 2-2 draw against host Oakland Roots SC in a crazy finish on a chilly night at Laney College Football Stadium. Martin's first goal of the season (second with the club) and Stoneman's score (also his first of the season) via bicycle kick had SD Loyal looking at three more points in the standings. Instead, coach Landon Donovan's team gave up the lead twice to earn only a point against an Oakland team that played with 10 men for the final 26 minutes of the wild match. SD Loyal appeared to be closing in on its sixth win but Oakland forward Óttar Magnús Karlsson tied the match four minutes into stoppage

ABOUT SD LOYAL

SD Loyal is in its third season after becoming an expansion and playing in its inaugural season in the USL Championship in 2020. It is coming off its first ever playoff appearance, a 2-0 loss against San Antonio FC in the first round. It was SD Loyal's first season playing more than 20 games with a revamped schedule that included 32 matches, mostly against teams in its geographical region. SD Loyal finished third in the Pacific Division with a 14-12-6 record and 48 points in a season that had several milestones.

It's first season in 2020 was a turbulent one for the club due the COVID-19 pandemic. It got to play its inaugural game in front of a sold-out home crowd then competition came to a halt in March. The league revamped the schedule and resumed play in July. SD Loyal went on to a 6-5-5 record under first-year coach Landon Donovan, finishing in fourth place in the Group B standings.

It finished the season with a forfeit in its regular season finale against Phoenix Rising FC after SD Loyal players walked off the pitch after a homophobic slur was used against one of its players before halftime. SD Loyal was in position to make a push for the playoffs before the forfeit. It was the second forfeit by SD Loyal in 2020. Donovan's team also forfeit a match against L.A. Galaxy II after a racial slur was used against one of its players.

Launched on June 19, 2019, San Diego Loyal is one of the newest members of USL Championship Western Conference. San Diego Loyal plays for America's Finest City and is led by some of the best in sport. The Club is led by Chairman Andrew Vassiliadis, who is the youngest principal owner in USL Championship. Team operations are led by President Ricardo Campos. The Executive Vice President of Soccer Operations Landon Donovan, one of the most decorated soccer players in the U.S., leads the technical side as both EVP and Team Manager. San Diego Loyal is built on four core pillars – Completion, Commitment, Connection, Camaraderie. San Diego Loyal holds training camps at the Chula Vista Elite Athlete Training Center.

Home matches are played at Torero Stadium located on the University of San Diego campus. It has hosted numerous important soccer events including the U.S. Women's National team and MLS clubs LA Galaxy, Chivas USA and Club Tijuana. It's also the temporary home to National Women's Soccer League's expansion team San Diego Wave FC.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

- SD Loyal currently sits in second place in the Western Conference with a 16W-6L-4D record and 52 points after 26 matches played.
- SD Loyal has scored the most goals in the USL Championship this season (56), five better than Colorado Springs Switchbacks FC.
- SD Loyal has won six of its last seven matches, the best run of any team in the Western Conference.
- SD Loyal has scored in 23 of its 26 games, more than any other team this season.

The Spanish goalkeeper comes from Levante UD of La Liga. He is coming off a season at Mallorca of the Spanish second division where he appeared in one match after being sent there on loan. He has played for a handful of teams in that division but has had La Liga experience with Levante since 2017. Vegas became the SD Loyal starting goalkeeper at the start of the 2022 season. He quickly dispalyed his global experience, helping SD Loyal to its best start in franchise history. Prior to coming to San Diego, Vegas made his La Liga debut in May 2018, keeping a clean sheet in a 4-2 away loss against Celta de Vigo. He was loaned to second division club Deportivo La Coruña for a year after spending the campaign as a third-choice behind Oier Olazábal and Aitor Fernández in July 2019.

Tallying one goal and three assists in 2021, Martin uses his speed and physicality to help in the attack. Martin was named to the league's Team of the Week in September 2021 and was also part of the first XI for the team's first ever post season match. Martin was also a consistent starter in the inaugural season for SD Loyal, working the left side of coach Landon Dono-van's three-man defensive backline. He has quickly became a dominant force on the field.



JACK METCALF

Stoneman made his USL Championship debut while starting for SD Loyal in the team's debut match against Las Vegas Lights.

He played there after being selected in the second round of the 2019 MLS SuperDraft by Sporting Kansas City and was subsequently signed by its USL Championship affiliate.

He earned Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honors his senior season along with a hand-ful of other accolades during his time there.

Hackworth also saw extensive time on the pitch in the later part of the 2020 season, playing in seven games, logging 375 minutes.

As the team captain, Adams helped keep the squad working towards each match goals despite the ups and downs of losing streaks and then unbeaten weeks in 2021. Adams showed off his quality as a ball distributor with an 87-per-cent pass accuracy and 29 accurate crosses. He had four assists while also displaying defensive capability with 64 interceptions and 58-percent of his challenges won last season. Adams will be tattooed into SD Loyal history. The English play maker scored the first official goal in SD Loyal history in a 1-1 tie against Las Vegas Lights in the team's debut.

Blake was an immediate impact player for SD Loyal in 2021 with his dangerous shot from outside the penalty box. The Englishman was tied for second in the league with four goals from beyond the box. He played in 25 matches, starting in 23, scoring five goals in a season that had him miss a handful of games due to injury. Blake returned in time for the playoffs, finishing the year with four assists and 1,877 minutes played.

He played in 31 games, of which he started 21. He had six goals and four assists in 1,946 minutes played. 

His pro career began as a teenager in Norway, where he signed with Molde FK in Norway's top league at age 18 in 2016.

MANAGER



LANDON DONOVAN

Regarded as one of the greatest U.S. soccer players in history, Landon Donovan brings his extensive knowledge of the game to San Diego Loyal's technical staff. During his 19-year professional career, Donovan's accomplishments span both his time domestically and internationally. In total, he played for five professional teams covering three leagues: Bayer 04 Leverkusen and Bayern Munich (Bundesliga); Everton (Premier League); San Jose Earthquakes and LA Galaxy (Major League Soccer). He played in six MLS Cups, the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup and earned two MLS Supporters' Shields. Individually, he was named to an MLS record 14-consecutive MLS All-Star games from 2001-2014, was honored with the Landon Donovan MVP Award in 2009 and won the Golden Boot in 2008, as well as being one of just two players to be named MLS Cup MVP twice. He still leads the MLS record books in assists (136), playoff goals (25) and co-leads MLS in playoff assists (14). He is second to Chris Wondolowski with most regular season goals at 145. Donovan's contributions to the U.S. Men's National Team continues to dominate the record books. He leads the USMNT in goals (57), assists (58), second in appearances (157) and is the only American player to surpass both 50 goals and 50 assists in his career. He was the fastest American to earn 100 caps and played for the U.S. in three FIFA World Cups. His individual awards include the 1999 FIFA U-17 World Championship Golden Ball Award, FIFA's Best Young Player of the 2002 World Cup, the CONCACAF Gold Cup MVP in 2013, a Gold Cup Best XI selection four times and U.S. Soccer Athlete of the Year a record four times.

NATE MILLER

Miller is in his third season with SD Loyal as the associate head coach. Miller joined the team in 2020 after serving as head coach of the Spring Arbor University men's soccer program for six seasons, where his accomplishments included an overall record of 86-32-15, one league championship title, two regular season titles and being named 2018 Crossroads League Coach of the Year. Miller was also the general manager and head coach of Lansing United – a former member of the Premier Development League (PDL) – and, in 2019, was the inaugural head coach of USL League One expansion side Lansing Ignite FC.
