### 4 THINGS TO KNOW

- SD Loyal kicked off the 2023 season with a 1-0 win against visiting Detroit City FC with a goal by defender Jackson Simba.
- This is a Western Conference rivalry that has produced intense matches since SD Loyal came into the USL Championship in 2020.
- Phoenix leads the all-time series 4-3-1, including a win by forfeit on Sept. 30, 2020, after SD Loyal players walked off the pitch at halftime due to a homophobic slur directed at Collin Martin.
- SD Loyal added Haitian striker Ronaldo Damus to the roster this week, adding to Miller's fluid attack.

## MATCH PREVIEW

SD Loyal played its first match of the 2023 season last week, earning three points with a 1-0 win against visiting Detroit City FC. This week, SD Loyal hosts Phoenix Rising FC in a Western Conference showdown. The clubs have met eight times with Phoenix leading the all-time series 4W-3L-1D. The last time they faced each other, SD Loyal clinched a playoff berth with a 3-0 win in September. Phoenix is coming off a disappointing 2022 campaign in which it finished 10th in the Western Conference with a 12W-16L-6D record and 42 points. The Arizona club hopes to bounce back with a renovated roster that includes the addition of striker Danny Trejo after losing Aodhan Quinn. Phoenix, who is coached by Juan Guerra and has a key returner in Kعون Lambert, is coming off a 1-1 draw against Charleston Battery in its season opener on the road.

Goalkeeper

Vegas enters his second season with SD Loyal. He cemented himself as the starter in 2022. Vegas is a goalkeeper that has quality in his touch, helping the team begin attacking from the back. He came from Levante UD of La Liga. He played at Mallorca of the Spanish second division in 2021 where he appeared in one match after being sent there on loan. He has played for a handful of teams in that division but has had La Liga experience with Levante since 2017. Vegas also became a fan favorite as he stood under goal in front of the official supporter groups at Torero Stadium.

HACKWORTH**

Forward

Morgan joined SD Loyal in February 2020 after spending the 2019 season playing for Memphis 1901. He played in 16 games with seven starts with Memphis in 2019 totaling 661 minutes. Before that, he played in the USL League Two. He played his college soccer career at Syracuse (2015-2017) where he played in eight games. He went on to play at Akron University (2017-2018) where he was named an Academic All-MAC selection, CoSIDA Academic All-America nominee and an Academic All-Ohio honoree. He was a member of the U-16 and U-18 Philadelphia Union Academy teams and led his team to fifth-place finish at 2014 Generation Adidas Cup.

MARTIN**

Defender

Martin started the SD Loyal inaugural season as part of the Team 1 first 11, working the left side of the defensive backline. He is an experienced defender at the USL Championship level, playing 31 games for the now defuncted Fresno FC in 2019. Martin spent the previous seasons with the Fresno FC U-23s and Fresno Fuego at the USL League Two level. Martin returned USL Championship for the first time since he spent two seasons with LA Galaxy II, playing in 17 matches in 2014 and 2015. Martin has also represented the United States as a youth, having played for the U-17 U.S. Boys National Team during the 2013 CONCACAF U-17 Championships in Panama.

Defender

Stoneman made his USL Championship debut while starting for SD Loyal in the team's debut match. Stoneman was part of Team 1 first 11 in the opener against Las Vegas Lights. He earned a spot as the starting defender on the right side of the defensive line. He can also play in the middle of the defense. Stoneman played in the USL League One and USL League Two before joining SD Loyal. His first team out of college was Lansing United of the National Premier Soccer League in 2016. Stoneman played college soccer at Wisconsin and later transferred to Loyola University in Chicago where he earned Second Team United Soccer Coaches All-America in 2016.

ADAMS**

Midfielder

Adams returns as a team leader. He was a key component in 2022. The team captain, Adams helped keep the squad working towards each match goals despite the ups and downs of losing streaks and then unbeaten weeks in 2021. The 27 year-old midfielder has been the heart of the midfield since coming here. He played in 33 matches while starting in 29 games in 2021. Adams showed off his quality as a ball distributor with an 87-percent pass accuracy and 29 accurate crosses. He had four assists while also displaying defensive capability with 64 interceptions and 58-percent of his challenges won during the 2021 season.

BODILY**

Midfielder

Bodily joined SD Loyal in January 2023 after spending the last three years with Portland Timbers of Major League Soccer. Bodily signed a homegrown contract with Portland in Jan. 2020 following three standout seasons with the University of Washington. Prior to the University of Washington, Bodily spent time with Portland Timbers Academy and Portland Timbers 2 from 2014-2017. Bodily first began playing with Portland Timbers 2 in 2015 where he appeared in 35 matches, scoring four goals. Bodily was acquired on loan by SD Loyal in October of 2021, playing in three matches with the club that month and then was recalled a few weeks later by Portland.

**RONALDO  
DAMUS**

Forward

Damus joined SD Loyal for the 2023 USL Championship season. The 23-year-old came from Swedish side GIF Sundsvall of the Superettan, the first division in Sweden. The Haitian striker played in 25 matches for GIF Sundsvall in 2022, scoring five goals and recording two assists. Damus was permanently transferred to the Swedish side after playing with Orange County SC in 2021 and part of 2022. During his time with GIF Sundsvall, Damus played alongside his now SD Loyal teammate Joe Corona for the 2022 Allsvenskan, Sweden's top flight division. The speedy and versatile forward was a key piece in helping Orange County win the 2021 USL Championship Final.

Forward

Conway joined SD Loyal after playing with Union Omaha of the USL League One in 2021 in which he played in 18 matches and started in 15. He scored 13 goals while playing in 1,258 minutes and added an assist. He is a dynamic forward who can play multiple positions. The Wisconsin native also played with Ventura County Fusion of the USL League 2 in 2019. Conway became an important piece of the SD Loyal attack as he helped produce several late game-winning goals. He is a forward that can attack from either side outside the penalty box but he can also play up front, a role he will take on this season.

Midfielder

Guido was signed to the squad Sept. 1, 2020 on loan from LAFC. The midfielder became an impact player immediately. He helped spark an offense with his presence at midfield. He helped set up an assist in his first match with SD Loyal and went on to score two goals in a win against Orange County SC, just a few days after signing. Guido grew up playing in local youth soccer leagues in the South Bay in South San Diego County and in Tijuana just across the border. He had trials and a short stint in Holland before signing with Club Tijuana of Liga MX. He played at different levels with the Xolos, eventually making his way onto the first team roster all the way from the U-20 team.

MOSHOBANE**

Midfielder

Moshobane is a versatile striker who adds a diverse attack for SD Loyal. He was part of the team's first ever win, a 2-1 victory at Tacoma Defiance. Moshobane came to the United States in 2015 and began to play soccer at the collegiate level at Kankakee Community College in Illinois. He transferred to Olivet Nazarene University from 2016 to 2018 where his uncle, Vincent Mkhwanazi, is one of the most decorated players to come out of Olivet Nazarene University's soccer program and is from Moshobane's hometown. He sat out the 2016 season then shined in 2017 and 2018, scoring 17 goals and seven assists in 40 appearances.

RILEY**

Defender

Riley, a defender, that came to San Diego from Rio Grande Valley FC. Riley played in xx games for SD Loyal in 2022. Before signing with SD Loyal, he played in 16 matches and started in 10 during the 2021 USL Championship season with RGVFC. The 25-year-old defender played 871 minutes helping his former team's back line. The Dallas, Texas native also played for Sporting Kansas City in 2020 and 2019. He played there after being selected in the second round of the 2019 MLS SuperDraft by Sporting Kansas City and was subsequently signed by its USL Championship affiliate.

Forward

San Diego Loyal SC acquired Adrien Perez on Feb. 28, 2023 ahead of the 2023 USL Championship season. The 27-year old joined SD Loyal after spending his last two seasons with Major League Soccer side D.C. United. The striker played the first three matches of 2022 for D.C. United before suffering a foot injury that kept him out the rest of the season. Perez joined D.C. United in January of 2021 after being selected in the 2020 MLS re-entry draft. The Ontario, Calif. native made 17 appearances (10 starts), recording two assists in 869 minutes played across two seasons.

CORONA**

Midfielder

Corona, a Sweetwater High School graduate, joined SD Loyal on January 18, 2023 after spending the 2022 season in Sweden playing for GIF Sundsvall of the Allsvenskan, the country's first division league. The midfielder played in 25 matches for GIF Sundsvall, logging 1,832 minutes. He was there on loan from Major League Soccer side Houston Dynamo, where he played in 30 matches and logged 1,732 minutes during the 2021 season. The 2008 Union-Tribune Player of the Year and first-team All CIF selection, Corona played one season at San Diego State University after capturing the 2007-2008 San Diego Section Championship with Sweetwater.

Defender

San Diego Loyal SC signed defender Jackson Simba Kasanzu on August 12, 2022. The Tanzanian international joined SD Loyal after playing with AFC Ann Arbor of USL League Two for the 2022 season. The defender played in eight matches for AFC Ann Arbor, starting in seven, helping his team to a 4W-2L-2D record during that span. Simba recorded 640 total minutes and two shot attempts for the season. Originally from Dar es Salaam, Tanzania, the 19-year-old defender signed his first professional contract with SD Loyal.

Midfielder

Martin is an experienced midfielder who was named to the starting line up in the team's second game. He led the midfield in the center of that five-man line against Tacoma Defiance, helping his team to a 2-1 win. Martin set up SD Loyal's first goal in that game, sending an assist via a free kick to Francis Atuahene, who charged the ball at the Defiance goal line. Martin signed with SD Loyal after spending 2019 with Hartford Athletic on loan from Major League Soccer side Minnesota United. Martin's experience in MLS began with D.C. United. He was signed to a professional contract as a home-grown player in 2013.

Collier joined SD Loyal during the offseason heading into the 2023 season. Collier joined SD Loyal after spending last season with USL Championship side San Antonio FC where he played in 23 games, scoring four goals. The forward has Major League Soccer experience. He spent four seasons with the Chicago Fire where he played in 54 matches (14 starts) while playing 1,750 minutes. Before that, he spent time on loan with Memphis 901 FC of the USL Championship in 2019. Collier also has international experience with the New Zealand national team. He earned his first call up in 2019 and had two appearances in friendlies against Ireland and Lithuania.

The 25-year-old came to San Diego from Indy Eleven where he played in 29 USL Championship matches, starting in 19 in 2021. He scored three goals and had four assists last season. He gives SD Loyal versatility as he can play at different areas off the pitch. Also from Wisconsin, not only has experience at the USL Championship level but has also played in League One where he played in 16 matches for Indy in 2020. This is Moon's second season with SD Loyal. He quickly became an explosive attacking player before suffering an injury and missing most of the season.

Ebenezer "Eby" Ackon came to San Diego after most recently playing with San Antonio FC. He was a standout during his college career at Bowling Green State University and was originally drafted by MLS side Chicago Fire during the 2019 MLS SuperDraft. Unfortunately, Ackon could not be registered because the club had exceeded their quota for international players. Prior to coming to the United States, he had a short stint at Ebusua Dwarfs in the Ghana Premier League.

Adams came to San Diego from USL Championship side Real Monarchs. The 25-year-old is an experienced defender with excellent passing skills. He played in 29 matches, starting in 27 with Real Monarchs in 2021. He had 42 interceptions and scored a goal in the 2,477 minutes he played. He had a two-year stint with fellow USL side Rio Grande Valley FC. He was the team captain in 2018- 2019, playing in 52 games. He was signed by MLS side Houston Dynamo in 2020 but was sent back on loan to RGV FC.

Ferree is the first player from Loyal Select to sign a professional contract with SD Loyal. He made it to the first team in 2022 and even saw playing time and his first start. It caught the eyes of the U.S. National Team. He made his national team debut and started in four matches for the U.S. Under-17 Men's National Team during the 2023 CONCACAF Under-17 Championship, FIFA U-17 World Cup qualifying tournament. The 16-year-old helped the U.S. qualify to the World Cup in Peru after against Barbados, Guatemala and Mexico. In the group stage, Ferree kept a pair of clean sheets.

## TECHNICAL STAFF



**LANDON DONAVAN**

**EVP, Soccer Operations**

Regarded as one of the greatest U.S. soccer players in history, Landon Donovan brings his extensive knowledge of the game to San Diego Loyal's technical staff. During his 19-year professional career, Donovan's accomplishments span both his time domestically and internationally. In total, he played for five professional teams covering three leagues: Bayer 04 Leverkusen and Bayern Munich (Bundesliga); Everton (Premier League); San Jose Earthquakes and LA Galaxy (Major League Soccer). He played in six MLS Cups, the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup and won two MLS Supporters' Shields. Individually, he was named to an MLS record 14-consecutive MLS All-Star games from 2001-2014, was honored with the Landon Donovan MVP Award in 2009 and won the Golden Boot in 2008, as well as being one of just two players to be named MLS Cup MVP twice. He continues to lead the MLS record books with assists (136), playoff goals (25) and co-leads playoff assists (14). He is second to Chris Wondolowski with most regular-season goals at 145.



**NATE MILLER**

**Head Coach**

Nate Miller is in his first season as the SD Loyal Head Coach after serving as the assistant head coach in the previous three seasons under Landon Donovan. Miller brings extensive experience to the club and is a figure that enjoys the camaraderie with his players. Miller's coaching journey started in 2010 when he walked away from a career in finance to follow his coaching passion. His first head coaching role was with Spring Arbor University where in six years at the helm, he helped lead the Cougars to three league championships and the program's highest-ever national ranking (#10). Following three seasons with Lansing United (USL League Two), Miller became the head coach at Lansing Ignite (USL League One). Miller led Lansing United to a second-place finish that included a three-month undefeated run. In Jan. 2020, Miller joined Landon Donovan as the Associate Head Coach of San Diego Loyal. Miller was part of the sixth graduating class to complete the U.S. Soccer Federation (USSF) Pro License, finishing a 12-month journey that began in December 2021. Joining an elite group of fewer than 75 coaches to have completed the highest-level coaching license in the Confederation of North, Central America and Caribbean Association Football (CONCACAF), Miller becomes the first San Diego area coach to earn the prestigious accreditation.
