#### ABOUT SAN ANTONIO FC

San Antonio is off to the best start in team history through 21 matches with a 16-3-2 record good for 50 points. The previous best was 2017, when the team went 11-1-8 with 41 points. The team is just one win away from tying the club record for wins in a single season with 17, also set in 2017. The total is already just four wins short of the fifth-most in USL Championship history.

San Antonio's six-straight wins in USL Championship play are a new club record, prior to tying against LA Galaxy II last week. The 7-0-2 mark in its last nine matches extends the longest unbeaten streak of the season since 2017 as well, with a +13 goal differential in the span. San Antonio has held opponents scoreless five times in that stretch, which has lasted since the start of June.

San Antonio FC's 16 wins are the most in the league, with the team's +22 goal differential the best in the Western Conference.

#### LOOKING AHEAD AT THE MATCH

SD Loyal is coming off a hard-fought match at Orange County SC where a late Evan Conway goal helped earn a 3-2 win against the defending champions in their home stadium. Coach Landon Donovan's team will now head into its toughest challenge yet this season when it hosts Western Conference leader San Antonio FC for the first time at Torero Stadium. San Antonio leads the entire USL Championship with 50 points as SD Loyal comes into the matchup as the second-place team in the Western Conference with 43 points, most in club history. SD Loyal comes into the match having won six of its last seven matches. After defeating the defending champions, Donovan's squad now faces the club that eliminated it from the playoffs last season.

"You don't have the ability to take days off in the West," Donovan said. "It's good for us. It makes us have to earn everything we get and right now, we're earning it."

San Antonio is coming off a 1-1 draw against LA Galaxy II last weekend. The first-place team is unbeaten in its last nine games with its last loss coming June 4 against Sacramento Republic FC.

#### ABOUT SD LOYAL

SD Loyal is in its third season after becoming an expansion and playing in its inaugural season in the USL Championship in 2020. It is coming off its first ever playoff appearance, a 2-0 loss against San Antonio FC in the first round. It was SD Loyal's first season playing more than 20 games with a revamped schedule that included 32 matches, mostly against teams in its geographical region. SD Loyal finished third in the Pacific Division with a 14-12-6 record and 48 points in a season that had several milestones.

It's first season in 2020 was a turbulent one for the club due the COVID-19 pandemic. It got to play its inaugural game in front of a sold-out home crowd then competition came to a halt in March. The league revamped the schedule and resumed play in July. SD Loyal went on to a 6-5-5 record under first-year coach Landon Donovan, finishing in fourth place in the Group B standings.

It finished the season with a forfeit in its regular season finale against Phoenix Rising FC after SD Loyal players walked off the pitch after a homophobic slur was used against one of its players before halftime. SD Loyal was in position to make a push for the playoffs before the forfeit. It was the second forfeit by SD Loyal in 2020. Donovan's team also forfeit a match against L.A. Galaxy II after a racial slur was used against one of its players.

Launched on June 19, 2019, San Diego Loyal is one of the newest members of USL Championship Western Conference. San Diego Loyal plays for America's Finest City and is led by some of the best in sport. The Club is led by Chairman Andrew Vassiliadis, who is the youngest principal owner in USL Championship. Team operations are led by President Ricardo Campos. The Executive Vice President of Soccer Operations Landon Donovan, one of the most decorated soccer players in the U.S., leads the technical side as both EVP and Team Manager. San Diego Loyal is built on four core pillars – Completion, Commitment, Connection, Camaraderie. San Diego Loyal holds training camps at the Chula Vista Elite Athlete Training Center.

Home matches are played at Torero Stadium located on the University of San Diego campus. It has hosted numerous important soccer events including the U.S. Women's National team and MLS clubs LA Galaxy, Chivas USA and Club Tijuana. It's also the temporary home to National Women's Soccer League's expansion team San Diego Wave FC.

#### WHAT TO WATCH FOR

- SD Loyal currently sits in second place in the USL Championship Western Conference, after 22 matches with a 13W-5L-4D record and 43 points, seven behind first place San Antonio FC.
- This is the second time SD Loyal faces San Antonio FC and first time hosting. The team played to a 2-0 loss on the road in SD Loyal's first-ever playoff appearance last season.
- SD Loyal has scored the most goals in the USL Championship this season (49), two more than Tampa Bay Rowdies.

The Spanish goalkeeper comes from Levante UD of La Liga. He is coming off a season at Mallorca of the Spanish second division where he appeared in one match after being sent there on loan. He has played for a handful of teams in that division but has had La Liga experience with Levante since 2017. Vegas became the SD Loyal starting goalkeeper at the start of the 2022 season. He quickly dispalyed his global experience, helping SD Loyal to its best start in franchise history. Prior to coming to San Diego, Vegas made his La Liga debut in May 2018, keeping a clean sheet in a 4-2 away loss against Celta de Vigo. 

Martin was also a consistent starter in the inaugural season for SD Loyal, working the left side of coach Landon Dono-van's three-man defensive backline. 

Fodrey was part of the USL Championship Academy players for SD Loyal in 2021 who eventually got a chance to practice and make his pro debut with the first team. He played in two matches, making his USL Championship debut on May 22, 2021 in a match against Louisville City FC. A local product who stood out during the 2021 preseason, Fodrey earned enough playing time that he even scored a goal in the team's second preparation match against MLS side LA Galaxy.

## LANDON DONOVAN

Regarded as one of the greatest U.S. soccer players in history, Landon Donovan brings his extensive knowledge of the game to San Diego Loyal's technical staff. During his 19-year professional career, Donovan's accomplishments span both his time domestically and internationally. In total, he played for five professional teams covering three leagues: Bayer 04 Leverkusen and Bayern Munich (Bundesliga); Everton (Premier League); San Jose Earthquakes and LA Galaxy (Major League Soccer). He played in six MLS Cups, the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup and earned two MLS Supporters' Shields. Individually, he was named to an MLS record 14-consecutive MLS All-Star games from 2001-2014, was honored with the Landon Donovan MVP Award in 2009 and won the Golden Boot in 2008, as well as being one of just two players to be named MLS Cup MVP twice. He still leads the MLS record books in assists (136), playoff goals (25) and co-leads MLS in playoff assists (14). He is second to Chris Wondolowski with most regularseason goals at 145. Donovan's contributions to the U.S. Men's National Team continues to dominate the record books. He leads the USMNT in goals (57), assists (58), second in appearances (157) and is the only American player to surpass both 50 goals and 50 assists in his career. He was the fastest American to earn 100 caps and played for the U.S. in three FIFA World Cups. His individual awards include the 1999 FIFA U-17 World Championship Golden Ball Award, FIFA's Best Young Player of the 2002 World Cup, the CONCACAF Gold Cup MVP in 2013, a Gold Cup Best XI selection four times and U.S. Soccer Athlete of the Year a record four times.

Miller is in his third season with SD Loyal as the associate head coach. Miller joined the team in 2020 after serving as head coach of the Spring Arbor University men's soccer program for six seasons, where his accomplishments included an overall record of 86-32-15, one league champi-onship title, two regular season titles and being named 2018 Crossroads League Coach of the Year. Miller was also the general manager and head coach of Lansing United – a former mem-ber of the Premier Development League (PDL) – and, in 2019, was the inaugural head coach of USL League One expansion side Lansing Ignite FC.
