O'Mara, forward last year, is the only regular member of the 1937 team returning. Edwards, Hoffman, Swindell and Bergman saw plenty of action as alternates last season. Thomas and Minor were reserves in 1937.

The team stresses the fast break, but there are more ball-handlers on the team than there are shooters. Swindell has been the leading scorer in early games, with Hendrickson, Edwards, O'Mara, and Thomas following. Bergman is fast, shifty and dangerous.
