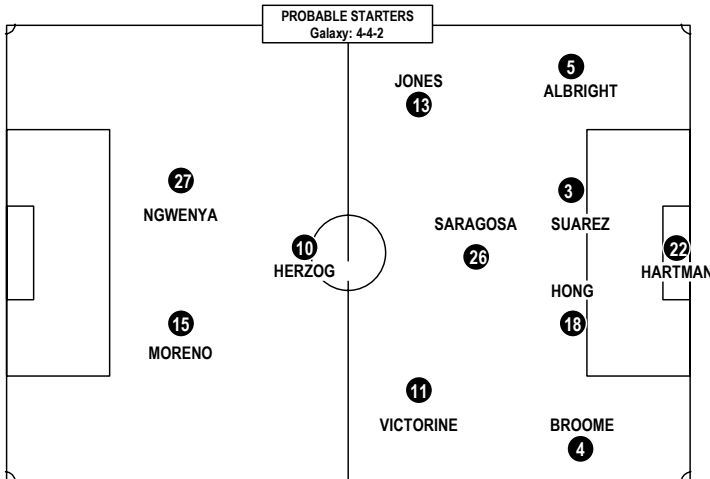

## **Sao Paulo Futebol Clube**

### **History**

Sao Paulo Futebol Clube is one of the most popular and well respected in South America. It was founded in the 1930's following the dissolution of several clubs from the city of the same name and took its present form in 1937.

Sao Paulo enjoyed one of the best periods in their history from 1990-1993, winning as many as 20 championships during that time. Their conquests during those four years included the Brazilian league and the 2002 and 2003 Copa Libertadores. They were also crowned world club champions in both 1992 and 1993, defeating Italian giants AC Milan in the 1993 final.

Additionally, the team has traditionally been recognized as a feeder of talent to the Brazil national team, producing players like Leonardo and Cafu that helped them win FIFA World Cup USA 1994 and Kaká, who played a big role in their victory at Korea/Japan 2002.

More recently, they finished in first place of Group One of the most recently completed Paulistsao (Sao Paulo regional) championship in league play and are competing in the semifinals of the 2004 edition of the Toyota Copa Libertadores, the championship for South American club teams (see details below).

### **2004 Toyota Copa Libertadores**

Sao Paulo are the lone Brazilian club to advance to the semifinals of the 2004 Toyota Copa Libertadores, where they will face Once Caldas of Colombia (who knocked off Brazilian club Santos) in a home-and-home series beginning on Wednesday, June 9. The other semifinal pits Argentine giants and arch-rivals River Plate and Boca Juniors.

Sao Paulo advanced to the semifinals after an aggregate victory over Deportivo Táchira of Venezuela in the round of eight. In addition, Sao Paulo's Luis Fabiano scored against Tachira and now leads all goal-scorers in the competition with six markers, aided greatly by former Bayer Leverkusen player Marquinhos, while goalkeeper Rogerio Ceni has been one of the best in the tournament.

Los Angeles Galaxy forward Jovan Kirovski scored a pair of goals as the most prolific attack in Major League Soccer registered a 4-1 victory against the Dallas Burn at The Home Depot Center. The Galaxy maintained their best overall record in the league, while the Burn fell to their fourth consecutive loss after starting the season with a four-game unbeaten streak. Despite missing the injured Carlos Ruiz, the league's leading scorer, for the third consecutive match, the Galaxy did not experience difficulty finding the back of the net. Sasha Victorine opened the scoring with a first-half header before an own goal doubled the lead. A Ronnie O'Brien goal halved the margin before Kirovski's fourth and fifth goals of the season put the result out of reach.

### **CLUB HOSTS HISTORIC DOUBLEHEADER AT THE HOME DEPOT CENTER SATURDAY, JUNE 5**

**FAREWELL MATCH FOR FORMER MIDFIELDER MAURICIO CIENFUEGOS AT 5 PM:** The Los Angeles Galaxy will be honoring former L.A. Galaxy and El Salvadoran international midfielder **Mauricio Cienfuegos** with a farewell match on Saturday at 5 pm. In what will be the largest reunion of current and former Galaxy players since the league's inception almost a decade ago, the Galaxy will celebrate the career of one of its "founding fathers" as part of an exciting doubleheader of soccer action. Cienfuegos' farewell match will kick off at 5:00 pm and will be played prior to the re-scheduled regular season match that evening between the Galaxy and the Kansas City Wizards (from July 31<sup>st</sup>) at 7:30pm (see details below).

Cienfuegos himself selected the teams and will play one half for each side. Among those expected to participate on the side representing the Galaxy and MLS are: goalkeeper/forward **Jorge Campos** and defenders **Dan Calichman**, **Paul Caligiuri**, and **Greg Vanney**. Midfielders **Ezra Hendrickson**, **Martin Machon**, **Danny Peña** and **Marvin Quijano** have also confirmed playing in the match, along with forwards **Raul Diaz Arce** and **Carlos Hermosillo**. Former Galaxy head coach **Lothar Osiander** will direct the MLS charges, while **Milovan Djoric**, former national team coach in El Salvador will lead the squad from Cienfuegos' homeland.

## **L.A. Galaxy vs. Sao Paulo FC – June 2, 2004 – 7:30 p.m. (PT)**

**GALAXY AND WIZARDS MEET IN IMPORTANT WESTERN CONFERENCE GAME AT 7:30 PM:** After hosting Sao Paulo FC in Wednesday's international friendly at The Home Depot Center, the Los Angeles Galaxy (**5-2-3, 18 pts - 1<sup>st</sup> West**) return to MLS action for a Western Conference match-up against the Kansas City Wizards (**3-3-2, 11 pts - 3<sup>rd</sup> West**) on Saturday, June 5 at 7:30 pm. Saturday's game will be the first between the clubs in the 2004 regular season, though the Galaxy defeated the Wizards 1-0 in a pre-season contest in Cary, North Carolina on March 27. The Galaxy leads the all-time regular-season series between the teams by a slim **16-13-3** margin. Though the game will not be available on television in Los Angeles, Galaxy fans can listen to it live on the radio in *English* on **KMPC 1540 AM** and in *Spanish* on **KMXE 830 AM**.

### **ALL THE STARS IN THIS GALAXY SHINING BRIGHTLY**

**KIROVSKI NAMED MLS PLAYER OF THE WEEK –** Los Angeles Galaxy forward **Jovan Kirovski**, who scored two goals in the club's 4-1 defeat of the Dallas Burn last Saturday at The Home Depot Center, has been voted Honda MLS Player of the Week for the week ending Sunday, May 30. It marks the second consecutive week that a Galaxy player received the award, with **Alejandro Moreno** picking up the hardware after a three-goal performance the week previous. Kirovski, 28, a U.S. national team player who returned stateside prior to the start of the 2004 season after 12 years in Europe's top leagues, now has amassed five goals and one assist for 11 points through 10 games with the Galaxy. Those numbers are good enough for third place on the team (trailing Moreno and Carlos Ruiz) and fourth in all of MLS. It is the second time Kirovski has captured the top weekly prize this season, both of them coming after two-goal outings against the Burn, the first for the week ending May 2.

**GALAXY TOP THE SCORING CHARTS –** The Galaxy not only sport the best overall record in MLS on third of the way through the season, but they also can boast about the most varied attack in the League. Entering this week's matches, the club had four players listed among the top ten in the Budweiser Scoring Leaders, including three of the top four. Forward **Carlos Ruiz** sits atop the table with six goals and two assists for 14 points, following closely by his replacement in the starting lineup, **Alejandro Moreno (5-2=12)**. Hot on the heels of Moreno are **Jovan Kirovski (5-1=11)** and midfielder **Andreas Herzog (2-4=8)**. The last time the club had four players among the top ten in MLS was the week of June 8, 1998 when Brazilian forward **Welton** led all of MLS in scoring with 33 points, followed closely by **Mauricio Cienfuegos** on **27**, while **Cobi Jones** was tied for fourth-best in MLS with **23** and **Martin Machon** tenth on the list with **17**.

**COBI PASSES CIEN IN GAMES PLAYED –** After surpassing former Galaxy teammate **Mauricio Cienfuegos** in career minutes played earlier this season, midfielder **Cobi Jones** played in his **206<sup>th</sup>** MLS Regular Season match last weekend vs. the Burn, establishing a club record. Entering the 2004 season, the Galaxy were one of only two clubs in the League to have at least two players on the exclusive 200-plus list.

**GALAXY-WIZARDS MATCHES UP MLS' BEST OFFENSE AND BEST DEFENSE –** When the Galaxy and the Wizards meet this Saturday at The Home Depot Center, Major League Soccer's best offense and best defense will collide. Through their first 10 matches, the Galaxy have scored a grand total of **22** goals, or **2.20** per game. Meanwhile, the Wizards have limited opponents to **five** goals in **seven** matches, just **0.63** per time they step out on to the field.

**LOS ANGELES GALAXY ALL-TIME CONCACAF CHAMPIONS CUP HISTORY**

The Los Angeles Galaxy have competed in three editions of the CONCACAF Champions Cup (1997, 2000, 2003), winning the regional championship for clubs once (2000) since the club's inception in 1996.

In 1997, the Galaxy reached the final before dropping a 5-3 decision to Mexican club Cruz Azul at RFK Stadium in Washington D.C on August 24 of that year. The club had reached the final four of the-then 16 team tournament by defeating Santos Laguna (Mexico) 4-1 in the first round and knocking off Luis Angel Firpo (El Salvador) 2-1 in the quarterfinal stage. Once in the semifinals, the Galaxy defeated MLS rival and nemesis D.C. United 1-0 in their own stadium to reach the winner take-all match to determine the champion.

The Galaxy made it to the summit of the 2000 edition of the tournament, defeating Olimpia of Honduras 3-2 in the final at Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum on January 21, 2001. After Danilo Tosello gave the Central Americans a 1-0 lead at the half hour, Ezra Hendrickson drew the Galaxy even in the 36<sup>th</sup> minute. The Galaxy took their first lead of the day on Cobi Jones strike in the 39<sup>th</sup> minute and carried it into the break. However, soon after halftime, the Honduran side tied it up, much to the chagrin of the Galaxy faithful in attendance. Their joy in drawing level would soon turn into sorrow as Hendrickson notched his second marker of the contest in the 78<sup>th</sup> minute to send the Galaxy to their first their honors on the continental stage. The climb to the championship was not an easy one for the club. Playing in a now-eight team field for this tournament, the Galaxy defeated Real España in the quarterfinals on January 17, surviving a scoreless draw in regulation before winning 5-3 on penalties. Their semifinal victory just two days later was also decided on penalties, 4-2 over D.C. United after the squads had traded successful penalty kicks during regular time.

The last time the Los Angeles Galaxy qualified for the CONCACAF Champions Cup was 2003. Again playing as part of a 16-team field, the Galaxy won their first round series against CD Motagua of Honduras 3-2, thanks to 1-0 home victory in the second leg on a dramatic Alexi Lalas goal after a 2-2 deadlock in Tegucigalpa. The Galaxy did not fair so well in the next round, suffering a 6-2 aggregate defeat to CD Necaxa of Mexico after dropping the crucial first leg at home by a 4-1 margin.

Having led the Los Angeles Galaxy to the title of every major club championship contested in the United States, Head Coach Sigi Schmid returns to lead the Los Angeles Galaxy into the 2004 MLS season. In five MLS seasons, Schmid has guided the L.A. Galaxy to three titles, winning the 2002 MLS Cup Championship, 2001 U.S. Open Cup Championship and the 2000 CONCACAF Champions' Cup, for the treble of titles in the region.

The 2003 season was an historic one for the Galaxy, highlighted by a move from the Rose Bowl in Pasadena, California to a 27,000 seat soccer-specific stadium at The Home Depot Center in Carson, Calif. In their new home, the Galaxy have attracted crowds averaging more than 21,000 fans, best in MLS during the 2003 campaign and good enough for second-best in team history, eclipsed only by a mean of 28,916 during their inaugural season in 1996.

Schmid guided the Galaxy through an up and down season in 2003. Due to the construction of its new stadium, the team was forced to play their first eight games away from home, going 0-4-4 in that span. However, the Galaxy recovered to post a 9-8-5 mark in the last five months of the season, including a 9-3-3 mark in the friendly confines of The Home Depot Center, the second-best home record in the league. Additionally, the club became the only team in MLS history to qualify for the playoffs in each of the league's first eight seasons. Additionally, the team qualified for the semifinal stage of the U.S. Open Cup for a third consecutive time.
