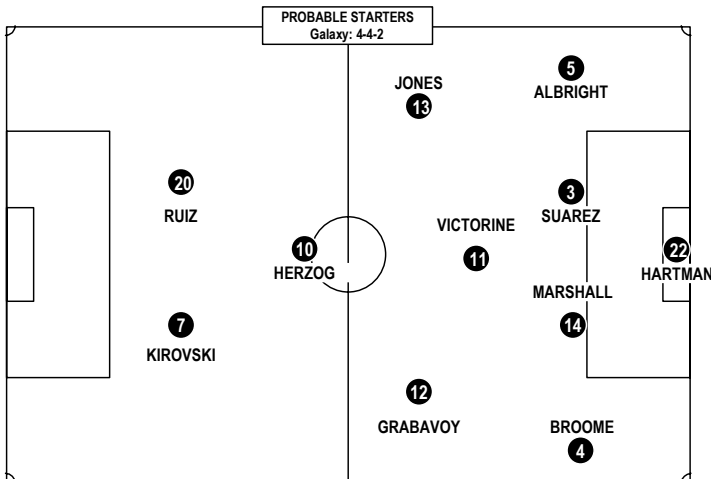

LAST MEETING VS. UNITED

Los Angeles Galaxy 4, D.C. United 2

Wednesday, May 19, 2004

RFK Stadium – Washington, D.C.

A hat trick within eight minutes in the first half by Alejandro Moreno gave the Los Angeles Galaxy a wild 4-2 victory against D.C. United at RFK Stadium. Moreno's hat trick -- all three goals set up by Andreas Herzog -- was the second-fastest in MLS history, and was immediately followed by a fourth Galaxy goal and United's first before halftime. But Adu also gave the RFK faithful a glimpse of his supreme talents with a superb strike of his own in the losing effort as United tried desperately to pull back into the game in the second half. Moreno answered any questions about how the Galaxy offense would handle the absence of injured star and MLS-leading scorer Carlos Ruiz, out with a severely sprained ankle. The eight-minute span marked the second-fastest hat trick in MLS history, only to another Galaxy performance, when Harut Karapetyan scored three goals in five minutes in a Los Angeles 8-1 victory at Dallas on June 4, 1998. In addition, for Moreno, it was five goals on five consecutive shots (including his first two goals this season), the first player in MLS history to achieve that feat. A shellshocked United squad continued to struggle and rookie striker Joseph Ngwenya took advantage moments later, scoring his first goal of the season. Former United player Chris Albright whipped in a good cross from the right touchline which Moreno headed back across the face of the goal where Ngwenya dived to make it 4-0 for the visitors. The four goals in nine minutes was the quickest ever allowed by United.

In their fourth and final meeting of the season - and second within five days - the Los Angeles Galaxy and Colorado Rapids played to a scoreless draw in a midweek meeting at Invesco Field at Mile High in Denver. The Galaxy extended their unbeaten streak to four games though their winning run ended at three. Still, Los Angeles came away with a win and a draw in the series between the two clubs, a series Rapids coach Tim Hankinson could go far in defining the Western Conference race over the second half of the MLS season. Both goalkeepers, Joe Cannon for the Rapids and Kevin Hartman for Los Angeles, made vital saves in keeping the other side off the board. Galaxy striker Carlos Ruiz was very dangerous in the first half, and came close on a number of occasions to adding to his league-leading goals total. On the first - in the third minute - Andreas Herzog played one of his patented long balls from midfield right into the striker's path, but Ruiz's shot from just inside the box sailed over the bar. Ruiz put his 23rd minute attempt on net after being set up from his fellow front-runner Jovan Kirovski. A perfectly-placed diagonal ball through the Rapids back line put Ruiz in alone against Rapids goalkeeper Joe Cannon and he smartly attempted to lift the ball over the sliding Cannon, but the 'keeper got his hands up to keep the game tied. Ned Grabavoy - who scored his first professional goal Saturday in the Galaxy's 2-0 win against Colorado - made a blistering run up the right flank before dumping the ball off in the box to Ruiz, but the Guatemalan international didn't get much power on the shot and Cannon had time to dive to his right and make the save. After the break, it was the turn of Galaxy 'keeper Hartman to lift his team. Ten minutes after the intermission speedy winger Chris Henderson got forward for the Rapids and controlled a long ball over the top, but Hartman was quick off his line to smother the chance. Rapids midfielder Mark Chung nearly provided the winner at the 74 minute mark. Henderson created space for himself on the left flank with a series of cutbacks before crossing the ball into the heart of the box. Chung flew through the air to connect on a diving header, but it was parried away by Hartman in a remarkable stop. The hosts had one final chance to grab three points deep in injury time and they came within inches of doing it. Defender Pablo Mastroeni floated in a cross and Nat Borchers challenged to get on the end of it, while Hartman came off his line. Hartman tried to punch the ball away but didn't make contact and the ball caromed off the left post, but was scrambled away to safety.

The Western-Conference leading **Los Angeles Galaxy (9-5-4, 31 pts. - 1st West)** play the second game in a month-long road trip Saturday at RFK Stadium at 4:30 pm (PT) when they take on **D.C. The Galaxy are not scheduled return to the friendly confines of The Home Depot Center for a game until **Saturday, August 14** at 7 pm against the Columbus Crew. The first 10,000 fans in attendance that evening will receive Galaxy jersey key rings, courtesy of Proctor & Gamble. A LOOK AT THE GALAXY ENTERING D.C. UNITED MATCH

THREE GALAXY PLAYERS TO START IN 2004 SIERRA MIST MLS ALL-STAR GAME: Three members of the MLS Western-Conference leading Los Angeles Galaxy will be in the starting lineup for the 2004 Sierra Mist MLS All-Star Game, it was announced last week by Major League Soccer. The League's ninth annual mid-summer showcase will be played on Saturday, July 31 at RFK Stadium in Washington, D.C at 11 am (PT) and will be televised live on ABC Sports. Defender **Chris Albright**, midfielder **Andreas Herzog** and forward **Carlos Ruiz** will all start for the Western Conference team, which is being guided by Galaxy Head Coach **Sigi Schmid** and his assistants **Martin Vasquez** and **Zak Abdel**.

THREE MORE SLATED AS RESERVES FOR MID-SUMMER SHOWCASE: In addition to the three Galaxy players who will be starters for the Western Conference All-Star squad, MLS has also announced that an additional three members of the Galaxy were named among the reserves at the League's Mid-summer Showcase. Goalkeeper **Kevin Hartman** and forward **Jovan Kirovski** were selected and will play for Galaxy Head Coach Sigi Schmid in the game; but defender **Danny Califf** - who is injured - was selected but will not be able to take part in the festivities.

HARTMAN'S TWO SHUTOUTS AGAINST RAPIDS EQUALS RECORD: The Los Angeles Galaxy and Goalkeeper Kevin Hartman held the Colorado Rapids' to consecutive clean sheets on July 10 (a 2-0 victory at The Home Depot Center) and July 14 (0-0 tie at INVESCO Field) to tie an MLS record. The feat marked only the second time in MLS history that a team posted two shutouts against the same opponent within five days. In a twist of fate, former Galaxy goalkeeper David Kramer and the San Jose Earthquakes were the first to do it, blanking the Galaxy on Sept. 16-20, 1998.

RUIZ LOOKS TO EXTEND LEAGUE LEAD: Galaxy forward **Carlos Ruiz**, who scored one of the club's goals in a 2-0 victory over Colorado on Saturday, will look to extend his lead at the top of the MLS scoring charts. With nine goals and two assists for 20 points in just 12 games played in 2004 (an average of 1.82 points per game, also a league best), Ruiz stands alone at the summit.

ROOKIE CHRIS ALOISI TO MISS SATURDAY'S GAME VS. UNITED: L.A. Galaxy defender Chris Aloisi will miss the club's next match Saturday against D.C. United while serving a one-game suspension. A former Syracuse Orangeman, Aloisi earned 11 caution points in last three games. The 5-10, 160-pound defender has earned three starts in four appearances

BROOME ONE GAME AWAY FROM REPRIEVE: Galaxy defender/midfielder **Paul Broome** is one game away from receiving a five point reduction in his total caution points, if he can keep his nose clean of cautions through the next game against United. However, if Broome draws a yellow card the next two match, he will again find himself on the outside looking in for the club's subsequent match.

SIGI SCHMID **L.A. GALAXY** **6th SEASON** **2004 RECORD: 8-5-3**

Having led the Los Angeles Galaxy to the title of every major club championship contested in the United States, Head Coach Sigi Schmid returns to lead the Los Angeles Galaxy into the 2004 MLS season. In five MLS seasons, Schmid has guided the L.A. Galaxy to three titles, winning the 2002 MLS Cup Championship, 2001 U.S. Open Cup Championship and the 2000 CONCACAF Champions' Cup, for the treble of titles in the region.

The 2003 season was an historic one for the Galaxy, highlighted by a move from the Rose Bowl in Pasadena, California to a 27,000 seat soccer-specific stadium at The Home Depot Center in Carson, Calif. In their new home, the Galaxy attracted crowds averaging more than 21,000 fans, best in MLS during the 2003 campaign and good enough for second-best in team history, eclipsed only by a mean of 28,916 during their inaugural season in 1996.

Schmid guided the Galaxy through an up and down season in 2003. Due to the construction of its new stadium, the team was forced to play their first eight games away from home, going 0-4-4 in that span. However, the Galaxy recovered to post a 9-8-5 mark in the last five months of the season, including a 9-3-3 mark in the friendly confines of The Home Depot Center, the second-best home record in the league. Additionally, the club became the only team in MLS history to qualify for the playoffs in each of the league's first eight seasons. Additionally, the team qualified for the semifinal stage of the U.S. Open Cup for a third consecutive time.
