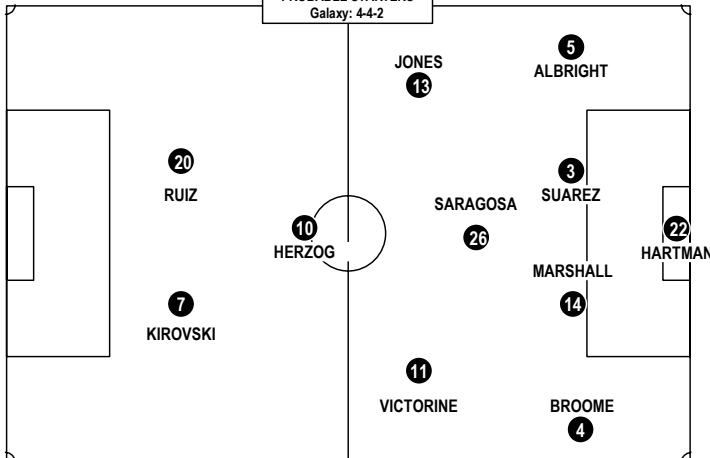

#### LAST MEETING VS. METROSTARS

**MetroStars 3, Los Angeles Galaxy 0**

**Wednesday, June 23, 2004**

**The Home Depot Center – Carson, CA**

The MetroStars hit for a three-goal blitz in the first half and knocked off the Los Angeles Galaxy for the second time in four days with a 3-0 win at The Home Depot Center. Amado Guevara notched the first goal of the night before turning provider on a pair of beautiful goals from 17-year-old Eddie Gaven to give the Metros sole ownership of the top spot in the Eastern Conference table. Guevara had a hand in all three goals in his first match back with the Metros after missing the previous two while representing Honduras in World Cup qualifying. It was the first time this season the Galaxy were shut out, and the 3-0 loss was their heaviest-ever league defeat at The Home Depot Center. The visitors got their first goal from a blistering 25-yard strike by Guevara in the 16th minute. A fine buildup saw Ricardo Clark play the final pass to Guevara from the right flank and the Honduran took care of the rest, taking a few touches towards the Galaxy net before unleashing an unstoppable drive just inside the right post. Gaven then sealed the deal before the end of the opening stanza with two splendid finishes. On the first, Guevara made a slicing run in from the left flank before laying the ball off to Gaven inside the penalty area, who cutpast Marcelo Saragosa to free some space and slot home past Hartman from close range. The second-year attacker then bettered his first with a wonderful curling effort from the top of the box that Hartman could do nothing about. Guevara found Gaven on the right side of the box this time, before the youngster skipped through traffic and sent a splendid shot around Hartman's dive and inside his right-hand post, for his second goal of the night and the season.

In the matchup of the two top teams in Major League Soccer, the Los Angeles Galaxy scored a goal five minutes deep into second-half stoppage time and snatched a 2-2 draw on the road against the Kansas City Wizards at Arrowhead Stadium. The Wizards had taken the lead with goals two minutes apart in the second half from Davy Arnaud and Jack Jewsbury, but the Galaxy began their fight back with a quick response through Sasha Victorine. Then almost as the five minutes of added time had run out, Tyrone Marshall rose up to head home an Andreas Herzog cross and keep the Galaxy in first place in the Western Conference, a point ahead of the Wizards. The Wizards hit for their first goal just before the hour as Davy Arnaud hit for his eighth of the campaign. Just two minutes later the Wizards doubled their lead through a long-range effort from Jack Jewsbury. But the Galaxy immediately responded. In the 67th minute, Cobi Jones sent a rolling cross from the right flank and Carlos Ruiz sold a perfect dummy, letting the ball run on to Victorine racing unmarked up the center of the area, and he side-footed home with ease to halve the lead. Referee Hector Tobon indicated five minutes of added time after a scuffle late in the half. Taking advantage of the added time, Andreas Herzog swung in a rebound from the left for one last try, and Marshall sent a glancing header inside the far post for the equalizer and a share of the spoils.

### **GALAXY ATTEMPT TO OUT-SHINE METROSTARS TONIGHT**

**MARSHALL'S GOAL VS KANSAS CITY HIS FIRST SINCE 2001:** Galaxy defender **Tyrone Marshall's** late equalizer in the club's 2-2 tie against the Kansas City Wizards on July 24 was his first since July 18, 2001, when Marshall was still a member of the Miami Fusion. In his career, which dates back to 1999, Marshall has now recorded 10 goals and 14 assists for 34 total points.

**RUIZ AND GUEVARA CONTINUE TO BATTLE FOR THE MLS SCORING LEAD:** As Major League Soccer returns from the All-Star break this week, there are three players battling for the top spot in the Budweiser Scoring Race. Two of them are playing in today's game – the Galaxy's **Carlos Ruiz** and the MetroStars **Amado Guevara**. Guevara currently sits atop the table with nine goals and seven assists for a total of 25 points, just two points ahead of the San Jose Earthquakes' Brian Ching (10g+3a = 23 pts). Hot on both their heels is Guatemalan International Ruiz – with 10 goals and two assists for 22 points. Additionally, Ruiz, who led the League in goals scored in both 2002 and 2003, leads MLS with **1.57** points per game, trailed by Guevara with 1.47 and Ching with 1.44.

**CLUB'S DEPTH ALLOWS SCHMID TO FIND DIFFERENT LINEUP COMBINATIONS:** A very busy schedule thus far in 2004 has allowed Galaxy Head Coach **Sigi Schmid** to use a bevy of different combinations on the field for the club this season. Proud to boast the team with best record in MLS and its arguably its deepest roster, Schmid has used 23 of his 24 players in League play – and used 17 different lineup combinations in the Galaxy's first 20 games.

**FWD ALEJANDRO MORENO OBTAINS GREEN CARD:** L.A. Galaxy forward **Alejandro Moreno** has obtained his green card from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, the club announced on Wednesday. With the acquisition of his permanent resident status, Moreno will no longer count as a Senior International player on the Galaxy's roster. MLS rules presently allow a maximum of three Senior International players per team. With the change in Moreno's status, the Galaxy will have one SI opening on their roster. The club's two other Senior International spots are presently filled by Guatemalan forward **Carlos Ruiz** and Austrian midfielder **Andreas Herzog**. Moreno has been with the Galaxy since the club selected him in the third round of the 2002 MLS SuperDraft (27<sup>th</sup> overall). The graduate of UNC-Greensboro has played in 54 regular season games in his three-year career - 25 of them starts. He has scored 12 goals and contributed six assists for a total of 30 points. Thus far in 2004, the native of Barquisimeto, Venezuela, has appeared in 18 games - eight of them starts and has scored six goals and added two assists for 14 points, all of which tie career-highs for the third-year striker, equaling marks he set in 2003. He recorded a hat trick in a match May 19 at D.C. United - and scored goals on his first five shots of the season, establishing an MLS record. The 25-year-old forward, a member of the Galaxy's MLS Cup Championship team in 2002, has made two appearances for the Venezuela national team, both of them coming in international friendlies. Additionally, he was on the bench as Venezuela shocked hosts Uruguay in Montevideo 3-0 this past March 31 in a qualifier to the 2006 FIFA World Cup Germany.

**GALAXY PLAYERS TAKE PART IN ALL-STAR GAME:** Los Angeles Galaxy players Chris Albright, Andreas Herzog, Jovan Kirovski, Carlos Ruiz and Kevin Hartman all saw extensive action for the Western Conference squad coached by Sigi Schmid at RFK Stadium during the 2004 Sierra Mist All-Star Game. However, despite their best efforts, it was the East, powered by Amado Guevara's two first half goals, that beat them and their Western Conference teammates by a 3-2 margin.

**CELEBRATION GAME HAS DISTINCTIVE GALAXY FEEL:** Former L.A. Galaxy 'keeper Jorge Campos stole the show at the MLS Celebration Game, making several saves and assisting on the game-tying goal as the MLS World Legends battled from two goals down to force a 2-2 draw with the MLS USA Legends. After the USA took a two-goal lead into the half, the World Legends came back into the game with two late goals from Raul Diaz Arce and Mauricio Cienfuegos to cap the match. In all, six former Galaxy players took part: Campos, Cienfuegos, Carlos Hermosillo and Luis Hernandez all played for the World Legends while Paul Caligiuri and Alexi Lalas played for USA - alongside current midfielder Cobi Jones and Galaxy Assistant Coach Martin Vasquez.



**MLS CUP 2004 AWARDED TO THE HOME DEPOT CENTER:** Major League Soccer Commissioner Don Garber announced today that the 2004 edition of the League's premier event, MLS Cup, returns to The Home Depot Center in Carson, Calif., for the second consecutive season. Home of the Los Angeles Galaxy, The Home Depot Center will host the League's ninth championship game, MLS Cup 2004, on Sunday, November 14, 2004 at 12:30 p.m. PT. The championship match will be broadcast live on ABC Sports. MLS Cup 2004 marks the third time that Major League Soccer's champion will be crowned in Southern California, as the Chicago Fire captured the Cup at the conclusion of their inaugural 1998 season and the San Jose Earthquakes captured their second Cup in three seasons with a thrilling 4-2 victory over the Fire at The Home Depot Center last year.
