The Ports scored six unanswered runs and their bullpen allowed just one hit over three shutout innings as Stockton defeated the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes 7-4 in the series finale at LoanMart Field on Sunday. **Max Muncy** and **Nick Brueser** each hit home runs for Stockton as part of an eight-hit attack. **Blake Beers** struck out eight over six innings in picking up his second win of the season. The Ports split their six-game series in Rancho Cucamonga.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Sam Carlson** will make his first start of the season in the series opener against the Ports at Banner Island Ballpark on Tuesday night...Made his first appearance of the season on Wednesday against the 66ers, allowing one run on two hits over 2.0 innings of relief... Walked one, hit a batter and struck out one...Went 6-4 with a 4.77 ERA in 19 starts last season... Opponents batted .268...Made five starts against the Ports in 2021, going 2-2 allowing 17 runs (11 earned) over 24.2 IP (4.02 ERA)...Underwent Tommy John surgery in 2017 and went through a 32 month recovery...Was finally ready to pitch in Minor League camp in 2020, but the season was canceled because of the COVID-19 pandemic...Selected by the Mariners in the 2nd round (55th overall) out of Burnsville HS in Burnsville, MN...Clocked as high as 97 mph in high school...23 years old.

PORTS AND NUTS CLASH FOR SECOND TIME IN 2022: After splitting their series in Rancho Cucamonga, the Ports return to Banner Island Ballpark for a six game set with the Modesto Nuts (Low-A, Seattle Mariners). The Ports' only series win came at the expense of the Nuts, as Stockton took four of six at Banner Island Ballpark in the second series of the season, from April 12-17.



WHO'S HOT

- **CJ RODRIGUEZ, C** During the Ports' series in Rancho Cucammonga, the Ports' backstop went 8-for-16 with a double and an RBI. Rodriguez also walked six times, giving him an OBP of .609 for the week.
- **KEVIN RICHARDS, OF** Richards leads the Ports in hitting during the month of May, compiling a batting average of .390 while also leading the club with three home runs during that span.

COLE IRVIN MAKES REHAB START: Left-hander **Cole Irvin** will make a rehab start on Tuesday against the Ports at Banner Island Ballpark in the opener of a six-game series with the Modesto Nuts. **Irvin** (shoulder tightness) landed on the Injured List on May 2 and is 2-1 with a 2.93 ERA in five starts with the Athletics this season. He is the third Oakland A to make a rehab start for the Ports this season, following James Kaprielian (April 15 v MOD) and Lou Trivino (May 1 v FRE).

Irvin was selected by the Phillies in the 5th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of the University of Oregon. The left-hander made his MLB Debut in 2019 with Philadelphia, going 2-1 with a 5.83 ERA in 16 appearances (3 starts). He was purchased by the A's on January 30, 2021 and went 10-15 with a 4.24 ERA last season.

WORKHORSE STARTERS: Through the first 33 games of the California League season, the Ports' starting rotation is tied with the Fresno Grizzlies for first in the league in innings pitched, logging 160 thusfar. The lead for the Ports and Grizzlies is by a wide margin: the Inland Empire 66ers are next up at 143/1 IP, 16.2 innings behind Stockton and Fresno.

EXPERIMENTAL RULES RETURNING TO CAL LEAGUE: Major League Baseball announced in March that experimental rules will expand in the California League for the 2022 season. The following rules will take effect:

- Pitch clock and pickoff limits remain: Pitchers must deliver within 14 seconds with the bases empty and 18 seconds with runners on base. HItters must be in the batter's box and attentive to the pitcher with 9 seconds left. Pitchers will also be limited to two pickoff attempts or step-offs per plate appearance; any more without retiring the baserunner will effectively function as a balk
- Larger Bases: The size of first, second and third base will increase from 15 to 18 inches, a rule in place at Triple-A during the 2021 season. The increase is aimed to provide more room for players to operate around the bases, while modestly shrinking the distance between bases themselves. Additionally, the larger bases will be composed of material that is expected to perform better in wet conditions.
- **Defensive Position Restrictions**: Teams must have a minimum of four defensive players on the infield when their pitcher delivers, with at least two infielders on either side of second base. The penalty for violation is an automatic ball, but if the hitter swings and gets a better outcome, the offensive team can take that. Goal is to increase batting average on balls in play.

Franklin Font was named manager of the Stockton Ports on March 21, 2022. He was originally named the Ports' Assistant Hitting Coach but assumed Managerial duties when Anthony Phillips was reassinged to the Arizona Complex League.

Font returns to professional baseball in the United States from France where he served as manager of the Aigles de France of the ESBL (European Super League of Professional Baseball) in 2021.

He joins the A's organization after spending 20 seasons in various coaching roles with the Chicago Cubs organization, including a minor league manager in 2002, 2005-06 and 2008. From 2012-20, he served as a Major League staff assistant following a one-year stint as assistant hitting coach with the Major League team.

Font was signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Cubs in 1995 and played in six minor league seasons with the club.

Born in Caracas, Venezuela, Font resides in Mesa, AZ with his wife, Maria. He has three children, Veronica, Benjamin and Balentine, and one grandson, Franklin Jr.



#20 BRYAN COREY, PITCHING COACH

Bryan Corey returns to Stockton for his second stint as pitching coach of the Ports, a role he previously held in 2018. He served as assistant pitching rehab coordinator last season and was pitching coach for the AZL A's the previous two seasons. He also spent two seasons as pitching coach at Short-Season Vermont. Originally drafted as a SS by Detroit in the 12th round of the 1993 draft, Corey was converted to a pitcher after two pro seasons. He spent five years in the Majors and also pitched in Japan, Korea and Taiwan before retiring after the 2012 season. A native of Thousand Oaks, CA, Corey resides in Phoenix, AZ and has two daughters, Brooke and Blair.



#40 KEVIN KOUZMANOFF, *HITTING COACH*

Kevin Kouzmanoff enters his fourth season as a professional hitting coach and first with the Ports after working with Double-A Midland in 2021 and making his coaching debut with the AZL A's in 2019. He joined the A's organization after spending the 2018 season as an assistant coach with Metropolitan State University in Denver. Kouzmanoff spent seven season in the Major Leagues, registering a .257 career batting average with 87 HR with Cleveland, San Diego, Oakland, Colorado and Texas. He makes his native Denver his offseason home.



#6 COOPER GOLDBY ASST. HITTING COACH

Cooer Goldby makes his coaching debut in Stockton after voluntarily retiring as a member of the A's organization in November of 2021. The Yuba City native was drafted by the A's in the 35th round of the 2017 Draft out of Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, ID. Goldby played three seasons accross five levels from 2017-19 as a utility man playing catcher, first base, and the outfield.



ERIC FASTH HEAD ATHLETIC TRAINER

Eric Fasth enters his second season with the A's and his first with the Ports. He previously served as assistant athletic trainer with Triple-A Las Vegas. Prior to joining the A's, Fasth worked with the women's ice hockey and rowing teams at College of the Holy Cross from 2019-21 following stinks with the Red Sox and Diamondbacks organizations. The Boise, ID native graduated with a bachelor's degree from Linfield College (OR) and a master's degree from California University of PA. He currently resides in Henderson, NV.



Steven Thayer enters his first season with the A's organization after spedning last season with the Giants as a sports performance coach in the Dominican Summer League. Prior to his time in professional baseball, Thayer was a strength coach at Mater Dei High School, an assistant strength coach for the Michigan State basketball and volleyball teams and as an intern with Cal football. A native of San Ramon, CA, Thayer graudated from Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo and has a master's degree in kinesiology from Michigan State.

LAST OUTING: Sanchez fired a career-high 4.2 innings in his second start of the season a week ago against the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes at LoanMart Field in Southern California. Coming on in relief of starter Luke Anderson with one out in the fourth inning, Sanchez held Modesto hitless over 2.2 innings of relief with three strikeouts. Trailing 6-1 after four innings, the Ports scored five runs in teh fifth and three in the sixth to pick up their first win of the season, 11-6.
