PORTS RIDE CLUTCH HITTING, STRONG PITCHING TO THIRD STRAIGHT:

The Ports scored all four of their runs with two outs and got quality outings from three different pitchers in running their winning streak to three with a 4-3 victory over the Modesto Nuts in the series opener on Tuesday night. **Cole Irvin** allowed just one run over five innings in an MLB rehab start and **Yehizon Sanchez** and **Hunter Breault** followed to shut the door on Modesto with four innings of relief.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Joseph Hernandez** will make his sixth

start (seventh appearance) of the 2022 season...Has allowed just 22 hits (.216 BAA) in 29.1 IP while striking out 36 and walking 12...Last pitched on Thursday, May 12 allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits in 4.1 IP with seven strikeouts and three walks...Made his first start of the seaason against the Ports at Banner Island Ballpark on April 13, allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 IP (Nuts 10-3)... Spent 2021 in the ACL going 4-0 with a 4.35 ERA in 10 appearances (4 starts)...Allowed 25 hits and struck out 49 over 31 IP...Made one appearance with the AA Arkansas Travelers last season, allowing six runs in four innings...Spent 2018 & 19 in the DSL after signing...Signed by the Mariners as an International Free Agent on July 2, 2017...21 years old

PORTS AND NUTS CLASH FOR SECOND TIME IN 2022: After splitting their series in Rancho Cucamonga, the Ports return to Banner Island Ballpark for a six game set with the Modesto Nuts (Low-A, Seattle Mariners). WORKHORSE STARTERS: Through the first 34 games of the California League season, the Ports' starting rotation leads the circuit in innings pitched, logging 165 thusfar. The Fresno Grizzlies' starting unit has compiled the second-most innings thusfar, registering 162 through their 34 games. The Ports and Grizzlies have a healthy margin on the rest of the field, as the Inland Empire 66ers' rotation comes in third having logged 148 innings so far.

EXPERIMENTAL RULES RETURNING TO CAL LEAGUE: Major League Baseball announced in March that experimental rules will expand in the California League for the 2022 season. The following rules will take effect:

- Pitch clock and pickoff limits remain: Pitchers must deliver
 within 14 seconds with the bases empty and 18 seconds with
 runners on base. HItters must be in the batter's box and attentive to the pitcher with 9 seconds left. Pitchers will also be
 limited to two pickoff attempts or step-offs per plate appearance; any more without retiring the baserunner will effectively
 function as a balk
- Larger Bases: The size of first, second and third base will
 increase from 15 to 18 inches, a rule in place at Triple-A during
 the 2021 season. The increase is aimed to provide more
 room for players to operate around the bases, while modestly
 shrinking the distance between bases themselves. Additionally, the larger bases will be composed of material that is
 expected to perform better in wet conditions.
- Defensive Position Restrictions: Teams must have a minimum of four defensive players on the infield when their pitcher delivers, with at least two infielders on either side of second base. The penalty for violation is an automatic ball, but if the hitter swings and gets a better outcome, the offensive team can take that. Goal is to increase batting average on balls in play.

Franlklin Font was named manager of the Stockton Ports on March 21, 2022. He was originally named the Ports' Assistant Hitting Coach but assumed Managerial duties when Anthony Phillips was reassinged to the Arizona Complex League.

Font returns to professional baseball in the United States from France where he served as manager of the Aigles de France of the ESBL (European Super League of Professional Baseball) in 2021.

He joins the A's organization after spending 20 seasons in various coaching roles with the Chicago Cubs organization, including a minor league manager in 2002, 2005-06 and 2008. From 2012-20, he served as a Major League staff assistant following a one-year stint as assistant hitting coach with the Major League team.

Font was signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Cubs in 1995 and played in six minor league seasons with the club.

Born in Caracas, Venezuela, Font resides in Mesa, AZ with his wife, Maria. He has three children, Veronica, Benjamin and Balentine, and one grandson, Franklin Jr.



#20 BRYAN COREY,PITCHING COACH

Bryan Corey returns to Stockton for his second stint as pitching coach of the Ports, a role he previously held in 2018. He served as assistant pitching rehab coordinator last season and was pitching coach for the AZL A's the previous two seasons. He also spent two seasons as pitching coach at Short-Season Vermont. Originally drafted as a SS by Detroit in the 12th round of the 1993 draft, Corey was converted to a pitcher after two pro seasons. He spent five years in the Majors and also pitched in Japan, Korea and Taiwan before retiring after the 2012 season. A native of Thousand Oaks, CA, Corey resides in Phoenix, AZ and has two daughters, Brooke and Blair.



#40 KEVIN KOUZMANOFF,HITTING COACH

Kevin Kouzmanoff enters his fourth season as a professional hitting coach and first with the Ports after working with Double-A Midland in 2021 and making his coaching debut with the AZL A's in 2019. He joined the A's organization after spending the 2018 season as an assistant coach with Metropolitan State University in Denver. Kouzmanoff spent seven season in the Major Leagues, registering a .257 career batting average with 87 HR with Cleveland, San Diego, Oakland, Colorado and Texas. LAST OUTING: Zhuang did not factor in the decision in his last start, allowing five runs on eight hits in 5.0 IP against the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes at LoanMart Field in Southern California. The right-hander struck out a season-low two batters and tied a season high with 84 pitches thrown.


