PORTS CLUB THREE HOMERS, WIN FOURTH STRAIGHT: Max Muncy, Cooper Uhl and Denzel Clarke all hit home runs as the Ports won their fourth straight game with a 9-7 victory over the Modesto Nuts on Wednesday night. **Muncy** hit a three-run home run in the first inning and added two-run double in the seventh, while **Uhl** and **Clarke** each chipped in with solo shots. **Skylar Syznski** picked up his first win as a Port with 1.1 innings of scoreless relief.

OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Michael Morales** will make his second start of the season for the Nuts...Has allowed 29 runs (20 earned) on 39 hits in 33.1 IP over seven starts...Has registered 35 strikeouts and 13 walks...0-2 with a 7.11 ERA in three starts in the month of May after going 2-1 with a 4.35 in April...Last pitched on Friday, May 20 against Inland Empire, taking the loss while allowing three runs on five hits in five innings with four walks and seven strikeouts... Allowed five runs on four hits in 4.1 IP against the Ports on April 14 at Banner Island Ballpark (STK 11-6)...Made one appearance in the ACL last season, allowing two runs on two hits in one inning...Selected by the Mariners in the 3rd round of the 2021 draft out of East Pennsboro High School in Enola, FL...Received a \$1.5 million signing bonus...Was committed to play college baseball at Vanderbilt...21 years old

PORTS AND NUTS CLASH FOR SECOND TIME IN 2022: After splitting their series in Rancho Cucamonga, the Ports return to Banner Island Ballpark for a six game set with the Modesto Nuts (Low-A, Seattle Mariners). The Ports' only series win came at the expense of the Nuts, as Stockton took four of six at Banner Island Ballpark in the second series of the season, from April 12-17.

WORKHORSE STARTERS: Through the first 35 games of the California League season, the Ports' starting rotation leads the circuit in innings pitched, logging 169.2 thusfar. The Fresno Grizzlies' starting unit has compiled the second-most innings, registering 168 through their 35 games. The Ports and Grizzlies have a healthy margin on the rest of the field, as the Inland Empire 66ers' rotation comes in third having logged 149.2 innings so far.

PORTS ON CAL LEAGUE LEADERBOARD: Through the first handful of weeks in the California League season, several Ports rank among the league leaders in a number of different statistical categories:

EXPERIMENTAL RULES RETURNING TO CAL LEAGUE: Major League Baseball announced in March that experimental rules will expand in the California League for the 2022 season. The following rules will take effect:

- **Pitch clock and pickoff limits remain:** Pitchers must deliver within 14 seconds with the bases empty and 18 seconds with runners on base. Hitters must be in the batter's box and attentive to the pitcher with 9 seconds left. Pitchers will also be limited to two pickoff attempts or step-offs per plate appearance; any more without retiring the baserunner will effectively function as a balk
- **Larger Bases:** The size of first, second and third base will increase from 15 to 18 inches, a rule in place at Triple-A during the 2021 season. The increase is aimed to provide more room for players to operate around the bases, while modestly shrinking the distance between bases themselves. Additionally, the larger bases will be composed of material that is expected to perform better in wet conditions.
- **Defensive Position Restrictions:** Teams must have a minimum of four defensive players on the infield when their pitcher delivers, with at least two infielders on either side of second base. The penalty for violation is an automatic ball, but if the hitter swings and gets a better outcome, the offensive team can take that. Goal is to increase batting average on balls in play.

Franklin Font was named manager of the Stockton Ports on March 21, 2022. He was originally named the Ports' Assistant Hitting Coach but assumed Managerial duties when Anthony Phillips was reassigned to the Arizona Complex League.

Font returns to professional baseball in the United States from France where he served as manager of the Aigles de France of the ESBL (European Super League of Professional Baseball) in 2021.

He joins the A's organization after spending 20 seasons in various coaching roles with the Chicago Cubs organization, including a minor league manager in 2002, 2005-06 and 2008. From 2012-20, he served as a Major League staff assistant following a one-year stint as assistant hitting coach with the Major League team.

Font was signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Cubs in 1995 and played in six minor league seasons with the club.

Born in Caracas, Venezuela, Font resides in Mesa, AZ with his wife, Maria. He has three children, Veronica, Benjamin and Balentine, and one grandson, Franklin Jr.



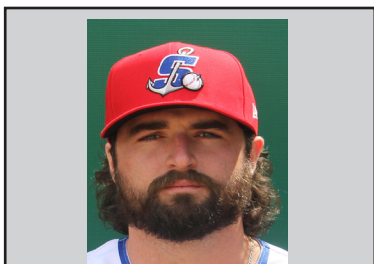
**#20 BRYAN COREY,

Bryan Corey returns to Stockton for his second stint as pitching coach of the Ports, a role he previously held in 2018. He served as assistant pitching rehab coordinator last season and was pitching coach for the AZL A's the previous two seasons. He also spent two seasons as pitching coach at Short-Season Vermont. Originally drafted as a SS by Detroit in the 12th round of the 1993 draft, Corey was converted to a pitcher after two pro seasons. He spent five years in the Majors and also pitched in Japan, Korea and Taiwan before retiring after the 2012 season. A native of Thousand Oaks, CA, Corey resides in Phoenix, AZ and has two daughters, Brooke and Blair.

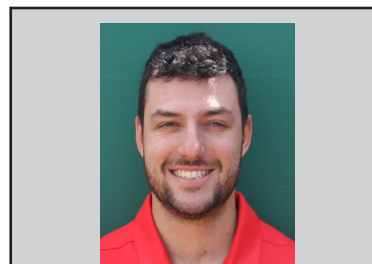
**#6 COOPER GOLDBY

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP **Luke Anderson** makes his sixth start for the Ports in game three of their six-game series against the Modesto Nuts at Banner Island Ballpark.

LAST OUTING: **Anderson** took his second loss of the season in his last start, allowing six runs (four earned) on seven hits in 4.0 innings against the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes at LoanMart Field in Southern California. Anderson allowed a season-high two home runs and has now allowed three homers over his last two starts after not allowing a long ball in any of his first three. Anderson has also allowed eight of his 13 walks this season over his last two starts.

vs. MODESTO: **Anderson** did not factor in the decision in his first start of the year, allowing six runs (four earned) on eight hits over 3.1 IP against the Nuts on April 14. After keeping Modesto scoreless in the first, the Nuts scored four times in the second (two unearned runs), once in the third and once more in the fourth to chase Anderson. The Ports came back from a 6-1 deficit in that game to pick up their first win of the season, 11-6.

MISCELLANEOUS: Selected by the A's in the 15th round of the 2021 draft out of the Central Oklahoma...Pitched in two games in the ACL after signing, allowing just one hit over three scoreless innings while striking out three...Went 6-5 with a 3.96 ERA in his final year at Central Oklahoma, striking out 76 in 72.2 IP..Went 9-5 with a 5.32 ERA over 35 career games in college, 18 of which were starts...Began his college career at Missouri where he made 17 appearances over two seasons... Was also an all-league basketball player in high school
