TONIGHT'S GAME: The Modesto Nuts (Class-A; Seattle Mariners) continue a six-game set with the Stockton Ports (Class-A; Oakland Athletics). With the loss, the Nuts have lost five straight in the season series with the Ports. At four games under .500, the Nuts have matched their worst record of the season. They are 2-7 in their last nine games. 14 of the Nuts' 19 losses have been by three or fewer runs.

ROAD POWER: The Nuts' offense has crushed 24 home runs in 19 road games this season. They have 8 home runs in 14 games at JTF. Five of those came in their last five games at the place for fun.

STREAKING: *Edwin Arroyo* is in the midst of the Nuts' longest hitting streak this season. He has recorded a hit in 12 straight games (.306 (15x49) 8 XBH 9 RBI). In 17 road games, *Arroyo* is hitting .324 with a .704 SLG. All six of his home runs have come on the road.

BIG RBI GUYS: The duo of *Robert Perez Jr.* and *Edwin Arroyo* are two of the top run producers in the league. *Perez* leads the league with 36 RBI. *Arroyo* is 3rd with 26 runs driven in.

BOMB.COM/PEREZ: *Robert Perez Jr.* has hit three home runs in his last two games... In his last 12 games, *Perez* is hitting .298 (14x47) with 7 HR, 18 RBI, 4 2B. 11 R... He has 5 HR in 7 games in Stockton. He has 3 multi-homer games this season. He had one last year with Modesto. He has 5 multi-homer games in his career. His first was 6/21/17 in the DSL... The last Modesto player to lead the league in home runs was *Steve Cox* (30; 1995)... *Robert Perez Jr.* bombed a milestone home run on Friday 5/13. It was his 44th pro home run and his 24th California League home run. He and his father, *Robert Perez Sr.* have now combined for over 300 professional home runs. Sr. played 24 pro season & hit 256 career home runs.

Nuts Notes

PREVIOUSLY: This is the Nuts' second series against the Ports. In the first, the Nuts won the first two games before losing the next four, their longest losing streak of the year. The offense crushed ten home runs. *Robert Perez Jr.* recorded a three-homer game and hit four total bombs. The Nuts went 12x14 in stolen base attempts. The issue for the Nuts was their starting pitching. Starters posted a 12.10 ERA while the bullpen posted a 2.93 mark. In game one of that series, the Nuts recorded 21 strikeouts, which was one shy of the league record (22) which was set on May 20th, 1964 when Salinas struck out 22 hitters against Santa Barbara... It was the first 20+strikeout game by Nuts pitching since July 15th, 2019 when they recorded 23 strikeouts in a 15 inning game.

BOMB.COM/ARROYO: *Edwin Arroyo* has entered the chat about the top power hitters in the California League. The former 2nd round pick is coming off a monster road trip in which he connected on five home runs. Overall, he hit went 17x44 on the road trip and hit .386/.440/.864 with 14 RBI, 2 2B, 2 3B, 4 BB 7 K.

RULES: The pitch clock is back. It will be set at 14 seconds with the bases clear and 18 seconds with runners on base. The timer starts when the pitcher has possession of the ball and is on the dirt of the mound, while the hitter, umpire, and catcher are all in the dirt area around home plate. Last year it was 15 and 17 seconds. During each plate appearance, the pitcher will be allowed two pickoffs, with the third needing to record an out or the runner will advance one base. The batter must be alert to the pitcher at the nine-second mark of the clock or risk being given an auto strike. The hitters will be granted time only once per plate appearance. The size of each base has gone from 15 to 18 square inches. In the second half of the season, second base will be moving in closer toward the mound... The shift is banded in the California League this year. There must be two infielders on either side of the second and all four infielders need to have both feet on the infield dirt.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The regular season will be split into two halves. The first half ends on June 23rd with the second half beginning on June 24th. Four of the eight teams in the Low-A California League will make the playoffs. The first and second half division winners will meet in a best-of-three game series. The winners of those series will meet for a best-of-three championship series. The last California League Championship in Modesto came in 2017. It was the first year of the Nuts' affiliation with the Seattle Mariners. The Nuts' current pitching coach Nathan Bannister was the game one starter on that pitching staff.
