A CHANGE OF SCENERY CAN'T HURT

The Red Stars enter tonight's match on a three-game losing streak and looking to refocus the offensive attack. After a strong start to the season, Chicago has gone 308 minutes - and the entire month of May - without scoring a goal. Last time out the Red Stars outshot Saint Louis 12-5, including a 6-1 margin in shots on goal, but still couldn't find the back of the net. Chicago was playing without four starters as Marian Dalmy, Carli Lloyd, Megan Rapinoe and Lindsay Tarpley were serving international duty with the U.S. national team.

LIFE OUTSIDE THE LAND OF LINCOLN

Tonight is the eighth match of the season for the Red Stars - and just the second to be contested outside the state of Illinois. Chicago has played five games at home and opened the season against Saint Louis, but the game was played east of the Mississippi in Edwardsville, Illinois. The Red Stars' only previous game beyond the state line was a 0-0 draw April 11 at Washington.

WPS GOES MID-WEEK

The Home Depot Center plays host to the first Wednesday night match in Women's Professional Soccer history tonight, but it certainly won't be the last. The WPS schedule features Wednesday night games on 10 of the next 11 weeks - all the way through the last week of the regular season in August. The Red Stars will play a total of five mid-week matches, but only one at home. The Washington Freedom visit Chicago on Wednesday, July 1.

SO CAL HOMECOMING

Three members of the Red Stars roster have ties to the Los Angeles area. Defender Jill Oakes was named Gatorade High School Player of the Year at Harvard-Westlake HS in 2001 before starring collegiately at UCLA, where she was a teammate of Red Stars forward Danesha Adams. Midfielder Brittany Klein grew up in Arcadia, Calif., and played at Santa Clara University. The trio also teamed up in 2008 to help the Santa Monica-based Pali Blues to the W-League championship.

SO CAL HOMECOMING, PART II

Four other Red Stars also grew up around The Golden State. Defender Natalie Spilger hails from El Cajon and played at Stanford, while Belmont, Calif. native Chioma Igwe and Marian Dalmy both spent their college days at Santa Clara. Midfielder Megan Rapinoe grew up in the northern California city of Redding.

THEY'VE COME A LONG WAY FROM SWEDEN

Red Stars midfielder Frida Östberg has connections with a pair of Sol players, having teamed with Marta and Johanna Frisk at legendary Swedish club Umeå IK. Östberg and Marta played together in 2004 and 2005, helping Umeå to a Swedish championship and Champions League title. In 2008, Östberg rejoined Umeå after a few seasons away and also played with Frisk.

TOUGH TASK FOR A STRUGGLING OFFENSE

The Red Stars sputtering attack goes head-to-head with the toughest goalkeeper in the league tonight. Los Angeles' Karina LeBlanc has allowed just two goals in seven matches, and a pair of Red Stars players know first hand just how good the keeper is. LeBlanc is a former W-League teammate of Red Stars captain Lindsay Tarpley - the pair helped the New Jersey Wildcats to the 2005 W-League championship - and Chicago defender Jill Oakes, who joined LeBlanc in New Jersey for the 2006 campaign.

SHE'S COMING BOCK HOME IN AUGUST

Los Angeles' Brittany Bock has a large cheering section in Red Stars country. The Sol forward grew up in the Chicago suburb of Naperville, where she starred at Neuqua Valley High School, then stayed close by for college at the University of Notre Dame. Bock and the Sol only make one visit to Chicago during the 2009 regular season - the Red Stars' home finale on Aug. 2.

LLOYD OUT FOR TWO WEEKS

Red Stars midfielder Carli Lloyd is out for two weeks after suffering a deep laceration in her left knee while practicing with the U.S. Women's National Team May 23rd. Lloyd suffered a 2.5 inch deep gash on the front of her kneecap after skidding on the ground trying to cross a ball, requiring six stitches to close. The injury was not serious, meaning Lloyd should be ready to return at full speed soon.

RED STARS ANNOUNCE SCHEDULE CHANGES

The Red Stars recently announced a pair of schedule changes for upcoming home games. Chicago's next home match will be at 3 pm on Sunday, June 21st. It had previously been scheduled for June 20th. In addition the July 26th match against Washington will now start at 3 pm instead of 7.

ROAD TRIP!

The Red Stars open their longest road trip of the season tonight - a four game stretch from June 3-17. After a west coast swing to Los Angeles and FC Gold Pride, the team makes a quick training stop in Chicago before heading east for a pair of games at Washington and Sky Blue FC. The Red Stars aren't back in action at TOYOTA PARK until Father's Day (June 21) when they host the Boston Breakers for a 3 pm match.

ABOUT CHICAGO RED STARS COACH EMMA HAYES



Emma Hayes was named the Head Coach and Director of Soccer Operations for the Chicago Red Stars on May 15, 2008.

Since 2006, Hayes has served as first team assistant coach and academy director at the FA's Women's Premier League's top-ranked Arsenal Ladies Football Club in London, England. Hayes helped guide the Lady Gunners to an undefeated league record and won every competition England has to offer.

Prior to joining Arsenal, Hayes served as head women's soccer coach at Iona College in New Rochelle, NY. Hayes' honors at Iona included the 2004 Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) Coach of the Year and the 2004-2005 MAAC Conference Championships.

Hayes also served as head coach domestically from 2001-2003 in the W-League with the Long Island Lady Riders. The youngest female head coach in W-League history, Hayes was named 2002 National Coach of the Year.
