RED STARS END THE STREAKS

The Red Stars enter tonight's match having earned their first point in over a month, thanks to a 1-1 tie at Los Angeles Wednesday night. Brazilian striker Cristiane scored her first goal of the season on an 88th minute shot from the right side of the six-yard box to put Chicago in front. But the Sol scored two minutes later, with Camille Abily recording the equalizer. The tie snapped a three-match losing streak for the Red Stars and also put to bed the longest scoreless drought in Women's Professional Soccer history. Prior to Cristiane's goal Chicago had gone 396 minutes without scoring - dating back to a Brittany Klein goal in the second half against Boston on April 25.

BACK HOME AT BUCK SHAW

Tonight's match serves as a homecoming for three members of the Red Stars roster who are very familiar with Buck Shaw Stadium. Defender Marian Dalmy and midfielders Chioma Igwe and Brittany Klein each played collegiately at Santa Clara University. A two-year team captain, Dalmy was the 2006 West Coast Conference Player of the Year and earned All-WCC first team honors three times. Klein captained the Broncos as a senior in 2007, also earning All-WCC first team honors. Both Dalmy and Klein were part of Santa Clara's NCAA Tournament run in 2004, although a torn ACL kept Dalmy from playing in the College Cup. Igwe played two seasons for the Broncos after transferring from Cal following her sophomore season. In addition, Red Stars television analyst Danielle Slaton was a four-year stand-out at SCU and won a national championship with the Broncos in 2001.

LAST TIME AROUND

FC Gold Pride won the first meeting between franchises, a 1-0 victory May 16 at TOYOTA PARK. Christine Sinclair scored unassisted in the 30th minute when a Tiffeny Milbrett shot bounced off Red Stars keeper Caroline Jönsson and right to Sinclair. The visitors outshot Chicago 12-7 in the match, including a 5-3 advantage in shots on goal.

CALIFORNIA DREAMING

Beyond the Santa Clara trio, four other members of the Red Stars have been looking forward to their trip back to The Golden State. Defender Natalie Spilger grew up in El Cajon and played at Stanford University while midfielder Megan Rapinoe hails from the northern California city of Redding. Defender Jill Oakes calls the Los Angeles suburb West Hills home; she and forward Danesha Adams both played their college soccer at UCLA.

TOUGH AS SWEDES

Chicago goalkeeper Caroline Jönsson is the only WPS keeper to have played every minute for her team this season. The Swede has been solid in minding the net, posting a 0.88 goals against average and three clean sheets. No other Red Stars have logged all 720 minutes of game action this season, but Karen Carney and Brittany Klein have started each of Chicago's eight matches. Jönsson's Swedish national teammate Frida Östberg would likely also be on that list, but was forced to miss the home opener after drawing a red card April 11 at Washington.

WEARING DOWN THE BACK LINE

FC Gold Pride is without two defensive starters for tonight's match. Former Notre Dame standout Carrie Dew - who has started all eight matches to date - will sit tonight after receiving two yellow cards in FC Gold Pride's last game, May 31 at Washington. Additionally, Kandace Wilson was lost for the season after fracturing her hip socket May 24 against Los Angeles.

LIGHTS, CAMERA, COMCAST!

For the fourth time this season Red Stars fans can watch their team on television tonight, as the match is broadcast live regionally on Comcast SportsNet Chicago. It's the first of a two-game regional television package for the Red Stars and FC Gold Pride - their July 12th match at TOYOTA PARK will also be broadcast by Comcast. The Red Stars' broadcast team of Dean Linke and Danielle Slaton will call the action for both of the games.

PLAYOFF WATCH

With the midway point of the WPS season just around the corner, it's not too early to begin sizing up the postseason race. The Red Stars' nine points have them currently in sole possession of fifth place in the standings, just a point behind FC Gold Pride for the fourth and final playoff spot.

LIFE OUTSIDE THE LAND OF LINCOLN

For just the third time on the year the Red Stars play outside the state of Illinois tonight (Chicago's opener at Saint Louis was contested in Edwardsville, Illinois). Chicago has the only unbeaten road record in WPS at 1-0-2; its two previous games across state lines have both ended in ties (0-0 at Washington April 11th and 1-1 at Los Angeles Wednesday).

LLOYD OUT FOR TWO WEEKS

Red Stars midfielder Carli Lloyd is out for two weeks after suffering a deep laceration in her left knee while practicing with the U.S. Women's National Team May 23rd. Lloyd suffered a 2.5 inch gash on the front of her kneecap after skidding on the ground trying to cross a ball, requiring six stitches to close. The injury was not serious, meaning Lloyd should be ready to return at full speed soon.

ABOUT CHICAGO RED STARS COACH EMMA HAYES



Emma Hayes was named the Head Coach and Director of Soccer Operations for the Chicago Red Stars on May 15, 2008.

Since 2006, Hayes has served as first team assistant coach and academy director at the FA's Women's Premier League's top-ranked Arsenal Ladies Football Club in London, England. Hayes helped guide the Lady Gunners to an undefeated league record and won every competition England has to offer.

Prior to joining Arsenal, Hayes served as head women's soccer coach at Iona College in New Rochelle, NY. Hayes' honors at Iona included the 2004 Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) Coach of the Year and the 2004-2005 MAAC Conference Championships.

Hayes also served as head coach domestically from 2001-2003 in the W-League with the Long Island Lady Riders. The youngest female head coach in W-League history, Hayes was named 2002 National Coach of the Year.
