

MATCH STORYLINES

A FAMILIAR FOE

OVER THE PRIDE'S HISTORY, MEETINGS WITH GOTHAM FC HAVE HISTORICALLY BEEN THE MOST EVEN MATCHUP AMONGST ANY OPPONENT. THE TWO SIDES HOLD A 7-7-5 ALL-TIME RECORD, EACH HOLDING AN EVEN SEVEN WINS ALL-TIME. ADDITIONALLY, THE TWO SIDES ARE SET TO MEET FOUR TOTAL TIMES THIS YEAR, WITH GOTHAM IN THE PRIDE'S NWSL CHALLENGE CUP GROUP, ALONG WITH WASHINGTON AND NORTH CAROLINA. ON THURSDAY IT WAS ANNOUNCED THAT UKG WILL BE PROVIDING A \$1 MILLION PRIZE TO THE 2023 CHALLENGE CUP WINNER.

SHINE BRIGHT LIKE A MESSIAH

FORWARD MESSIAH BRIGHT RECORDED HER FIRST PROFESSIONAL GOAL IN THE PRIDE'S LAST MATCH AGAINST ANGEL CITY FC. BRIGHT CAME ON AS A FIRST-HALF SUBSTITUTE DUE TO AN INJURY SUFFERED BY JULIE DOYLE AND LATER FOUND THE BACK OF THE NET IN THE 51ST MINUTE. BRIGHT RECEIVED THE BALL AND WAS ABLE TO FEND OFF TWO ANGEL CITY DEFENDERS AND CALMLY SLOT THE BALL INTO THE BOTTOM CORNER OF THE NET.

REMEMBERING WATT HAPPENED

IN THE LAST MATCHUP BETWEEN THESE TWO SIDES, THE PRIDE STROLLED OUT OF SUBARU PARK WITH A 2-1 VICTORY OVER GOTHAM, BACKED BY A 49TH MINUTE GOAL FROM DEFENDER CELIA AND A 73RD MINUTE STRIKE BY FORWARD ALLY WATT. THE MATCH SERVED AS WATT'S DEBUT WITH THE PRIDE AFTER BEING ACQUIRED VIA TRADE JUST FIVE DAYS EARLIER, SCORING JUST NINE MINUTES INTO HER FIRST APPEARANCE FOR ORLANDO. DEFENDER HALEY MCCUTCHEON ALSO MADE HER DEBUT WITH THE PRIDE AFTER BEING REQUIRED DAYS BEFORE THE GAME, AS WELL.

GATOR HALL OF FAMER

PRIDE MIDFIELDER ERIKA TYMRAK NOTCHED AN ASSIST ON THE BRIGHT GOAL AGAINST ANGEL CITY IN THE CLUB'S LAST MATCH. IT COUNTED AS THE FIRST ASSIST OF THE SEASON FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA ALUMNA, WHO ALSO LED THE SIDE IN ASSIST LAST YEAR. A FEW DAYS PRIOR TO THE MATCH, IT WAS ANNOUNCED THAT TYMRAK WOULD BE INDUCTED INTO THE UF ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME AS PART OF THE 2023 CLASS. TYMRAK RECORDED 32 GOALS AND 40 ASSISTS, WHICH STILL SHARES NO. 3 ALL-TIME FOR THE GATORS, TO GO ALONG WITH THREE SEC TITLES IN HER FOUR-YEAR CAREER AS A GATOR.

NO DAYS OFF

THE PRIDE ARE COMING OFF AN INTERNATIONAL WHICH SAW A FEW OF THEIR PLAYERS REPRESENT THEIR RESPECTIVE COUNTRIES IN THE BUILDUP TO THE 2023 FIFA WOMEN'S WORLD CUP COMING THIS SUMMER. FORWARD ADRIANA GOT THE START AND WENT THE FULL 90 MINUTES FOR BRAZIL IN A 2-1 VICTORY OVER GERMANY. FORWARD AMANDA ALLEN SPENT THE BREAK WITH THE CANADIAN NATIONAL TEAM AS THEY PLAYED A FRIENDLY AGAINST FRANCE AND FELL 2-1. FORWARD HALEY BUGEJA REPRESENTED HER HOME COUNTRY, MALTA, OVER THE BREAK AND HELPED EARN HER SQUAD A 2-1 VICTORY OVER ESTONIA WITH A GOAL IN THE MATCH.

HEAD COACH SEB HINES

ON TAKEAWAYS FROM THE ANGEL CITY MATCH...

WE LOOKED LIKE TWO DIFFERENT TEAMS FROM THE TEAM THAT PLAYED AGAINST PORTLAND AND THE TEAM THAT TURNED UP AGAINST LA. OBVIOUSLY, DISAPPOINTED AFTER THE RESULT, PERFORMANCE WAS GOOD IN TERMS OF WORK ETHIC AND DESIRE AND ATTITUDE. BUT END OF THE DAY, WE HAVE TO WIN THEM GAMES AT HOME, WE HAVE TO WIN GAMES AT HOME. AND IT'S ANOTHER LEARNING MOMENT FOR US. YOU KNOW, WE FELT LIKE WE'RE THE TEAM THAT WAS GOING TO WIN THE GAME. WE WERE THE TEAM THAT WANTED TO WIN THE GAME AND WE FELL SHORT. SO YEAH, WE REFLECTED WE DID VIDEO SESSIONS, WE'VE HAD TIME ON THE FIELD, WHICH HAS BEEN GOOD. AGAIN, THE EFFORT OF THE PLAYERS HAS BEEN TREMENDOUS AND WE'RE LOOKING FORWARD TO THE GAME ON SATURDAY.

ON WHAT TO EXPECT FROM GOTHAM...

THEY'RE GOING TO HAVE TO BOUNCE BACK FROM THEIR GAME AGAINST OL REIGN. THEY'RE VERY EXPERIENCED, THEY GOT SOME BIG NAMES AND WE HAVE TO BE MINDFUL OF THAT. WE HAVE TO BE AWARE OF THE THREATS AND THEIR QUALITIES. BUT AGAIN, THE FOCUS IS ON OURSELVES. WE HAVE TO BOUNCE BACK, WE NEED TO GET POINTS ON THE TABLE, WE NEED TO GIVE THE FANS MOMENTS TO BE EXCITED ABOUT AS WELL AND REALLY SHOW HOW FAR THIS TEAM HAS COME IN THE PAST WEEKS AND MONTHS OVER PRESEASON. SO, AGAIN, IT'S ANOTHER GAME THAT WE FEEL WE CAN GO OUT AND WIN AND BE COMPETITIVE AND BUILD FROM THAT.

ON THE FOCUS IN TRAINING THIS WEEK...

JUST GOING BACK TO OUR PRINCIPLES, OUR IDENTITY, WHO WE ARE THAT WE SPOKE SO HIGHLY OF IN PRESEASON. GOING BACK, WE HAD A SUCCESSFUL PRESEASON. REALLY SHOWING, THIS IS WHO WE ARE. LIKE I SAID EARLIER, TWO DIFFERENT TEAMS LAST TWO GAMES, WE HAVE TO BRING IT TOGETHER. WE HAVE TO BE AS THREATENING IN THE ATTACK AS WE ARE TRYING TO KEEP THE BALL OUT THE NET AS WELL. AND, YOU KNOW, JUST KEEP REINFORCING THAT MESSAGE. SO THAT'S, THAT'S BEEN THE MAIN FOCUS. OBVIOUSLY, THERE'S AREAS THAT WE NEED TO REALLY FOCUS ON. BUT AGAIN, GOING BACK TO OUR IDENTITY AND WHO WE ARE IS MOST IMPORTANT.

ON FORMER PRIDE PLAYER ALI KRIEGER WHO ANNOUNCED THIS WILL BE HER FINAL SEASON...

I MEAN, IT'S AN OUTSTANDING CAREER TO GO AS LONG AS SHE HAS PLAYING AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL AND CONSISTENTLY PERFORMING. IT'S A CREDIT TO HER AND ALL THE WORK SHE'S PUT INTO IT. SHE'S A GREAT HUMAN BEING, AS WELL. YOU KNOW I'VE GOT A LOT OF TIME WITH HER, SPENT SOME TIME WITH HER WORKING IN AREAS THAT SHE WANTS TO IMPROVE ON, EVEN WITH THE EXPERIENCES SHE HAS. SHE'S A SHE'S A TESTAMENT TO THE PLAYERS IN THE LEAGUE WHO HAVE PLAYED FOR ALL THE YEARS AND IT'S A TOUGH ONE, BECAUSE SHE'S OBVIOUSLY OUR OPPONENT, BUT WE WISH HER ALL THE BEST IN A NEW CAREER AFTER THIS SEASON AND CREDIT TO HER, SHE'S BEEN BRILLIANT.

MIDFIELDER MIKAYLA CLUFF

ON HAVING AN EXTRA WEEK OF TRAINING TO PREP FOR THE GAME... WE HAD A FULL WEEK OF TRAINING STILL. SO WE HAD A REALLY GOOD WEEK LAST WEEK AND THEN HAD A COUPLE DAYS OFF THIS WEEKEND. AND IT WAS NICE JUST TO KIND OF BE ABLE TO RECOVER A LITTLE BIT AND GET SOME NEW ENERGY GOING INTO THIS WEEK AND TO THE NEXT FEW GAMES THAT WE HAVE COMING UP.

ON HOW THE TEAM REBOUNDS FOR THE ANGEL CITY RESULT...

YEAH, IT WAS TOUGH. OBVIOUSLY, GETTING SCORED ON IN THE 98TH MINUTE, OR WHATEVER IT WAS, IS DIFFICULT AND WE FELT LIKE THAT GAME WAS OURS TO TAKE, FOR SURE. SO I THINK NOW IT'S JUST KIND OF GIVEN US THAT NEW MOTIVATION, THAT NEW ENERGY TO NOT TAKE ANYTHING FOR GRANTED, NOT EXPECT TO WIN ANY GIVEN GAME, BUT JUST KNOW THAT EVERY GAME IS DIFFICULT, AND THAT WE HAVE TO BRING IT EVERY SINGLE GAME AND THAT WE'RE MORE THAN CAPABLE OF GETTING THE RESULT.

ON THE TEAM'S PROGRESSION BETWEEN THE FIRST TWO GAMES...

WE'RE NEW, WE'RE YOUNG, BUT IT SEEMS LIKE EVER SINCE PRESEASON BEGAN, WE HAVE THIS HUNGER AND DESIRE TO COME TOGETHER COLLECTIVELY, THAT WE HAVE KIND OF THIS UNDERDOG MENTALITY WHERE WE KNOW WHAT WE'RE ABLE TO ACHIEVE AND NOW IT'S JUST UP TO US TO PROVE THAT TO EVERYBODY. 


