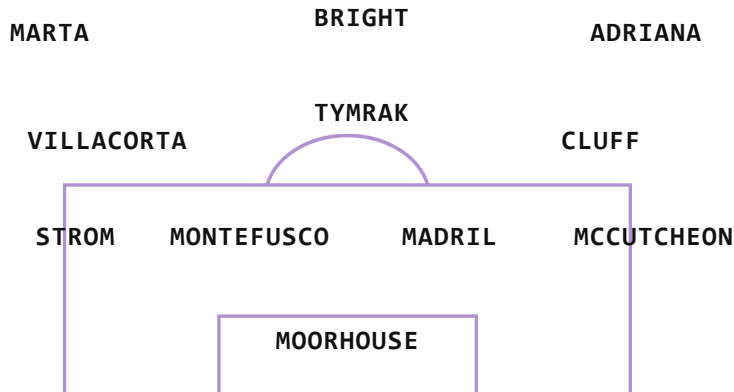

# ORL PRIDE

## 2023 GAME NOTES

### MATCH STORYLINES

#### NWSL

RETURNING TO NWSL REGULAR SEASON PLAY, THE PRIDE WILL LOOK TO EXTEND THEIR WINNING STREAK TO THREE GAMES AGAINST GOTHAM. THE TEAM'S MOST RECENT ROAD TRIP IN THE REGULAR SEASON RESULTED IN A 3-1 WIN OVER THE SAN DIEGO WAVE AT SNAPDRAGON STADIUM. THE MATCH SAW MIKAYLA CLUFF, HALEY MCCUTCHEON AND ADRIANA ALL FIND THE BACK OF THE NET. THE PRIDE FOLLOWED THAT WIN UP BY RETURNING HOME TO EXPLORIA STADIUM AND EARNING A 1-0 VICTORY OVER RACING LOUISVILLE BEHIND A GOAL BY MESSIAH BRIGHT AND GOALKEEPER ANNA MOORHOUSE MAKING SEVEN SAVES TO PRESERVE THE TEAM'S FIRST CLEAN SHEET OF THE SEASON.

#### STAYING BUSY

THE MATCH AGAINST NJ/NY GOTHAM FC WILL SERVE AS THE CLUB'S THIRD GAME IN THE LAST NINE DAYS ACROSS ALL COMPETITIONS. WITH THE BUSY SCHEDULE, IT HAS ALLOWED HEAD COACH SEB HINES TO GO INTO THE DEPTH OF HIS TEAM AND GIVE SOME MINUTES TO A NUMBER OF PLAYERS. THE MATCH AGAINST THE SPIRIT SAW THREE PLAYERS EARN THEIR FIRST START FOR THE CLUB WITH AMANDA ALLEN, HALEY BUGEJA AND BRIANNA MARTINEZ ALL GETTING THE NOD IN THE STARTING XI. DEFENDER CELIA AND MIDFIELDER THAIS REISS BOTH MADE THEIR 2023 DEBUTS, ALSO EARNING A SPOT IN THE STARTING LINEUP.

#### DEJA VU

FORWARD ALLY WATT RECORDED HER SECOND GOAL OF THE SEASON IN THE MATCH AGAINST THE SPIRIT SHORTLY AFTER HALFTIME. ALL OF WATT'S GOALS SO FAR THIS SEASON HAVE COME IN THE CHALLENGE CUP, AFTER SHE FOUND THE BACK OF THE NET IN A 1-1 DRAW AGAINST THE NORTH CAROLINA COURAGE IN THE CLUB'S OPENING MATCH OF THE TOURNAMENT. MIDFIELDER SUMMER YATES PICKED UP THE ASSIST AND HAS PROVIDED THE HELPER ON BOTH OF WATT'S GOALS THIS SEASON. THE DUO BOTH LEAD THE CHALLENGE CUP IN THEIR RESPECTIVE CATEGORIES WITH WATT BEING TIED FOR THE TEAM'S GOLDEN BOOT AND YATES SITTING ALL BY HERSELF AS THE LEADING ASSIST HOLDER, SO FAR.

#### TAR (BACK) HEEL

PRIDE DEFENDER TORI HANSEN SCORED HER FIRST PROFESSIONAL GOAL IN THE CLUB'S LAST MATCH AGAINST THE WASHINGTON SPIRIT IN THE UKG NWSL CHALLENGE CUP. THE 2023 DRAFT PICK GOT THE PRIDE ON THE BOARD AFTER THE BALL FELL TO HER IN THE BOX AND SHE FLICKED IT WITH HER BACK HEEL INTO THE NET. THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA PRODUCT ALSO EARNED THE SECOND START OF HER CAREER IN THE MATCH AND PLAYED THE FULL 90 MINUTES.

#### GOTHAM TAKEOVER

THE PRIDE ARE UNBEATEN IN THEIR LAST FIVE TRIPS TO NJ/NY GOTHAM FC. THE CLUB'S LAST ROAD LOSS TO GOTHAM CAME BACK ON SEPTEMBER 8, 2018. THEIR MOST RECENT TRIP TO PLAY GOTHAM WAS A MATCH PLAYED IN PHILADELPHIA AT SUBARU PARK AND RESULTED IN A 2-1 VICTORY FOR THE PRIDE. THE TEAM WAS BACKED BY GOALS FROM CELIA AND ALLY WATT, WITH THE LATTER MAKING HER DEBUT FOR THE CLUB IN THE MATCH, COMING ON AS A SECOND-HALF SUBSTITUTE AND SCORING JUST MINUTES IN.

#### TYMRAK TIME

PRIDE MIDFIELDER ERIKA TYMRAK IS THE ONLY PLAYER IN LEAGUE HISTORY TO RECORD AN ASSIST IN EVERY REGULAR SEASON. THROUGH THE FIRST FOUR GAMES OF THE YEAR, TYMRAK HAS TWO ASSISTS, ONE AGAINST ANGEL CITY FC AND ONE AGAINST SAN DIEGO. ADDITIONALLY, SHOULD TYMRAK SCORE ONE GOAL THIS YEAR AND ADD ONE MORE ASSIST, SHE WILL INCREASE HER CAREER TOTALS TO 20 GOALS AND 20 ASSISTS, BECOMING JUST THE 12TH PLAYER IN LEAGUE HISTORY TO ACCOMPLISH THAT FEAT.

- ERIKA TYMRAK IS ONE APPEARANCE AWAY FROM 175 ACROSS ALL NWSL COMPETITIONS, AND THREE FROM 50 WITH THE PRIDE.

### WHAT THEY'RE SAYING

#### HEAD COACH SEB HINES

##### *ON HOW THE TEAM IS FEELING HEADING INTO THE MATCH*

STILL POSITIVE, WE STILL HAVE GOOD MOMENTUM. OBVIOUSLY, THE GAME ON WEDNESDAY DIDN'T GO THE WAY THAT WE WANTED. BUT THERE'S STILL A LOT OF GOOD VIBES AROUND THE GROUP. AGAIN, IT'S A COMPETITIVE ENVIRONMENT, EVERYONE'S PUSHING EACH OTHER. [STAYING ON THE ROAD] DOES ALLOW YOU TO SPEND TIME WITH EACH OTHER. WHEN YOU'RE AT HOME, YOU DO YOUR OWN THING, YOU GO BACK TO YOUR OWN HOUSE, YOUR OWN APARTMENT. BUT [THE ROAD] DOES ALLOW THE PLAYERS TO GET TO KNOW EACH OTHER A LITTLE BIT MORE AND THAT'S WHAT WE SPOKE ABOUT IN PRESEASON. GETTING TO KNOW ONE ANOTHER, GET TO TRAIN, GET TO EAT, GET TO SOCIALIZE. AND THAT'S A GOOD THING WITHIN THIS GROUP, BECAUSE IT'S A LONG SEASON. THERE'S A LOT OF GAMES AND THESE MOMENTS ARE REALLY IMPORTANT.

##### *ON THREE GAMES IN A WEEK, WITH TWO ON THE ROAD*

IT CAN'T ALWAYS BE FOOTBALL. YOU TRAIN AND YOU'VE GOT TO GIVE THE PLAYERS SOME DOWNTIME. OBVIOUSLY, THERE'S A LOT OF RECOVERY WITHIN THAT TIME AS WELL BECAUSE OF THE THREE-GAME WEEK AND THE TRAVEL. BUT WE HAVE A CLEAR OBJECTIVE GOING INTO SUNDAY. WE KNOW WHAT WE NEED TO DO. WE'VE REITERATED THAT TO THE PLAYERS. WE'VE ALREADY PLAYED GOTHAM EARLY ON IN THE SEASON AND THERE WASN'T A LOT BETWEEN THE TWO TEAMS. WE KNOW THAT THEY'VE GOT A STACKED ROSTER WITH SOME INTERNATIONALS, BUT YOU LOOK BACK ON THAT GAME, IT WAS DEFINED BY A REFEREE CALL. WE GO THERE WITH HUNGER TO GO OUT THERE AND BEAT THEM. SO AGAIN, WE HAVE THAT MOMENTUM, THE PLAYERS ARE ALL BOUGHT INTO IT, THEY'RE ALL REALLY UNITED IN THE OBJECTIVE GOING INTO SUNDAY'S GAME.

##### *ON EXPECTATIONS FOR SUNDAY'S LINEUP*

WE KNOW THAT GOTHAM HAD THE MIDWEEK GAME OFF SO THEY GOT A LONGER PERIOD TO PREPARE FOR THIS GAME. I'VE ALWAYS SAID THAT IT'S MORE ABOUT THE ROSTER, IT'S NOT JUST THE STARTING 11 AND A COUPLE OF SUBS. IT'S THE OVERALL SQUAD AND EVERYONE HAS TO PLAY THEIR PART IN THIS SEASON. AND AGAIN, GIVING THE PLAYERS THE OPPORTUNITY ON WEDNESDAY TO GO OUT THERE AND PERFORM, WE KNOW WHO WE CAN RELY ON GOING INTO THE GAME. WHO'S LOOKING TO COME OFF THE BENCH AND MAKE A DIFFERENCE? WHO'S THERE TO END THE GAME AND MANAGE THE GAME AT THE END? EVERY GAME GIVES YOU AN OPPORTUNITY TO KNOW MORE ABOUT YOUR PLAYERS AND, YEAH, WE HAD TO ROTATE. WE HAVE TO MAKE SURE THAT WE SET OURSELVES UP FOR SUCCESS, FEEL FRESH AND GO OUT THERE AND GIVE ABSOLUTELY EVERYTHING COME GAME TIME.

##### *ON HOW FACING GOTHAM PREVIOUSLY HELPS*

LIKE I SAID, THERE WAS NOT A LOT BETWEEN THE TWO TEAMS WHEN WE PLAYED THEM AT HOME. WE KNOW THAT THEY'VE GOT THREATENING PLAYERS, WE KNOW THAT LYNN WILLIAMS IS ON A GOOD RUN OF FORM AND WE HAVE TO BE MINDFUL OF HER. BUT THE DAY IS ABOUT US AND WE'VE WON OUR LAST TWO LEAGUE GAMES. WE KEPT A CLEAN SHEET IN

THE LAST GAME AND WE'RE GOING TO NEED THAT AGAIN. WE'RE GOING TO NEED TO STOP THEIR THREATENING PLAYERS IN THE ATTACK, WE'RE GOING TO HAVE TO BE THREATENING IN THE ATTACKING THIRD, AS WELL, AND SCORE GOALS. EVERY GAME IS A DIFFICULT GAME. IT'S A CHALLENGE FOR ALL OF US BUT YOU KNOW WE'RE LOOKING FORWARD TO IT. WE FEEL LIKE WE CAN GO THERE AND WIN A GAME OF FOOTBALL.

#### FORWARD ALLY WATT

##### *ON TAKEAWAYS FROM WEDNESDAY'S GAME*

WE HAVE SO MUCH TO LEARN AND GROW STILL. I KNOW THAT WE ARE DOING REALLY WELL IN THE REGULAR SEASON, BUT WE HAVE SO MUCH ROOM TO GROW STILL. THERE'S A YOUNG TEAM, SO MUCH POTENTIAL HERE, AND WE'RE A NEW TEAM THIS YEAR. SO WE HAVE SO MUCH ROOM TO GROW IN THAT WE'RE BUILDING RELATIONSHIPS, BUILDING IDENTITY STILL, AND JUST GOING AT IT WITH AS MUCH AS WE CAN.

##### *ON HER CONNECTION WITH SUMMER YATES*

WE KNOW EACH OTHER AT THIS POINT. SHE KNOWS IF SHE HAS THE BALL AT HER FEET, SHE'S RUNNING AT THE BACKLINE, I'M RUNNING, SHE KNOWS WHAT GAPS IN PLAY. SHE'S PHENOMENAL PLAYER. WE JUST HAVE A REALLY GOOD RELATIONSHIP THAT WE BUILT IN PRESEASON, I THINK EVERYONE SAW THAT. AND THEN WE'VE BEEN REALLY ABLE TO TRANSLATE IT TO GAMES IN THE SEASON. SO, HOPEFULLY, WE'LL KEEP THAT CONNECTION GOING FOR THE REST OF THE YEAR.

##### *ON IF THE WIN STREAK GIVES CONFIDENCE*

IT GIVES US ALL THE CONFIDENCE WE NEED. WE KNOW THAT WE CAN PLAY, WE KNOW THAT WE HAVE A GOOD FOUNDATION NOW, WE KNOW THAT WE HAVE A SYSTEM AND THAT WE NEED TO KEEP GOING WITH IT. EACH GAME, EACH PRACTICE, WE'RE GROWING MORE INTO OURSELVES. I THINK WITH THIS TWO-GAME WINNING STREAK GOING INTO THIS NEXT GAME THAT WE KNOW THAT WE'RE MORE THAN CAPABLE TO WIN.

##### *ON HOW SHE USES HER SPEED FOR DEFENSE*

I'M TRACKING DOWN A PLAYER WITH THE BALL, IF THEY HEAR MY FOOTSTEPS, WE JUST HOPE WE'RE PUTTING FEAR INTO THEM. STOP RUNNING, THEY PASS THE BALL MAYBE. BUT JUST KEEPING THE HIGH PRESS AS MUCH AS I CAN IS WHAT I CONTRIBUTE TO OUR DEFENSE. SO I USE MY SPEED TO THE BEST OF MY ABILITY TO HELP CLOSE OUT PLAYERS. AND HOPEFULLY, IF I CAN'T GET THE BALL, THEY'LL MAKE A MISTAKE AND THEN WE CAN GET INTO THE TRANSITION. AND THAT'S WHEN I WANT THE BALL TO GO IN BEHIND AND THAT'S THE FUN PART OF IT. SO, BUT ALSO TRYING TO PUT SOME FEAR INTO THE DEFENDERS IS MY FAVORITE PART ABOUT IT.

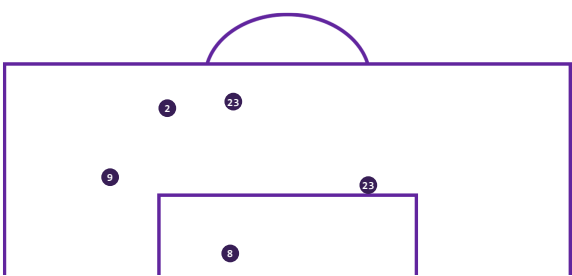

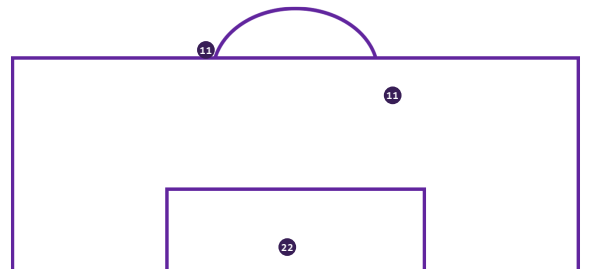

IN ADDITION, CARTER'S ROLE WILL BE INTEGRAL IN LIAISING WITH THE FRONT OFFICE TO GROW AND DEVELOP THE PRIDE ON THE BUSINESS SIDE.

CARTER IS A FORMER PROFESSIONAL PLAYER, BUSINESS EXECUTIVE, COACH, LICENSED ATTORNEY, AND VETERAN OF THE U.S. MARINE CORPS. A CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL SOCCER SCOUT, CARTER HOLDS LEVEL I AND II TALENT IDENTIFICATION CERTIFICATION THROUGH THE PROFESSIONAL FOOTBALL SCOUTS ASSOCIATION, AND SERVED AS CHAIR OF THE WOMEN'S COACHES COMMUNITY FOR UNITED SOCCER COACHES FROM 2019 TO 2023. PRIOR TO THAT, HINES SERVED 15 GAMES AS THE INTERIM HEAD COACH DURING THE 2022 CAMPAIGN, AFTER SPENDING EIGHT YEARS COMBINED AS A MEMBER OF THE ORLANDO PRIDE AND ORLANDO CITY SC FAMILY.

A FORMER DEFENDER IN THE ENGLISH PREMIER LEAGUE, HINES WAS NAMED THE CLUB'S INTERIM HEAD COACH ON JUNE 7, 2022. DURING THAT TIME, THE PRIDE WENT ON A SEVEN-GAME UNBEATEN RUN FROM JULY 3 TO AUG. 20, AND SAW INCREASES IN THE TEAM'S AVERAGES ON SHOTS, SHOT ON TARGET AND PASSING ACCURACY, AS WELL AS THREE TOTAL CLEAN SHEETS.

A NATIVE OF WETHERBY, ENGLAND, THE DEFENDER FIRST CAME TO ORLANDO IN 2015, PLAYING THREE SEASONS WITH ORLANDO CITY SC IN MAJOR LEAGUE SOCCER. FOLLOWING HIS RETIREMENT, HINES BEGAN SHADOWING FORMER PRIDE HEAD COACH TOM SERMANNI IN 2018 AND CONTINUED AS A VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT OVER THE NEXT TWO SEASONS, ULTIMATELY HIRED AS A FULL-TIME ASSISTANT UNDER MARC SKINNER IN 2020.

FOLLOWING HIS STINT WITH DERBY COUNTY, HE THEN HELPED WEST BROMWICH ALBION GAIN PROMOTION TO THE PREMIER LEAGUE WHERE HE PLAYED FOR THEM UNTIL TRANSFERRING TO DONCASTER ROVERS FC.

BARNES TRANSITIONED TO MAJOR LEAGUE SOCCER IN THE UNITED STATES IN 2012 AFTER SIGNING WITH THE HOUSTON DYNAMO. HE PLAYED FOR A FEW DIFFERENT MLS TEAMS BEFORE BEING TRADED TO ORLANDO CITY IN 2017.
