The primary mark is a visual expression of our brand that combines our key defining characteristic in the horn and our celebration of our home, LA.





Design Inspiration

The Perfect Spiral

By focusing on the make-up of the most iconic and sacrosanct part of the brand – the Rams horn – the team discovered nature's beauty unfold with the golden ratio (aka Fibonacci Sequence) in its curvature. It's the same ratio that underpins one of LA's most iconic imagery – the perfect wave. Both are connected through nature's perfect spiral, so this became the driving concept behind the new logo.

This physical design is a reminder of how the Rams new brand identity is foundationally built to embrace, celebrate, and mirror it's LA home. Los Angeles is a City of Dreams with an energetic, driving force that enables the Angeleno spirit to thrive. There is a shared attitude between the Rams and LA towards the relentless pursuit of that dream and the constant pursuit of better. The mark embraces this shared distinctiveness between the Rams and the LA home it represents.

Logo Color Applications

Full Color

Full color logo incorporates all color, gradients and shading. This full color logo should be the most predominately used logo.

Full Color Minus Shading

Full color minus shading logo eliminates the shading elements from the full color logo therefore elimating number of colors incoporated in full color

One-Color

When the printing or reproduction process limits the number of colors that may be used to display the mark, a one-color version may be used.

Grayscale

When an ad or visual is going to be output in grayscale, use a solid positive or reversed mark to provide adequate branding contrast.

Photographic Background

When the mark appears on a photographic background, you may use any of the color or white versions of the marks, making sure a sufficient amount of contrast appears between the photograph and the mark. If the photograph is primarily dark, use a mark specific for dark backgrounds or the one-color yellow mark. If the photograph is primarily light, use a mark specific for light backgrounds or the one-color blue mark.

No matter what expression you choose, your communications will be supported by a foundation built on design integrity and quality.

Spacing And Size Requirements



Clear Space Requirements

The protected area around the marks ensures that no other graphic elements interfere with its clarity and integrity. The depth of the protected area is equivalent to the height of the "X":

Primary Mark Safe Space

The safe space around the primary mark is half the x - height of the 'L'.

Improper Usage

Under no circumstance may any of the Los Angeles Rams marks be modified, altered or enhanced in any manner. Examples of incorrect usage of the marks are below. The marks should never be warped or distorted. Perspective should never be applied to any mark when other elements of the composition are not similarly treated.



At no time should anything (other logos type, etc.) be placed over the identity elements



Identity elements should not be used as a repeat in closed patterns.



Identity elements should not be modified, stretched or distorted in any way.

Identity elements should not be used in any other color combinations other than those specifically called out in this manual.



Identity elements should not appear against any distracting textures or repeated patterns.



Identity elements should not be outlined in any other way other than those specifically called out in this identity manual.



Identity elements should not be used as an outline.



At no time should effects be added to the identity elements.
(Glow, posterize, etc.)



Do not crop the identity elements in any way.



At no time should the proportions or the positions of the identity elements in the sport lock-ups be modified.
