THE MATCHUP

In a matchup of the top two teams in the UFL standings, the Las Vegas Locomotives and Omaha Nighthawks will get together for a battle that could go a long way in helping earn a spot in the championship game for the winner. The Locos have won four straight since losing their season opener to Florida, while the Nighthawks are looking to defend their 2-0 record at home. Kickoff is set for 7 p.m. (CDT) at Rosenblatt Stadium on Thursday, Oct. 28.

Following the announcement that the UFL Championship Game will be played in Omaha on Nov. 27, this matchup could be the first of two battles the teams partake in within the next month. Las Vegas, at 4-1, could all but lock up a spot in the championship game with a win, while Omaha, at 3-1, would take over the standings lead with a win and avenge its only loss of the season.

THE SERIES

The defending UFL champion Locos lead the all-time series 1-0. Las Vegas defeated Omaha 22-10 on Oct. 8 in Las Vegas, giving the Nighthawks their first and only loss of the season.

THE COACHES

Jeff Jagodzinski (Wisconsin-Whitewater, '85) leads the Nighthawks after guiding Boston College to a 20-8 record and two ACC Championship Game appearances in 2007-08. Jagodzinski has coached in the collegiate and professional ranks for 26 years.

Jim Fassel (Long Beach State, '72) returns for his second year as head coach of the Locos. The former NFL Coach of the Year has led the Locos to a 9-3 all-time record in the UFL's brief history. Fassel was the NFL Coach of the Year in 1997 with the New York Giants, and he also led the Giants to the Super Bowl in 2000.

LAST TIME THEY MET

Las Vegas Locomotives 22, Omaha Nighthawks 10

In the first matchup in Week 4 at Sam Boyd Stadium, Las Vegas bested Omaha, 22-10. The Nighthawks were ahead 10-3 early in the second quarter, but the Locos scored the game's final 19 points to go on to the win. Las Vegas running back DeDe Dorsey was the difference maker, accounting for 148 combined rushing and receiving yards.

The game was one where the defenses stood tallest. Both teams combined for just 523 yards and two touchdowns on offense, and they combined for four turnovers. Las Vegas cornerback Isaiah Trufant tied a league record with two interceptions, including one for a touchdown. Omaha linebacker Patrick Thomas had 12 total tackles and a tackle for loss.

BREAKING THE CENTURY MARK

In the 19-14 win over the Hartford Colonials on Oct. 16, the Nighthawks went over 100 yards rushing as a team for the first time this season, totaling 101 yards on 29 attempts. Ahman Green led the way with a season-high 76 yards on 16 carries. Maurice Clarett added 10 yards to the cause.

BALLHAWKS

After recording just one interception in their first three games of the season, the Nighthawks' defense piled it on against Hartford with three interceptions. Clinton Hart and Calvin Lowry had interception returns of 23 and 19 yards, respectively. But none was bigger than Alex Lewis's 39-yard interception return in the fourth quarter that set up the Nighthawks' game-winning touchdown.

HAPPY TRAILS

For the third time in four games, the Nighthawks entered the locker room at halftime trailing. Hartford held a 14-7 lead at the break, but the Nighthawks rallied in the second half with 12 unanswered points. In its three wins this season, Omaha has outscored its opponents 37-16 in the second half.

PLAYING WITH HART

Free safety Clinton Hart filled in nicely in his second start of the season in place of the injured Aaron Rouse. Hart recorded a game-high nine tackles, including one tackle for a two-yard loss. Hart also made his first interception of the season, returning a Josh McCown pass 23 yards.

SOLVING MCCOWN

The Nighthawks apparently learned a thing or two from watching film of Hartford quarterback Josh McCown. McCown gave the Nighthawks' defense fits in the season opener, going 22-for-25 for 264 yards, two touchdowns and no interceptions. Facing McCown for the second time this season, the Nighthawks had him figured out. Omaha forced McCown into 13-of-26 passing for 142 yards, two touchdowns and three interceptions. The Nighthawks also sacked McCown once.

NEW LOOK LOCOS

Las Vegas will be without quarterback Tim Rattay, who led the Locos to a 3-1 record before rupturing his right Achilles tendon. Rattay, who will miss the rest of the season, will be replaced by Drew Willy, who went 18-of-29 for 191 yards and one touchdown in leading Las Vegas to a 24-21 overtime win against Hartford in his first start.

KEY MATCHUP NO. 1: *Omaha quarterback Jeff Garcia vs. Las Vegas cornerback Isaiah Trufant*

Trufant had those two interceptions in the first meeting, and has a league-high four so far this season. Garcia has thrown just four interceptions in four games so far this season - just slightly more than the number of fourth-quarter game-winning touchdown passes he's tossed in 2010 (three).

KEY MATCHUP NO. 2: *Las Vegas running back DeDe Dorsey vs. Omaha linebacker Patrick Thomas*

In the Week 6 overtime victory at home vs. Hartford, Dorsey nearly broke his own UFL single-game rushing record, gaining 132 yards and adding a touchdown on just 20 carries. Thomas has 21 total tackles in the last two games from his linebacker position.
