December 17, 2004 at Arrowhead Pond – Game #29, Home #11

Tonight's Game

The Cincinnati Mighty Ducks face-off against the Edmonton Road Runners, the AHL affiliate of the Edmonton Oilers, in the first of a two-game series at the Arrowhead Pond...Cincinnati and Edmonton wrap up the two-game series in Anaheim Saturday, December 18 at 5:00 p.m. (PST).

DUCKS/ROAD RUNNERS – Tonight's game is the third of four meetings between the Ducks and Edmonton in 2004-05 and the first of two games to be played at the Arrowhead Pond...the series is tied 1-1-0-0 following the Ducks' 1-0 win December 4 in Edmonton in the last meeting...the teams will face-off against each other Saturday, December 18 at the Arrowhead Pond to wrap up the four-game season series...following is the game-by-game schedule for the Cincinnati vs. Edmonton games in 2004-05:

December 15, Cincinnati 5 at Chicago 4: Joel Perrault scored with 59 seconds remaining in overtime, as the Mighty Ducks defeated the Chicago Wolves, 5-4, at Allstate Arena...Joffrey Lupul had two goals and an assist for Cincinnati, which rallied from a three-goal third-period deficit en route to its first overtime win this season...Alexei Smirnov and Michael Holmqvist also scored for the Ducks, who improved to 2-1-0-0 in their last three games...Frederic Cassivi stopped 21 shots to record his first win since October 30...Brad Larsen had two goals for the Wolves, who snapped a four-game winning streak...Michael Garnett surrendered three goals on 38 shots before being pulled in favor of Scott Fankhouser in the third period...Fankhouser gave up two goals on 11 shots in 12:25 minutes to take the loss.

December 12, Cincinnati 1 at Cleveland 5 – Ryane Clowe had two goals and two assists to lead the Cleveland Barons to a 5-1 victory over the Mighty Ducks at Gund Arena...Christian Erhoff, Shane Joseph and Craig Valette also scored for the Barons, who snapped a three-game losing streak...Dimitri Patzold turned aside 38 shots in the win...Joel Stepp was credited with the lone goal for the Ducks, who went 0-for-9 on the power play...Mathieu Chouinard surrendered four goals on 26 shots in the losing effort.

December 11, Cleveland 0 at Cincinnati 1 – Casey Hankinson scored a second-period goal and Mathieu Chouinard stopped 37 shots as the Mighty Ducks blanked the Cleveland Barons 1-0 ...Hankinson netted the only goal of the game 6:08 into the middle period...Chouinard stopped 13 shots in the first period, nine shots in the second period and 15 more in the third en route to his 11th career shutout and seventh in the AHL...Nolan Schaefer stopped 30 shots in the loss.

December 10, Grand Rapids 3 at Cincinnati 2 – Joey MacDonald made 36 saves, and Niklas Kronwall had two assists to help the Grand Rapids Griffins defeat the Mighty Ducks, 3-2...Eric Manlow, Ernie Hartlieb and Darryl Bootland scored for the Griffins, who won for the sixth time in seven games...Chris Kunitz had a pair of power-play goals for Cincinnati, which fell to 0-2-0-2 against Grand Rapids this season...Frederic Cassivi surrendered three goals on 16 shots before being pulled in favor of Mathieu Chouinard in the second period...Chouinard, called up earlier in the day from ECHL San Diego, stopped all 13 shots he faced in 33 minutes.

December 4, Cincinnati 1 at Edmonton 0 – Kurtis Foster scored a second-period goal and Ilya Bryzgalov made 27 saves as the Mighty Ducks blanked the Edmonton Road Runners, 1-0, at Rexhall Place...the victory snapped a franchise-record 11-game road skid (0-10-0-1)...Bryzgalov stopped five shots in the first period, nine shots in the second period and 13 more in the third en route to his first shutout of the season and the 12th of his career...Jeff Drouin-Deslauriers turned aside 21 shots in the losing effort.

Cincinnati Mighty Ducks Team Notes

QUICKLY – The Ducks are 10-16-0-2 for 22 points and in sixth place in the seven-team West Division...they are 3-2-0-0 in their last games after losing four straight November 28-December 3 (0-3-0-1)...are 5-14-0-2 since their record stood at 5-2-0-0 on October 30...were a season-high three games over .500 at 4-1-0-0 and 5-2-0-0...at 9-16-0-2 were a season-low seven games below .500 for the third time this season (also at 8-15-0-2 and 7-14-0-2)...were 11-13-4-0 after 28 games last season (12-13-4-0 after 29).

DUCKS AT THE POND – The Ducks are 0-0-0-1 at the Arrowhead Pond this season...they earned one point in the standings with a 4-3 shootout loss November 24 vs. Grand Rapids in the first of three regular-season games the squad is scheduled to play at the Pond this season.

PLAYING AT HOME – Entering tonight's action, the Ducks have produced a 5-4-0-1 home record...they have won two of their last three games played at Cincinnati Gardens.

WHO LET THE DUCKS OUT? – After scoring just 11 goals in eight games from November 27-December 12, the Ducks erupted for a season-high five goals December 15 at Chicago...the last time Cincinnati scored as many as five goals in a game prior to December 15 was on March 26, 2004, when the squad lit the lamp five times vs. Chicago, a span of 37 games.

DRINKS ALL AROUND – The Ducks have scored on three of their last four power-play chances after scoring on just three of 70 man-advantage opportunities November 19-December 15...the club matched a season-high with three power-play tallies December 15 at Chicago.

THIRTY SOMETHING – The Ducks accrued a season-high 49 shots December 15 at Chicago, marking the fourth straight game the club has recorded 30 shots or more...the Ducks went seven consecutive games without reaching the 30-shot plateau November 26-December 4 prior to their current string of 30's.

HORSESHOES AND HAND GRENADES – The Ducks are 9-11-0-2 in games decided by two goals or less, including 2-7-0-0 in two-goal games...they have gone 6-5-0-2 in one-goal games, but have won three of their last four one-goal decisions (3-1-0-0).

LET'S SHOOT FOR IT – The Ducks are 2-2 in overtime shootouts this season...are 1-1 at home and 1-1 on the road in games decided by a shootout.

WHEN LUPUL'S BEEN ON, SO HAVE THE DUCKS – The Ducks have had their best success when right wing Joffrey Lupul has had an offensive presence...the Ducks are 4-0-0-0 this season when he's scored a goal and 6-4-0-1 when he earns at least one point...additionally, the club has posted a 5-0-0-0 record in Lupul's team-leading four multiple-point games this season.

HE MUST BE BUTTER BECAUSE HE'S ON A ROLL – Defenseman Kurtis Foster has recorded points (1-4-5) in four of his last five games and seven of his last 12 (1-7-8)...he ranks first among club defensemen in points (12), goals (three), assists (nine) and shots (56)...Foster needs one more point for 100 in his career and two more points for 100 in the AHL.

I AM AMUSED BY THE SIMPLICITY OF THIS GAME – Goaltender Mathieu Chouinard has posted a .947 save percentage in three games since being called up December 10 from ECHL San Diego, stopping 72 of the 76 shots he has faced...he didn't allow a goal in his first two games in a Cincinnati uniform, stopping all 13 shots he faced in relief December 10 vs. Grand Rapids, followed by 37 saves in a 1-0 win December 11 vs. Cleveland.

MOVIN' ON UP – Defenseman Mark Popovic has made 175 career appearances in a Cincinnati uniform...the third-year pro ranks fourth on the club's all-time list in games played, four behind Marc Chouinard, who made a total of 179 appearances from 1997-2001, for third on the list.

BRYZGALOV GRABS EUROPEAN VACATION – Cincinnati goaltender Ilya Bryzgalov was loaned December 9 to the Russian Federation for the Rosno Cup tournament in Moscow this week...the Rosno Cup pits host Russia, Finland, Sweden and the Czech Republic in a battle of European powerhouses December 16-19...Bryzgalov will miss six games during his sabbatical.

WHAT'S IN A NAME – Cincinnati is one of five AHL teams that has adopted the same nickname as its NHL parent club...Cincinnati, the top affiliate for the Mighty Ducks of Anaheim, joins the Binghamton Senators (Ottawa Senators), Providence Bruins (Boston Bruins), St. John's Maple Leafs (Toronto Maple Leafs) and Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Penguins (Pittsburgh Penguins) as AHL teams using the same nickname as its parent club.
