TODAY'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds continue a six-game road trip against at the Indianapolis Indians at Victory Field. Right-handed pitcher Tommy Parsons is slated to start for Memphis opposite left-handed pitcher Kent Emanuel. First pitch for game five of the series is scheduled for 6:05p.m. CDT.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Memphis Redbirds continued a six-game road trip against the Indianapolis Indians on Friday night with a 2-1 loss at Victory Field. With the Ione Memphis run scoring on a double play in the fourth inning, the Redbirds were unable to put much traffic on the basepaths. In total, Memphis registered two hits and drew four walks while the team struck out 12 times. In a bullpen day, the Redbirds pitching staff dominated Indian bats. In a spot start, Andrew Suarez tossed a scoreless 4.0 innings of work, allowed three hits and struck out three batters. Both Indianapolis runs scored in the fifth inning. With the loss Memphis falls to a season worst three games under .500. MLB Rehabber Tyler O'Neill went 1-for-2 with a walk in his third appearance of the current MLB Rehab Assignment as he works back from a back injury.

AGAINST INDIANAPOLIS: The Memphis Redbirds took five of six against the Indianapolis Indians during a series at AutoZone Park back in April. During the series, the Memphis pitching staff dominated, posting a 3.83 ERA in 54.0 innings pitched while striking out 57 batters and walking just 11. Gordon Graceffo had a tremendous start in the series, going 6.0 innings, allowed two runs on five hits, walked one and struck out six batters to earn the win. Offensively, Memphis posted a .259 batting average. Catcher Ivan Herrera led the way as he posted a .364 batting average in three games in the series. Tres Barrera and Juniel Querecuto each clubbed two home runs in the series. In total, Memphis hit 11 homers and drove in 42 runs in the series. Indianapolis scored just 24 runs in the six-game set.

O'NEILL REHAB: St. Louis Cardinals outfielder Tyler O'Neill begins a MLB Rehab Assignment with the Memphis Redbirds on July 4 at Indianapolis. The Canadian-born outfielder played 29 games with St. Louis to start the season before going down with a back injury. O'Neill has a Major Legaue batting average of .250 in parts of six seasons with the Cardinals. O'Neill has appeared in a game with Memphis in four seasons (2017-19, 2022), last with the Redbirds in 2022 as part of a pair of rehab assignments. In his career in Triple-A, the outfielder posts a .270 batting average with 69 home runs, 186 RBI and 244 hits in 240 games played.

BY THE NUMBERS



REDBIRD ROTATION: The starting pitching rotation for Memphis has had immense success at the minor league level. The five include three St. Louis Cardinals Minor League Pitchers of the Year (Hudson 2018, Liberatore 2021 and Graceffo 2022), the 2022 Arizona Fall League Pitcher of the Year (Connor Thomas) and the 2022 Cardinals minor league/International League wins leader (Tommy Parsons, 12). The most recent addition to the crew is No. 4 Cardinals prospect Michael McGreevy.

HAPPY 25th, REDBIRDS!: To commemorate the 25th anniversary season, the Memphis Redbirds will have a select number of giveaways centered around the club's past players and events. On Saturday May 20, the first 1,500 fans had the chance to celebrate 25 seasons of history with the original Memphis Redbirds jersey as worn by many greats including Albert Pujols, Adam Wainwright and more! In a further knod to the history of baseball in Memphis, on August 4, the first 1,500 fans will receive The blue Memphis Chicks jersey featuring the blue and red Memphis wordmark. The Redbirds will also wear Memphis Chicks jerseys every Thursday home game for Throwback Thursday.

TOP PROSPECTS IN MEMPHIS: As evident with the young success at the Major League level for the St. Louis Cardinals, Memphis plays a key role in development for the big club. Currently, 10 of MLB Pipeline's Top-30 prospects in the St. Louis Cardinals organization are currently playing in Memphis: Masyn Winn (1), Gordon Graceffo (3), Michael McGreevy (5), Ivan Herrera (6), Moises Gomez (11), Connor Thomas (14), Jake Walsh (21), Ryan Loutos (23), Guillermo Zuniga (27) and Luken Baker (30). Masyn Wynn (36) earned a slot in the current top-100 overall prospect list for MLB Pipeline. RHP Tink Hence (currently with Peoria) is also in the top-100 (58).

MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

Ben Johnson enters his fifth season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his fifth year in the Cardinals organization.

- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contension for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

• Marrero, 42, is beginning his 11th season in the Cardinals organization and first with Memphis.

COACHING CAREER

• Ten current members of the St. Louis Cardinals 40-man roster have come through Springfield since Marrero's tenure began in 2017. Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

PLAYING CAREER

• Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

• Clark is beginning his first season in the Cardinals organization and first with Memphis

COACHING CAREER

• In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles.In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

PLAYING CAREER

- Clark played parts of six seasons in MLB with the Baltimore Orioles, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays from 2002 to 2008.
- Clark batted .262 with three home runs and 26 RBI in his career

TODAY'S START: Tommy Parsons will make his 14th start and 16th appearance of the season in game five of the series against the Indianapolis Indians.

LAST TIME OUT: The right-handed pitcher tossed 5.0 innings in game six of the series against Nashville. Parsons allowed two runs and broke a streak of six consecutive starts with a HR allowed.. Parsons allowed seven hits, walked three and struck out three.

FINDING THE GROOVE: Last sesaon, The fourth-year Cardinal minor leaguer found significant success in May and June, nearly cutting his ERA in half across those two months after the end of April (8.18 to 4.17) and lowered his WHIP by 0.50 over that span (from 1.55 to 1.05). Batters are also hit 72 points lower over the span, which has coincided with an increase in workload, making three starts and appearing in long relief (>2.0 IP) three other times.

STARTING VS RELIEVING: Parsons has mainly been used out of the bullpen after reaching Triple-A in 2021, totaling 37 relief appearances and 23 starts. Last year as a starter, Parsons went 1-5 with a 6.94 ERA in 9 starts while posting a 1-1 record and a 4.00 ERA in 15 bullpen outings. This season, Parsons is 6-0 with a 4.04 ERA as a reliever and 0-2 with a 4.74 ERA in four starts.

HIT HIM, I DARE YOU: Last season, In his fourth season of professional ball and his second season at Triple-A, nearly a third of the righthander's strikeouts this season came in June (25 strikeouts). He also held opponents to just a .182 batting average this season and held a 0.99 WHIP in the month. In May, the right-handed pitcher posted a .174 batting average against and a crazy low 0.75 WHIP, each his best numbers in any month this season.

QUICK RISE: Parsons went undrafted in 2018 out of Adrian College (DIII) and was going to tryout for the independent Gateway Grizzlies when he got a phone call from Cardinals' area scout Jason Bryans offering him a tryout. A day later, he drove from his home in Ohio down to Johnson City, where he made 13 outings and went 5-1 with a 3.00 ERA. That year, he won Johnson City's Starting Pitcher of the Year award. The following year, Parsons spanned four levels in the Cardinals organization and earned the Midwest League Player of the Month for April 2019. Two years after he was signed by St. Louis as an undrafted free agent, Parsons was invited to big league spring training and was ranked as the organization's 21st best prospect by MLB.com.

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Signed as a non-drafted free agent in 2018 out of Adrian College... In 44 career starts, went 40-4 with a 2.21 ERA and 24 complete games... Three-time Michigan IAA Pitcher of the Year winner...Went to New Albany, HS located outside of Columbus, OH.
