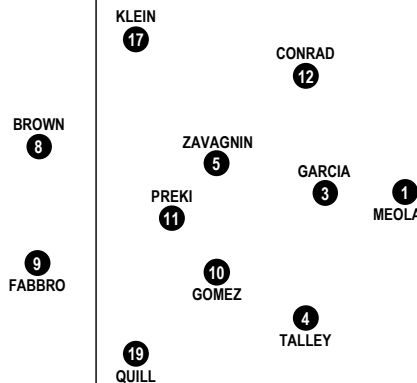

PREVIEW OF TODAY'S MATCH

The Kansas City Wizards will travel to our Nation's capital to face D.C. United in the second of three meetings in 2003. Kansas City and D.C. United will square off on Saturday, May 17th at 6:30 p.m. and will be broadcast live on Fox Sports World. The Wizards beat D.C. in overtime in the season opener at Arrowhead Stadium. Kansas City will also look to snap a seven game winless streak against D.C. United at RFK Stadium (0-5-2). The Wizards last road win against D.C. came on August 4, 1996.

D.C. is still looking for their first win in 2003 after posting a 0-2-3 record through the first five games of the season. United has just three goals scored in their five matches, tied for the lowest total in MLS, while the Wizards have scored a league leading 12 goals this season. United has gone 283 minutes without scoring dating back to April 26th when Marco Etcheverry found the back of the net in the 7th minute in Colorado.

The Wizards have scored the first goal in all six matches this season and have six players with at least one goal on the season. Preki continues his record scoring pace after assisting on the Wizards lone goal on Wednesday. The assist was Preki's 230th career MLS point and it came in his 200th career MLS appearance.

Kansas City's newest addition Alex Zotinca, who was signed on Wednesday afternoon and made his MLS debut just hours later, will likely get more playing time this weekend with the Wizards rash of injuries. Defender Jose Luis Burciaga is out for the year with a torn ACL and Diego Gutierrez missed Wednesday's match with back spasms. Zotinca can play both defensively and in the midfield and adds loads of experience at the age of 26, having already appeared in the UEFA Cup in his young career.

D.C. UNITED NOTES

- * D.C. United has scored just three goals in five games this season. All three D.C. goals have come on the road.
- * Entering Saturday's match, D.C. United has not scored in 283 minutes of play. Their last goal came in the 7th minute on April 26th in Colorado.
- * United has conceded 39 goals in the all-time series with the Wizards, the second most goals they have given up against an MLS team (MetroStars - 44).
- * Only two players remain on the D.C. United roster from their 1999 MLS Cup Championship team - Marco Etcheverry and Ben Olsen. That was also the last time D.C. United has appeared in the postseason.

CURRENT WIZARDS NOTABLES



Last Match (5/14 vs. NE)

- * The Wizards lead the all-time series against the Revolution 10-6-1 and lead 6-2-1 all-time at Arrowhead Stadium.
- * Kansas City has outscored New England 27-20 in the all-time series.
- * Before Wednesday's match, the Wizards had won the last five meetings between the two sides, outscoring the Revs 12-5 in that stretch. The last time Kansas City lost to New England was a 1-0 decision at Arrowhead on July 19, 2000.
- * Revs forward Joe-Max Moore made his return to MLS this season after spending the past three seasons with Everton in Europe. Despite his three-year absence from the Revs, he remains the team's all-time leading scorer with 103 points (38g, 27a).
- * Preki made his 200th career MLS appearance on Wednesday, becoming just the fifth player in league history to appear in 200 matches.
- * The Wizards signed defender Alex Zoticca on Wednesday and he made his MLS debut just hours later, playing the final 15 minutes.

vs. Opponent (5/17 at DC)

- * The Wizards lead the all-time series against D.C. 9-8-2, but trail 2-5-2 all-time at RFK Stadium.
- * The Wizards captured their first ever regular season overtime victory against D.C. in a 3-2 win on April 12, 2003 in the season opener. Chris Brown notched the game-winning goal.
- * Kansas City won the season series 2-1-1 last year, including winning both matches at Arrowhead Stadium. Kansas City outscored D.C. 5-3 in four meetings in 2002.
- * Wizards midfielder Preki is ranked second all-time in MLS with 96 career assists. D.C. midfielder Marco Etcheverry is ranked third all-time 95 career assists.
- * Kansas City is winless in their last seven matches against D.C. at RFK Stadium, going 0-5-2 in that stretch. Their last win on the road to D.C. came on August 4, 1996, a 4-2 win.
- * The Wizards most historic victory in team history came at RFK Stadium on October 15, 2000 when they captured the 2000 MLS Cup with a 1-0 win over the Chicago Fire.

Individual Marks

- * Preki is tied for second in the league in scoring with 7 points (2g, 3a).
- * With an assist on Wednesday, Preki extended his all-time leading scoring total to 230 points (67g, 96a). He now stands 6 points ahead of Jason Kreis (224) for the all-time lead.
- * Chris Brown and Eric Quill are tied for fifth in the league in scoring with 5 points each (2g, 1a).
- * Preki's 96 career assists ranks him second all-time in MLS history.
- * Tony Meola is the all-time League leader in shutouts (44) and saves (793).
- * Preki is ranked 5th all-time in MLS in games played (200), games started (194) and 4th all-time with 17,241 minutes played.
- * Chris Brown has now appeared in 68 consecutive regular season matches for the Wizards (entering Wednesday's match). The last regular season game he missed was August 12, 2000. His 68 consecutive games is the longest current streak in MLS.
- * The Wizards record for consecutive games played is held by Mark Chung who appeared in 74 consecutive matches from 1996 to 1998.

Team Marks

- * Through the first seven weeks of the season, Kansas City leads the league in scoring with 12 goals.
- * Eight of the Wizards 12 goals this season have come at Arrowhead Stadium.
- * The Wizards have scored the first goal in all six games this season and have scored more than one goal in four of their six matches.
- * Kansas City has scored three goals in the opening 15 minutes this season, more than any other team in MLS.
- * Kansas City is the only team to post an overtime victory so far in 2003.
- * With their win in the April 12th season opener, the Wizards improved to 4-3-1 in season openers and 6-1-1 in their first home game of the season (the Wizards opened the season at home in 1996, 1997, 2000 and 2002).
