Earthquakes 1, United 0; Sunday, August 24, 2003 Spartan Stadium; San Jose, Calif.

The San Jose Earthquakes maintained the best record in Major League Soccer and stretched their unbeaten streak to six games with a 1-0 win over D.C. United at Spartan Stadium. A goal by Ramiro Corrales in the 80th minute was all the offense the Earthquakes would need as goalkeeper Pat Onstad set a new Earthquakes club record with his ninth shutout of the season. San Jose controlled much of the early part of the game and had its best scoring opportunity of the first half in the 31st minute following a nice attack up the right side of the field. Midfielder Chris Ronér found Richard Mulrooney on the sideline about 25 yards away from the United goal. Mulrooney sent a deft pass through the D.C. defense to Landon Donovan inside the penalty box. Donovan took on a United defender and moved to his left before firing a shot toward the goal that skimmed off the crossbar. D.C. put some pressure on the Earthquakes net to start the second half in the 48th minute when Ronald Cerritos sent a cross in front of the San Jose goal mouth to a sliding Alecko Eskandarian, who knocked it wide of the goal. San Jose picked up the offensive pressure in the 62nd minute as Dwayne De Rosario, who came on for an injured Brian Mullan in 23rd minute, moved the ball up the right sideline. When the ball got away from him it went straight to Todd Dunivant, who launched the ball into the D.C. penalty box where Donovan ran onto it and tried to put it past a sliding Rimando. However, Rimando knocked the ball out of bounds. The Earthquakes took the lead in the 80th minute on Corrales' first goal of the season. Ronér deflected a United clearance to De Rosario about 25 yards in front of the D.C. goal. De Rosario took the ball into the right of the box and sent a low ball across the middle of the United goal past Rimando and several United defenders. A wide-open Corrales knocked the ball into the net for the 1-0 lead.

Earthquakes 2, Revolution 1; Sunday, September 7, 2003 Spartan Stadium; San Jose, Calif.

The San Jose Earthquakes recovered from a 1-0 deficit with goals from Dwayne De Rosario and Landon Donovan to earn a 2-1 win over the New England Revolution at Spartan Stadium. With the win, the Quakes now lead the Western Conference by nine points with seven games remaining in the regular season. San Jose also leads Major League Soccer with 43 points. Brian Mullan notched his team-leading eighth assist of the season and Donovan scored his fourth game-winning goal of 2003 early in the second half. The Revolution struck first in the 41st minute on a goal by Pat Noonan. Steve Ralston controlled the ball in midfield and then slotted a ball through for Noonan to the left of Quakes goalkeeper Pat Onstad. As Onstad came out to cut off the angle, Noonan pushed the ball past Onstad into the empty net for a 1-0 lead. The Quakes responded one minute later as De Rosario netted his first goal of the season on a pass from Mullan. Jeff Agoos found Mullan on the right wing and Mullan beat Joey Franchino before sending a low cross to De Rosario in front of the net. De Rosario took a touch and sent the ball past Brown into the upper part of the net to even the game at 1-1. Seven minutes into the second half, Donovan netted the game-winner from 10 yards out. De Rosario started the play by finding Ramiro Corrales, who then served a ball from the left wing to the back post to Donovan. Donovan powered a header on goal but Brown made the save. The rebound fell to Ekelund and he tipped it to Donovan, who slotted the ball past Brown. The Revolution went down a man in the 83rd minute after an altercation between Rusty Pierce and Mullan. Mullan came in hard and fouled Pierce and the Revolution defender retaliated by throwing Mullan to the ground. Mullan was shown a yellow card, while Pierce received his second yellow and was sent off.

"We are disappointed that we will not be able to play this game," Earthquakes General Manager Johnny Moore said. "Due to injuries on both teams as well as other factors, both parties felt that the best decision was to postpone the match. We do have a great international match between the Earthquakes and Chivas next month and we look forward to playing El Salvador at a later date."

Quakes vs. Chivas

The San Jose Earthquakes will host legendary Mexican club Chivas de Guadalajara at Spartan Stadium in the Copa El Mexicano on Tuesday, October 14 at 8:00 p.m. PT. Tickets for the October 14 game are on sale now. Advanced ticket prices for the Earthquakes vs. Chivas game are \$45, \$30 and \$25. Tickets can be purchased by visiting the Earthquakes Ticket Office at 3550 Stevens Creek Blvd., by logging on to www.sjearthquakes.com, or by calling Ticketmaster at 408-998-TIXS, 415-421-TIXS, 510-625-TIXS, 925-685-TIXS, or by visiting any Ticketmaster outlet, including Tower Records, Rite Aid, and Ritmo Latino. Founded in 1906, Chivas has always held true to its tradition of fielding only all-Mexican lineups as the team has captured 10 Mexican and one CONCACAF Champions Cup trophies in its storied history. Chivas last played at Spartan Stadium on March 6, 2002 in a 1-1 tie against La Piedad. San Jose and Chivas have faced each other on one previous occasion, battling to a 1-1 tie at Civic Stadium in Portland, Oregon on May 5, 1998.

Onstad Wins Los Gatos Brewing Company Player of The Month Award

San Jose Earthquakes goalkeeper Pat Onstad has been selected as the Los Gatos Brewing Company Earthquakes Player Of The Month for the month of August. The team also announced that Landon Donovan's volley against the Dallas Burn on August 13 was selected as the Earthquakes Goal of the Month. Onstad led the Quakes to a 3-1-1 record in the month of August to help them to a nine-point lead on top of the Western Conference. Behind Onstad's play the Quakes became the first team to clinch a playoff spot in 2003 as he posted three shutouts in five games to give him a league-leading nine for the season. Onstad broke the San Jose club record for shutouts in a season on August 24 with a 1-0 shutout of D.C. United. In the month, Onstad allowed just three goals in five matches for a 0.59 goals against average.

De Ro Strikes Back

Earthquakes forward Dwayne De Rosario scored his first MLS goal of the 2003 season on Sunday against the New England Revolution in the 42nd minute. De Rosario entered the game as a substitute for an injured Manny Lagos in the 31st minute and scored off a fine pass from Brian Mullan. It was De Rosario's first goal in league play since July 20, 2002. The Canadian forward has played in five games this season since recovering from a torn LCL in his right knee suffered in April.

Getting Physical

Earthquakes midfielder Ronnie Ekelund was whistled for seven fouls Sunday against New England, tying a club record for most fouls in a game. The record was set by Manny Lagos on May 26, 2001 against the Chicago Fire.

Cautions

If Ramiro Corrales or Brian Mullan receives a yellow card worth three or more caution points in their next MLS match, they will be suspended for the following game due to caution points accumulation.

Road Warriors

The Earthquakes currently own the best road record in MLS. The Quakes 6-1-4 mark and .727 winning percentage is tops in the league and equals the club season record for road wins (6), set in 1996 and equaled in 1997. San Jose has only allowed 10 goals on the road this season, the fewest in the league when away.

Record Breaking Road Streak

By tying the New England Revolution on Aug. 16, the Quakes extended their road unbeaten streak to seven games, equaling the longest road unbeaten streak in MLS history, while breaking the club record streak of six games. The Quakes are tied with D.C. United (1999) and the Los Angeles Galaxy (1997-1998) for the longest road unbeaten streak in league history. The team will have a chance to set the record on September 13 against D.C. United.

Donovan Gets It Done

San Jose forward Landon Donovan moved into a tie with Eric Wynalda for second place on the Earthquakes all-time goal-scoring list with his game-winning strike on Sunday against New England. Donovan now has 21 career goals with San Jose in 58 games. Ronald Cerritos is the Earthquakes all-time leading goal-scorer with 55 career San Jose goals.

Playoffs Clinched

The Quakes became the first team in MLS to clinch a spot in the playoffs on August 30 despite their 2-1 loss to Colorado. The Los Angeles Galaxy defeated the Dallas Burn 2-1 to put the Quakes into the playoffs with eight games remaining. This is the earliest the

Quakes have clinched a playoff spot under Frank Yallop. In 1996, 2001 and 2002, the team clinched with five games remaining.

The Revolution Stops Here

Under head coach Frank Yallop, the Earthquakes are now 6-0-1 against the New England Revolution following Sunday's 2-1 win. The Revolution has not beaten the Quakes since a 2-1 win on July 22, 2000.

Racking Up The Points

The Quakes now have 43 points on the season, just two points shy of the club record for points in a season. The record of 45 points was set in 2001 and equaled in 2002.

Leading Scorers vs. D.C. United

Manny Lagos is the Quakes current leading scorer against D.C. United. Lagos has five goals and one assist for 11 points in six games vs. United as a member of the Earthquakes. In his career, which includes stints with Chicago, Tampa Bay, the MetroStars and San Jose, Lagos has scored six goals and recorded two assists in 12 career games vs. D.C. Lagos' six goals vs. United are more than he has scored against any other team. Also for the Earthquakes, Landon Donovan has two goals and one assist in five games vs. D.C.

Earthquakes - D.C. United Connections

San Jose defender Jeff Agoos played five seasons with D.C. United from 1996-2000, winning three MLS Cup titles...Earthquakes head coach Frank Yallop served as an assistant coach for D.C. United during the 2000 season...D.C. United forward Devin Barclay played with San Jose in 2002 before coming to D.C. prior to the 2003 season in exchange for the first pick in the 2003 Supplemental Draft, which resulted in Brian Ching, and a conditional pick in the 2005 MLS SuperDraft...D.C. United defender Ryan Nelson played at Stanford University in 1999 and 2000...D.C. United defender Brandon Prideaux played at the University of Washington in 1994-1997 with San Jose players Ian Russell and Craig Waibel...Newly acquired United forward Ronald Cerritos played in San Jose from 1997-2001 and is the club's all-time leading scorer.

History vs. D.C. United

D.C. United and San Jose appeared in the first MLS game in league history, with San Jose defeating D.C. 1-0 at Spartan Stadium on an Eric Wynalda goal. San Jose defender Jeff Agoos played in that game for D.C. United, while Earthquakes defender Troy Dayak played 90 minutes that day for San Jose...Earthquakes goalkeeper Jon Conway earned his first MLS win against D.C. United on August 19, 2000 in a 1-0 San Jose win...Earthquakes goalkeeper Pat Onstad set a new Earthquakes record for shutouts with his ninth shutout when he blanked D.C. United 1-0 on August 24.

Dangerous D.C. Players

Marco Etcheverry is D.C. United's active leading scorer against the Earthquakes with a goal and six assists in 14 games. Dema Kovalenko has scored two goals in seven games against San Jose, while Eliseo Quintanilla has also scored two goals in three matches.

Donovan Scores in New Month

Landon Donovan's goal against the New England Revolution last Sunday was his first MLS regular season goal in the month of September. With the goal, Donovan has now scored in every month of the regular season.

Dominating D.C.

The Earthquakes have lost just once to D.C. United in the teams' last ten games. San Jose is 7-1-2 in those games since the start of the 1999 season with their only loss coming to D.C. on August 31, 2002 in a 4-2 defeat at RFK Stadium.

Onstad Remains On Top

Earthquakes goalkeeper Pat Onstad remained the top goalkeeper in Major League Soccer, recording another win on Sunday. As he has for much of the season, Onstad leads the league in wins (12), shutouts (9), goals against average (0.83) and catch/punches (94). Onstad is third in MLS with a 77.2% save percentage.

Quick Notes

- -The Earthquakes are 9-2-0 in one-goal games in 2003
- -San Jose has the best defense in MLS, allowing just 24 goals against this season.
- -The Earthquakes lead MLS with 42 assists. San Jose has registered those 42 assists on just 34 goals.

Maximum Effort By Mullan

Earthquakes midfielder Brian Mullan is enjoying the best season of his three-year MLS career in 2003. Mullan has started and played in all 23 games for San Jose this season, registering career-highs in goals, assists and minutes played. In his two previous seasons with Los Angeles, Mullan scored a total of five goals and four assists in 1,828 minutes in 31 games. This season, Mullan already has six goals and eight assists for 20 points in 2,073 minutes. Mullan is now the eighth leading scorer in MLS and has the second highest assist total in the league, four behind leader Preki. Mullan is also riding a two-game point streak following his assist on Sunday against New England and his goal August 30 vs. Colorado.

Top 10

Landon Donovan's game-winning goal Sunday against New England gives him seven goals on the year, making him the ninth leading goal-scorer in MLS this season. Donovan is also tied for the lead in MLS with four game-winning goals. Donovan is also tied for ninth

in MLS with 19 points, trailing teammate Brian Mullan, who has 20 points. Mullan is tied for second in MLS with eight assists.

In September

San Jose has recorded a 15-16-0 record in the month of September in its history and a 3-3-0 record under Frank Yallop in the month.

Iron Quakes

Three members of the Earthquakes are amongst the league leaders in minutes played. Defender Jeff Agoos is fifth in the league with 2,133 minutes, while defender Todd Dunivant is seventh with 2,128 minutes played. Brian Mullan is ninth in MLS with 2,073 minutes played.

Halftime Success

If the Earthquakes enter the half-time break with the lead, recent history suggests they will keep it. Since the beginning of the 2000 season, the Earthquakes are 33-0-4 in games when leading at the half, including 6-0-1 this year.

Making The First One Count

The Earthquakes were 25-2-2 in 2001 and 2002 when finding the back of the net first. The Quakes only gave up leads two times last season, losing 2-1 to Los Angeles on July 4 and falling 2-1 to Kansas City on July 27. The team has continued that trend in 2003, possessing a 9-0-1 mark when they score the first goal this season. Dating back to the 2000 season, the Earthquakes own a 37-2-3 record in their last 42 matches when they score the first goal of the game.

Rookie Impact

Earthquakes rookie defender Todd Dunivant made history on July 2 against the MetroStars when he assisted on Brian Ching's goal in the 15th minute. The assist gave Dunivant six points in his rookie campaign, as he tied Wade Barrett for the Quakes rookie record for points in a season set in 1998. Dunivant has a goal and four assists in addition to shutting down some of the best attackers in MLS. Dunivant has made himself a leading candidate for Rookie of the Year with his strong play in the first 23 games of the season. Dunivant has started all 23 games for the Quakes, becoming the first San Jose rookie to ever start the first 23 games of his career. Dunivant was named the Earthquakes Los Gatos Brewing Company Player of the Month for April.
