The San Jose Earthquakes overcame a 1-0 halftime deficit to take a 2-1 lead early in the second half, before allowing three late goals to fall 4-2 against D.C. United at RFK Stadium. D.C. United got on the board first after a long run by Jaime Moreno set up Bobby Convey for the goal. Moreno took the ball from 40 yards out and dribbled into the penalty box before finding Convey. Convey controlled the ball and fired a low shot to the far post for the 1-0 lead in the 38th minute. The Quakes came out strong in the second half and evened the score with a brilliant Donovan strike in the 49th minute. Richard Mulrooney found Donovan on the left side with Eddie Pope on him. Donovan took the ball right at Pope and beat him to the right before firing home a near post shot to bring the Quakes into a 1-1 tie. Donovan came right back with a second goal to put the Quakes into the lead in the 58th minute. Midfielder Manny Lagos received a pass from Donovan and then played it back to the 20-year old forward as he was running at goal 30 yards out. Donovan split right the center of four United defenders and found himself in alone on Rimando, before slotting a low shot to the near post. D.C. tied the match in the 74th minute with a goal by Ryan Nelsen. Petter Villegas drove a free kick into the box from near midfield and the ball was flicked on to Nelsen, who tipped the ball in at the far post. Pope provided United's third goal in the 84th minute off a corner kick. Marco Etcheverry sent in the corner to Pope, who headed to the back post for the 3-2 lead. Minutes later, Villegas completed the scoring with a goal off a Quakes turnover. Moreno picked up the loose ball and dribbled into the Quakes 18-yard box, before tipping a pass to Villegas, who fired underneath Conway for the goal.

The San Jose Earthquakes six-game unbeaten streak came to an end Saturday night at Spartan Stadium as they fell 2-0 to the Colorado Rapids. The Rapids (5-8-3, 18 points) won their third straight game with a first half goal from Ritchie Kotschau and a second half strike from Mark Chung to send the Earthquakes (6-3-6, 24 points) to their first loss in seven games. The Rapids took the lead in the 34th minute on a goal from defender Ritchie Kotschau. Kotschau received a long pass on the left side of the field from Chris Carrieri and beat his defender after Brian Mullan slipped while pursuing him. Kotschau headed in on Conway and was able to place the ball above the sliding goalkeeper for a 1-0 Colorado lead. Colorado extended its lead to 2-0 just four minutes into the second half on a wicked one-time volley by Chung. Chung hammered a shot to the near-post past a diving Conway following a cross from the right side by Carrieri. The Earthquakes nearly got on the scoreboard in the 58th minute, as Lagos gathered a pass behind the Colorado defense and headed into the Rapids penalty box with just Garlick to beat, but his shot was deflected by the sliding goalkeeper.

Quakes Six Game Unbeaten Streak Snapped; Three-Game Road Unbeaten Streak Alive

The Earthquakes had their six-game unbeaten streak snapped last Saturday against the Colorado Rapids in a 2-0 defeat. However, Frank Yallop's squad still has one unbeaten streak to build on. Against D.C. United on Saturday, the Quakes will attempt to extend their road unbeaten streak to four games. The team has gone 1-0-2 in its last three road matches. The team record road unbeaten streak is six games, set in 2001 from April 28 – June 16. The Earthquakes currently own the best road record in MLS. The Quakes 3-1-3 mark and .643 winning percentage is tops in the league.

Scoreless at Home

For the first time in team history, the Earthquakes have been shutout in three consecutive games at home. The team has not scored at Spartan Stadium since the 77th minute of its match against the Columbus Crew on June 21, a total of 303 minutes.

Levesque Makes MLS Debut

Roger Levesque made the first MLS appearance of his career, entering as a substitute last Saturday against the Colorado Rapids in San Jose and logging 22 minutes. He has been out of action all season after tearing the ACL in his right knee in January. The Quakes drafted Levesque in the third round of the 2003 MLS SuperDraft.

Donovan and Mulrooney Help United States Advance In Gold Cup

The San Jose Earthquakes' Landon Donovan started and played the full 90 minutes in the U.S. National Team's 2-0 victory over El Salvador in the Group C opener of the CONCACAF Gold Cup last Saturday in Foxborough, Mass. Earthquakes midfielder Richard Mulrooney, who is also on the Gold Cup roster, did not see any action in the match. On Monday, July 14, the U.S. continued its winning ways with a 2-0 victory over Martinique to put them into the quarterfinals. Both Donovan and Mulrooney started and played the entire match for the U.S. Mulrooney helped create the U.S.' first goal by setting up Steve Ralston, who found Brian McBride for the goal. The U.S. now plays Cuba at 3:00 p.m. ET on Saturday, July 19 at Gillette Stadium.

Pat's Gone Golden

Earthquakes goalkeeper Pat Onstad spent the last two weeks with the Canadian National Team for the CONCACAF Gold Cup. Onstad has appeared 37 times for Canada since 1988, last playing for Canada on June 1 in a 4-1 loss to Germany. Onstad served as the backup goalkeeper, as the Canadian National Team defeated Costa Rica 1-0 in their first match of Gold Cup play on July 12 at Gillette Stadium in Foxborough, Mass. He was also the backup goalkeeper as the Canadians dropped their second match of group play 2-0 to Cuba. Due to Costa Rica's 3-0 win over Cuba, Canada finished third and was eliminated in the group stage. Onstad joined his teammates in D.C. for Saturday night's match.

Four at a Time

Last Saturday against the Rapids, Frank Yallop had four rookies in the line-up at the same time, as Arturo Alvarez, Todd Dunivant, Roger Levesque and Jamil Walker all shared the field in the second half. That is the first time in San Jose club history that four rookies have been on the field at the same time.

Waibel and Agoos Seeing Yellow

If Earthquakes defender Craig Waibel receives a yellow card worth two points or more on Saturday against D.C. United, Waibel will be suspended for the Quakes next match. Earthquakes defender Jeff Agoos will also be suspended if he receives a yellow card worth three or more points in his next game.

Alvarez on National Duty

Quakes rookie Arturo Alvarez has a busy stretch in the next two weeks, as he will represent his country at two different levels. Following the Quakes-D.C. United match on Saturday, Alvarez will travel to Northern Ireland, where he will join the U.S. Under-18 team for the Northern Ireland Milk Cup. At the conclusion of that tournament, Alvarez will travel directly to Houston, Texas to play for the U.S. Under-20 national team from July 26 – August 3 at the USASA Soccer Festival. Alvarez will miss the Quakes match on Saturday, July 26 against the Dallas Burn.

San Jose – D.C. United History

D.C. United and San Jose appeared in the first MLS game in league history, with San Jose defeating D.C. 1-0 at Spartan Stadium on an Eric Wynalda goal. San Jose defender Jeff Agoos played in that game for D.C. United, while Earthquakes defender Troy Dayak played 90 minutes that day for San Jose...Earthquakes goalkeeper Jon Conway earned his first MLS win and first MLS shutout against D.C. United on August 19, 2000 in a 1-0 San Jose win.

San Jose – D.C. United Connections

San Jose defender Jeff Agoos played five seasons with D.C. United from 1996-2000, winning three MLS Cup titles...Earthquakes head coach Frank Yallop served as an assistant coach to D.C. United during the 2000 season...D.C. United forward Devin Barclay played with San Jose in 2002 before coming to D.C. prior to the 2003 season in exchange for the first pick in the 2003 Supplemental

Draft, which resulted in Brian Ching, and a conditional pick in the 2005 MLS SuperDraft...D.C. United defender Ryan Nelson played at Stanford University in 1999 and 2000...D.C. San Jose Leaders Against D.C. United

Manny Lagos is the Earthquakes active leading scorer against D.C. United. Lagos has scored five goals and registered two assists in 12 career matches against United. Landon Donovan has two goals and one assist in four games against D.C., while Ronnie Ekelund has two goals in three career games vs. United.

D.C. United Leaders vs. San Jose

Marco Etcheverry is D.C. United's active leading scorer against the Earthquakes with a goal and six assists in 13 games. Dema Kovalenko has scored two goals in seven games against San Jose, while Eliseo Quintanilla has also scored two goals in two matches.

In July

In the month of July, San Jose teams have traditionally struggled, posting a 14-21-2 record in their history prior to 2003. The Quakes have a 0-1-2 record in the month in 2003.

Working Overtime

Earthquakes Jeff Agoos, Todd Dunivant, and Brian Mullan are among the league's leaders in minutes played. They have each logged 1,410 minutes on the field.

Onstad Is On

Earthquakes goalkeeper Pat Onstad is enjoying a successful season and is now one of the top-rated net minders in MLS. Onstad leads the league in goals against average (0.95), wins (6) and shutouts (5). He also boasts a 76.8% save percentage, good for second best in the league

Sharing The Ball

San Jose currently shares the MLS lead in assists with 26 assists on 20 goals in 2003.

Waiting Until the Last Minute

The Earthquakes have scored six goals in the final 15 minutes of games in 2003, putting together the second-highest late goal total in MLS. San Jose has allowed five goals in the last 15 minutes of games.

Some Like It Close

The Earthquakes 5-1-0 record in one-goal games in 2003 is the best record in MLS matches decided by one-goal.

The Yallop Watch

Earthquakes head coach Frank Yallop reached 33 wins for his career in San Jose with the teams win against the Columbus Crew on June 21. Yallop is now just two wins away from the club record of 35 held by Brian Quinn, who coached parts of three seasons from 1997-99.

Hitting The Century Mark

The Earthquakes 2-1 win against Columbus on June 21 was the 99th victory in team history. The Quakes can record the 100th win in club history with a win against D.C. United on July 19.

Halftime Success

If the Earthquakes enter the half-time break with the lead, recent history suggests they will keep it. Since the 2000 season, the Earthquakes are 30-0-3 in games when leading at the half.

Making The First One Count

The Earthquakes were 25-2-2 in 2001 and 2002 when finding the back of the net first. The Quakes only gave up leads two times last season, losing 2-1 to Los Angeles on July 4 and falling 2-1 to Kansas City on July 27. The team has continued that trend in 2003, possessing a 5-0-0 mark when they score the first goal this season. Dating back to the 2000 season, the Earthquakes own a 33-2-2 record in their last 37 matches when they score the first goal of the game.

Rookie Impact

Earthquakes rookie defender Todd Dunivant made history on July 5 against the MetroStars when he assisted on Brian Ching's goal in the 15th minute. The assist gave Dunivant six points in his rookie campaign, as he tied Wade Barrett for the Quakes rookie record for points in a season set in 1998. Dunivant has a goal and four assists in addition to shutting down some of the best attackers in MLS. Dunivant has made himself a leading candidate for Rookie of the Year with his strong play in the first 15 games of the season. Dunivant has started all 15 games for the Quakes, becoming the first San Jose rookie to ever start the first 15 games of his career. Dunivant was named the Earthquakes Los Gatos Brewing Company Player of the Month for April.

Lazio vs. Club America

Legendary Italian side S.S. Lazio will face Club America on Wednesday, July 23 at 8:00 p.m. PT at Spartan Stadium. The match marks the first appearance by Lazio at Spartan Stadium and will be the second appearance in 2003 by Club America in San Jose.

Both teams will bring their full complement of players as they are currently in preseason training for their upcoming league campaigns. Lazio finished fourth last season in Serie A, earning a spot in the 2003-04 Champions League, while Club America is looking to rebound after missing the playoffs last season. Quakes forward Brian Mullan has four goals and five assists on the season, giving him 13 points and placing him in a tie for the seventh-highest point total in MLS. Brian Ching and Landon Donovan are tied for the tenth-highest scoring total with 10 points a piece. Mullan is currently tied for fourth in MLS in assists with five. Donovan and Todd Dunivant are tied with six other players for fourth in MLS in assists with four. Manny Lagos and Ian Russell are tied for second in game-winning assists with two and Donovan is tied for second in the league with two game-winning goals.
