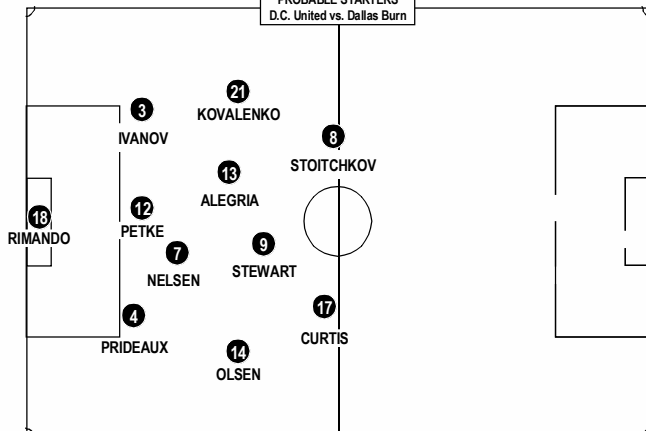

Last Meeting: Frustrated United Gets Burned 3-2

SOUTHLAKE, TX (May 31, 2003) – The Dallas Burn (1-3-3, 6pts) earned their first victory of the season as they held off D.C. United (0-3-4, 4pts) in a 3-2 victory on Saturday night at Dragon Stadium. The Burn are now undefeated in the last seven matches against D.C. United and have outscored them 16-6 in that span. United, who remain winless on the season, have not won on the road against Dallas since Aug. 7, 1998.

"It was a tough game and somebody had to fall tonight," said United head coach Ray Hudson. "We came out with the feeling of frustration. We played good, attractive possession football but we were unlucky from the get go. We were right on the edge but at the end of the night, we we're not good enough. Our next game at home is going to be huge for us."

Dallas converted on an early scoring opportunity in the 16th minute as forward Jason Kreis sent a glancing header past D.C. United goalkeeper Nick Rimando. It was left midfielder Brad Davis who lofted a cross from the left flank and Kreis beat out D.C. defender Brandon Prideaux to the ball. It was Kreis' team-leading fourth goal of the season and it brought him within five goals of the all-time goal-scoring record set by Roy Lassiter (88 goals).

United reacted and had two favorable opportunities to equalize. In the 20th minute the visitors were foiled by Dallas goalkeeper D.J. Countess, who stopped a close-range attempt by D.C. defender Galin Ivanov. Nine minutes later a deflected clearance by Dallas defender Ryan Suarez fell to United forward Alecko Eskandarian in the box but the No. 1 selection of the 2003 SuperDraft was unable to find the target as he sent the ball over the bar from 10 yards out.

While D.C. could not capitalize on its scoring chances, Dallas took advantage of consecutive defensive lapses by its opponents to head into the locker room up 2-0. In the 41st minute Burn forward Bobby Rhine beat the offside trap and ran onto a ball in the box but a charging Rimando deflected his effort for a corner kick. On the ensuing set piece from the left corner taken by Davis, Gbandi was left unmarked at the center of the six-yard box and slotted home past Rimando for his first MLS goal in only his second career start.

D.C. United pulled one back early in the second half as midfielder Bobby Convey scored in the 51st minute on a powerful and accurate left-footed shot. Eskandarian battled for the ball at the top of the Dallas box and poked the ball to an onrushing Convey, who blasted a low shot inside the far right post for his first goal of the season.

After Rimando kept United in the game with a save on a volley by Rhine in the 60th minute, the Burn earned a penalty kick in the 74th minute and converted on the spot kick to extend their lead to 3-1. United midfielder Earnie Stewart was judged to have fouled Dallas midfielder Joselito Vaca just inside the right

side of the United penalty area. Second half substitute Ronald Cerritos stepped up to convert the PK for his first goal of the year.

Down by two goals, United brought on player/coach Hristo Stoitchkov and pushed forward with urgency. On United's best opportunity in the closing stages, Convey saw his right-footed shot saved by Countess, who collected the rebound off the left post before Eskandarian could get a foot on the ball (85th minute). Convey would eventually succeed in reducing the deficit to 3-2 in the 89th minute when he slid onto a Stoitchkov cross and poked the ball past Countess.

United were without the services of veteran Marco Etcheverry (knee) and forward Santino Quaranta (groin) while defender Ryan Nelsen was serving a one-game suspension. The absences forced Head Coach Ray Hudson to field his seventh different starting lineup in seven games.

D.C. will look for its first win of the season next Saturday, June 7 when the club hosts the Chicago Fire in an Eastern Conference battle (7:30PM ET). Dallas will be idle next weekend and returns to action when it plays host to the San Jose Earthquakes on Saturday, June 14 (9:00PM ET).

COLUMBUS, OH (June 28, 2003) – The Columbus Crew defeated visiting D.C. United by a score of 3-0 Saturday night at Columbus Crew Stadium. The Crew's Brian West registered a goal and an assist on the night, as goalkeeper Tom Presthus recorded his first shutout of the 2003 season.

"They wanted it more tonight," said United Head Coach Ray Hudson. "They had their fangs out tonight. Our attitude, however, was terrible defensively. Two bad breakdowns early were too much to overcome. I don't think, as a team, we had the desire. We humiliated ourselves tonight, and Columbus that will make you pay for it. We feel as if we have let each other down. We had a good talk afterward."

Brian West put the Crew up 1-0 early in the first half, hammering home a side volley in the eighth minute of play. Diego Walsh started an upfield rush for the Crew, picking out an overlapping Frankie Hejduk. Hejduk took a crack at goal, but his shot was deflected wide by the United defense. West was in position to capitalize, however, as he hammered the ball out of the air and into the net for his first tally of the season.

Brian McBride doubled the Crew lead in the 25th minute, putting the authoritative finish on West's well-placed cross. Working from the flank, West snapped a quick ball into the penalty area, somehow finding a gap between goalkeeper Nick Rimando and his closest defender. McBride connected with the ball at the far post, blasting a powerful header into the empty net for the insurance goal.

Walsh extended the Crew lead to 3-0 in the 60th minute with his first professional goal. Defender Brian Dunseth played a ball over the top of the United defense to Walsh, who plucked the ball out of the air with an outstretched right leg. On his second touch, Walsh unleashed a rocket of a shot that blazed past Rimando.

Columbus (5-5-3, 18 points) avenges a 3-0 loss to United on June 14th at RFK. The Crew tighten up the Eastern Conference standings, drawing to within three points of Chicago in the top spot. Columbus next hosts the Dallas Burn on Saturday, July 5th at 7:30 PM ET (Fox Sports World).

United (2-4-6, 12 points) sees a four-game unbeaten streak come to a halt with the result, the first loss since dropping the May 31st game to the Burn. United faces the Burn at Dragon Stadium on Wednesday, July 2nd as part of a crowded holiday weekend. D.C. will then face the MetroStars at RFK Stadium on Saturday, live on ESPN2 (4:00 PM ET).

Series History

D.C. United has struggled more against the Dallas Burn than any other team in MLS. The Black-and-Red have particularly struggled in recent years as well as on the road. The last time United picked up three points in Texas was in 1998, as the Burn have won all of the last six meetings between the two sides away from RFK. In the last seven matches between the two sides, United has been outscored 16-6.

When the teams first met this season, United hosted the Burn on May 3rd in a feisty affair that produced some excitement, but no goals. Burn midfielder Ronnie O'Brien suffered a broken leg in a clash with Dema Kovalenko, who was subsequently fined and suspended for the incident. On May 31st United traveled to Dallas and suffered a disappointing 3-2 defeat. This match between Dallas and United will close out the regular season series between these two sides in 2003.

Tying the Record for Ties

United has already registered 6 ties this season, equaling a team high set in 2000 and matched in 2002. With 18 league matches still to go this season, it is highly likely that United will establish a new record for ties this season.

Defense Rules

D.C. United has had one of the strongest defenses in the league this season. Through 12 games, United has only allowed 13 goals. San Jose has also only allowed 13 and only the MetroStars have allowed fewer with 12.

Corner Kick Curse Continues

D.C. United's corner kick curse continues, as the team has now failed to score in 80 attempts, still the highest number in the league. Los Angeles has attempted 79, though the Galaxy have played one more game than D.C.

Inconsistent Line-up

In 12 MLS matches this season, United has fielded 11 different starting line-ups. D.C. is expected to again field a different line-up this week as Bobby Convey will be unavailable because of

caution point accumulation. Marco Etcheverry will also not travel with the team.

Convey, Stewart to Gold Cup

Bobby Convey and Earnie Stewart have been named to the U.S. National Team's roster for the CONCACAF Gold Cup later this month. They will also join the team for a friendly against Paraguay this Sunday in preparation for the tournament.

Still Seeking a Striker?

English forward Jamie Cureton, who recently had a week-long trial with the club, has signed a contract to play in South Korea next year. Uruguayan Silvio Fernandez and Columbian Diego Serna also tried out, though the club has yet to make a decision on either player.

United's Road Woes

D.C. United's road record so far this season is 0-4-2. The Black-and-Red have only scored five goals away from RFK Stadium, while Nick Rimando has allowed 11 to get by him.

Halftime Ties Can't Be Broken

D.C. United has a record of 0-0-6 when the score is tied at halftime. A shortage of second half goals may explain this statistic. Only 4 of the team's 12 goals have come after halftime. Seven have been scored in the last fifteen minutes of the first stanza.

Not the Comeback Kids

United has not been able to come from behind for a victor yet this season. Six times D.C. has given up the first goal, and United has earned a record of 0-4-2 in those games.

Head Coach Ray Hudson

A South Florida soccer legend for more than 20 years, Ray Hudson was named the head coach of D.C. United on January 8, 2002. Hudson joins United from Fusion F.C., where, in his first full year as head coach of the club, he led them to the best regular season record in MLS and to the semifinals of the 2001 MLS Cup.

Hudson was named head coach of the Fusion on May 8, 2000 and instilled an exciting offensive attack that netted more than two goals per game and narrowly missed the playoffs by two points. The team that had just one win in its first eight games of the season before Hudson's hiring, immediately recorded three straight victories on its way to an 11-12-1 mark the remainder of the year. The team also advanced to the 2000 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup final, winning four consecutive contests before falling to the Chicago Fire 2-1 in the Championship game on October 21.

In 2001, Hudson molded Fusion F.C. into a championship contender by bringing in talented players such as Carlos Llamasa, Chris Henderson, Preki, Ian Bishop and Alex Pineda Chacon. The results were new Fusion club records for wins (16), points (53), goals (57), assists (89) and fewest goals allowed (36) in a season that also netted the first division title in club history and the 2001 MLS Supporters Shield.

Known as one of the most quotable personalities in American sports, the colorful Hudson previously served as Fusion F.C.'s television color analyst on Sunshine Network from its inception in 1998 until he took the reigns as head coach. He also worked in the office as the community outreach manager for seven months.

Hudson, 47, brings to United an unparalleled level of passion, grit and determination gained over a long and stellar relationship with the world's most popular sport. As a crafty playmaker, his list of teammates and opponents reads as a "who's who" of soccer history. German World Cup hero Gerd Muller, English goalkeeper Gordon Banks and Peruvian legend "Nene" Cubillas all played with him. The great Brazilian Pele, Dutchman Johan Cruyff and Ireland's George Best battled against the native of Newcastle England.

"Rocky," as he was affectionately known during his playing days, captured the hearts of South Florida sports fans as captain of the Fort Lauderdale Strikers from 1977-84. He was a five-time NASL All-Star midfielder who led the Strikers to the Soccer Bowl in 1980. Former Strikers and Kansas City Wizards head coach Ron Newman said in 1978, "Ray is the finest midfielder in the league. I wouldn't trade him for Franz Beckenbauer or any other midfielder in the NASL."

When the team moved to Minneapolis, Hudson played three years for the club (1984-87) and finished his NASL career with 197 games played, 44 goals and 99 assists (third in NASL history). He then returned to South Florida to play for the Fort Lauderdale Strikers of the APSL (1988-91).

Hudson began his professional career with Newcastle United of the English Premier League in 1973 at the age of 17. He made over 40 appearances for the first division club from 1973-77 before joining the Strikers.

After retiring from soccer in 1992, Hudson stayed active in the sport as director of coaching for the Hollywood Wildcats youth program (1993-97) and coach at University High School at Nova Southeastern (1998) in Davie.

Hudson returned to Lockhart Stadium in 1998 as the Fusion's color commentator on Sunshine Network. As a television analyst, his enthusiasm and knowledge of the game earned him critical praise. *City Link* magazine named him the area's best color analyst, and a CNN/SI web site poll selected him the best analyst in MLS. As the Fusion's community outreach manager, Hudson entertained an average of 20,000 children a month with energetic soccer assemblies at elementary schools and clinics involving local youth teams.
