

Last Meeting: United Yet To Find The Way, Loses 1-0 EAST RUTHERFORD, NJ (May 10, 2003) – EAST RUTHERFORD, N.J. - Clint Mathis's first-half goal led the MetroStars their third consecutive victory, a 1-0 victory against D.C. United on Saturday night at Giants Stadium.

Mathis scored in the 42nd minute to extend the MetroStars (3-1-1) unbeaten string to four matches, while keeping United (0-2-3) searching for their first victory of the season, and extending their streak without scoring to 283 minutes.

"In that first half we were sleepwalking," said United Head Coach Ray Hudson. "We had too many players, who did not want it enough. They did not express themselves with the ball. They were playing too much within themselves. In the second half, we played much better, but we need a forward that is going to be like Clint Mathis. It just takes two seconds for a true marksman to strike."

The only goal of the match came after a nifty exchange between Mark Lisi and Amado Guevara at the top of the penalty area. Guevara chipped a little pass over the United defense and in full stride Mathis took it off his chest and lashed a shot with the outside of his right foot past a diving Nick Rimando. It was the second goal of the season for Mathis, and kept intact the winning streak when he scores for the MetroStars, now 19-0-2.

As the first half went on, the home side gradually began to take control of the match, but couldn't find the final touch to beat Rimando. In short order in the 26th minute, Rimando first saved a terrific flick-on header from Mike Magee on a Guevara free kick, then saved a Richie Williams shot from the resulting corner.

Guevara and Mathis controlled the tempo of the match for MetroStars, who began to be put under pressure in the second half as United coach Ray Hudson made a number of changes - both in personnel and tactics - to try and change his team's fortunes. Bobby Convey forced a good save from Metros 'keeper Tim Howard, then Alecko Eskandarian was also denied by the U.S. international, in United's best chances to break their scoreless string.

Next week, United will return home in search of their first victory in 2003 when they play host to Kansas City Wizards at RFK Stadium at 7:30 p.m. ET (Fox Sports World). The MetroStars will travel to Invesco Field to take on the Colorado Rapids at 4 p.m. EDT (ESPN2).

### Last Match: United Gets First Road Victory

SOUTHLAKE, TX (July 2,2003) – D.C. United won for the first time in nearly five years in Texas, scoring two goals in the final 12 minutes to defeat Dallas Burn in Dragon Stadium on Wednesday, also United's first win on the road in 2003.

"It's a wonderful night, a celebratory night," said United Head Coach Ray Hudson. "We had outstanding individual performances and a very deserved result. The bloodymindedness of our club has been evident since our wake-up call this morning. You could tell that we meant business."

Goals from Dema Kovalenko and Hristo Stoitchkov gave United (3-4-6, 15 pts.) the victory after a Jason Kreis penalty in the second half for the Burn (2-7-3, 9 pts.) canceled out a Ryan Nelsen first-half strike. It was United's first away victory against Dallas Burn since August 7, 1998, a stretch of seven matches in between.

The opening passages were intense, both teams coming off heavy defeats to conference rivals and in desperate need of three points, with just four victories in 23 games between the two. But United had more of the ball in the first half and kept Dallas pinned into their own for long periods.

Ben Olsen had the first clear chance on 17 minutes, his diving header forcing D.J. Countess to just tip the ball around his right post. But just when it seemed the Burn might hang on, United took the lead just before the half-hour.

Ali Curtis rounded Ryan Suarez at the byeline, and drove a low ball into the mixer, where Countess, Olsen and defender Shavar Thomas all converged. But the ball squirted through to the back post where Nelsen came running on to tap in from almost on the goal line.

Countess was again tested in the 38th minute, Jose Alegria shooting on the run from well outside the area, the Dallas 'keeper palming it wide at full stretch.

But in the second half, Dallas came out with the upper hand, and created two good opportunities in the first five minutes. First Ronald Cerritos brought out a great save by a diving Rimando, then the United 'keeper blocked a Jason Kreis shot with his legs after he slipped through the D.C. defense.

The Burn then leveled terms in the 74th minute, but not after some controversy. Brandon Prideaux and Kreis tangled in the area, first as Kreis tried to reach a long ball, then continuing as the play went on. After some seconds, referee Jair Marrufo whistled the foul and awarded the penalty.

Kreis just slipped it under Rimando's dive, his seventh goal of the season and the 86th of his league career, now two behind the all-time MLS record held by Roy Lassiter.

But United re-took the lead just four minutes later on a wonderful goal. Curtis held up a long ball, picking out Olsen racing down the left. He pulled back a low cross from the corner which Kovalenko came in to strike first-time, sidefooting home inside the far post.

Then in the dying minutes, Stoitchkov put the match away with a stunning free kick from nearly 40 yards, ripping a drive that Countess could only push against the inside of the post and to the back of the net.

#### **Series History**

D.C. United has a winning record overall against the MetroStars thanks to a solid home record. The Black-and-Red are 9-5-0 against the MetroStars in RFK Stadium and 7-7-1 away from RFK.

United has played the MetroStars once so far during the 2003 season. That match was on May 10<sup>th</sup> and the MetroStars won by a 1-0 score on a goal from Clint Mathis. In 2002's Atlantic Cup series, United captured the cup after winning three of the four meetings between the two sides.

The final two matches of the 2003 season series will come at the end of September in a home and home series. The first of those two matches will be away on Thursday, September 25<sup>th</sup>, while the second will be the following Sunday, September 28<sup>th</sup> at RFK Stadium.

The All-Time leader for United in points (41) and goals (17) is Jaime Moreno, now with the MetroStars after being traded in the off-season.

### **Atlantic Cup Clash**

The Atlantic Cup is once again on the line as D.C. United faces the MetroStars this Saturday at RFK Stadium. The MetroStars defeated United in the first game, played at Giants Stadium, providing them a 3-0 lead in standings points gained in head-to-head play and have a 1-0 lead in aggregate goals (first tie-breaker).

Though the rivalry between the opposing sides has been intense since the beginning of Major League Soccer in 1996, the series took on greater meaning with last season's creation of the Atlantic Cup.

D.C. United topped the MetroStars to earn last year's inaugural Atlantic Cup. During the 2002 season, United and the MetroStars played the final two games of the series in a 48 hour span in mid-September. The Black-and-Red won both matches in route to a 9-3 aggregate standing point total in the head-to-head season series.

With both teams trying to breakout out of an Eastern Conference logjam this season, fans of both sides should expect nothing less than the same exciting action that they've seen the previous seven seasons. For a second season, the series winner will earn more than just pride, they'll get to take home the Atlantic Cup.

#### Tying the Record for Ties

United has already registered 6 ties this season, equaling a team high set in 2000 and matched in 2002. With 17 league matches still to go this season, it is highly likely that United will establish a new record for ties this season.

### **Defense Rules**

D.C. United has had one of the strongest defenses in the league this season. Through 13 games, United has only allowed 14 goals, fewer than any other team in the league. United's goals against average is 0.93. Los Angeles has only given up 15 goals, though they have played one more game than United. The MetroStars have given up 16 goals in 13 games for third place in MLS.

#### **Corner Kick Curse Continues**

D.C. United's corner kick curse continues, as the team has now failed to score in 84 attempts, still the highest number in the league. San Jose has attempted 80, and L.A. has attempted 79,

but the Galaxy have played one more game than both United and San Jose. The MetroStars have taken only 64 corner kicks.

### **Inconsistent Line-up**

United has started with the same line-up in two consecutive games only once so far this season: 6/14 vs. Columbus and 6/21 vs. New England. D.C. is expected to again field a different line-up this weekend as Bobby Convey and Earnie Stewart will be unavailable because of national team call-ups. Nick Rimando and Ben Olsen are the only United players to have started in all 13 of United's league matches so far this season.

## Still Seeking a Striker?

English forward Jamie Cureton, who recently had a week-long trial with the club, has signed a contract to play in South Korea next year. Uruguayan Silvio Fernandez and Colombian Diego Serna also tried out, though the club has yet to make a decision on either player. Should Serna attempt to return to MLS, the New England Revolution, his last MLS club, would have the first opportunity to sign him.

### **Home Sweet Home**

Though D.C. United has struggled on the road this season, they have been strong at home in RFK Stadium. The Black-and-Red are undefeated on home soil with a record of 2-0-4. United has scored seven goals at home and has only given up two. Chicago and Los Angeles are the only other teams that are unbeaten at home this season.

#### Halftime Ties Can't Be Broken

D.C. United has a record of 0-0-6 when the score is tied at halftime. Also, United has not been able to come from behind for a victor yet this season. Six times D.C. has given up the first goal, and United has earned a record of 0-4-2 in those games.

## **Head Coach Ray Hudson**

A South Florida soccer legend for more than 20 years, Ray Hudson was named the head coach of D.C. United on January 8, 2002. Hudson joins United from Fusion F.C., where, in his first full year as head coach of the club, he led them to the best regular season record in MLS and to the semifinals of the 2001 MLS Cup.

Hudson was named head coach of the Fusion on May 8, 2000 and instilled an exciting offensive attack that netted more than two goals per game and narrowly missed the playoffs by two points. The team that had just one win in its first eight games of the season before Hudson's hiring, immediately recorded three straight victories on its way to an 11-12-1 mark the remainder of the year. The team also advanced to the 2000 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup final, winning four consecutive contests before falling to the Chicago Fire 2-1 in the Championship game on October 21.

In 2001, Hudson molded Fusion F.C. into a championship contender by bringing in talented players such as Carlos Llamosa, Chris Henderson, Preki, Ian Bishop and Alex Pineda Chacon. The results were new Fusion club records for wins (16), points (53), goals (57), assists (89) and fewest goals allowed (36) in a season that also netted the first division title in club history and the 2001 MLS Supporters Shield.

Known as one of the most quotable personalities in American sports, the colorful Hudson previously served as Fusion F.C.'s television color analyst on Sunshine Network from its inception in 1998 until he took the reigns as head coach. He also worked in the office as the community outreach manager for seven months.

Hudson, 47, brings to United an unparalleled level of passion, grit and determination gained over a long and stellar relationship with the world's most popular sport. As a crafty playmaker, his list of teammates and opponents reads as a "who's who" of soccer history. German World Cup hero Gerd Muller, English goalkeeper Gordon Banks and Peruvian legend "Nene" Cubillas all played with him. The great Brazilian Pele, Dutchman Johan Cruyff and Ireland's George Best battled against the native of Newcastle England.

"Rocky," as he was affectionately known during his playing days, captured the hearts of South Florida sports fans as captain of the Fort Lauderdale Strikers from 1977-84. He was a five-time NASL All-Star midfielder who led the Strikers to the Soccer Bowl in 1980. Former Strikers and Kansas City Wizards head coach Ron Newman said in 1978, "Ray is the finest midfielder in the league. I wouldn't trade him for Franz Beckenbauer or any other midfielder in the NASL."

When the team moved to Minneapolis, Hudson played three years for the club (1984-87) and finished his NASL career with 197 games played, 44 goals and 99 assists (third in NASL history). He then returned to South Florida to play for the Fort Lauderdale Strikers of the APSL (1988-91).

Hudson began his professional career with Newcastle United of the English Premier League in 1973 at the age of 17. He made over 40 appearances for the first division club from 1973-77 before joining the Strikers.

After retiring from soccer in 1992, Hudson stayed active in the sport as director of coaching for the Hollywood Wildcats youth program (1993-97) and coach at University High School at Nova Southeastern (1998) in Davie.

Hudson returned to Lockhart Stadium in 1998 as the Fusion's color commentator on Sunshine Network. As a television analyst, his enthusiasm and knowledge of the game earned him critical praise. *City Link* magazine named him the area's best color analyst, and a CNN/SI web site poll selected him the best analyst in MLS. As the Fusion's community outreach manager, Hudson entertained an average of 20,000 children a month with energetic soccer assemblies at elementary schools and clinics involving local youth teams.
