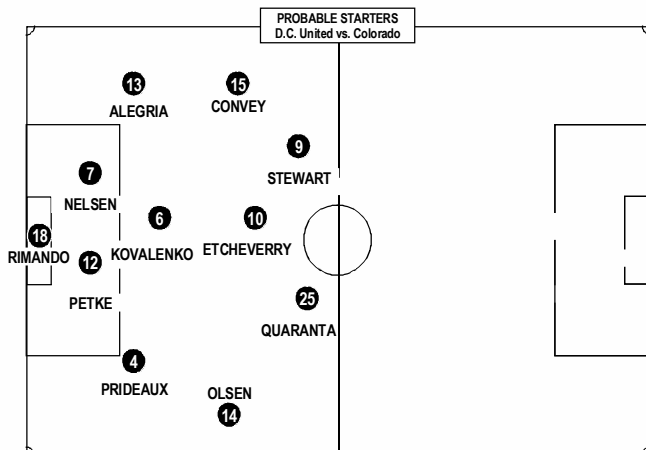

Last Meeting: D.C. United Downs Colorado, 2-0

WASHINGTON, DC (June 19, 2002) –D.C. United just might have found the player that will solve its problem with depth at the forward position, and strangely enough it happens to be defender Ryan Nelsen. The New Zealand defender’s goal in the 17th minute proved to be all United would need as the Black-and-Red coasted to a 2-0 victory in front of 11,086 fans at RFK Stadium.

Earlier in the week, United Head Coach Ray Hudson continued say that he has yet to see an effort from his team that he has been pleased with. Despite continuing that sentiment after the match, Hudson did express joy over the effort his side gave in front of the home crowd.

“It was close to the most complimentary performance we’ve put together this year in that there were players that really twinkled tonight,” said Hudson, “We got support from all over the field. It’s hard for me to pick one particular player out as the standard player that wholly affected the game tonight. Am I happy? No, I’m still not happy. I still think we’re short, but it’s a good night.”

United’s possession attack once again thrived at home, as the Black-and-Red were able to create chance after chance from the start of the match. Colorado goalkeeper Scott Garlick had a busy night, with his first save coming in the seventh minute. United midfielders Petter Villegas and Bobby Convey executed a perfect give-and-go on the right side of the penalty area, but Garlick was able to stop Villegas’s shot from nine yards out.

Ten minutes later, Garlick was not as fortunate as Nelsen was able to give United a quick 1-0 advantage. Colorado captain Robin Fraser attempted to head a ball out of danger, but instead popped the attempt up towards the top of the penalty area. Nelsen showed no hesitation as he cracked a perfect right-footed volley from 17 yards past a helpless Garlick to give United a lead they would never relinquish.

“What a great goal. That wasn’t a defender’s goal, either,” proclaimed Hudson.” It was a dynamite, assassin’s goal. He hit it plum right down the alley.”

Five minutes later, Nick Rimando came up big to keep the score where it was. Rapids forward Chris Carrieri managed to find space on the left flank and skipped a low cross through the penalty area. Rimando darted off the line and dove to collect the cross before it was received by a waiting Chris Henderson. The Black-and-Red had plenty of chances to stretch the lead before the break, but Garlick was able to tip a 30-yard Villegas blast wide right of the net in the 24th minute. In the 37th minute, Convey executed two pull-back fakes at the top of the box to beat a pair of defenders, but his shot, destined for the lower right corner, was stopped by Garlick. One minute from half, Convey once again created havoc inside the box, deflecting a Marco Etcheverry cross just wide of target.

The half was dominated by United, as the Black-and-Red forced Garlick to make five saves to only one for Rimando. Etcheverry also had a busy half, as the United captain took nine corner kicks and numerous free kicks in the Colorado offensive

third. The Rapids managed only four shots in the half and created no corner kick opportunities.

The half changed, but the run of play did not as United’s defense continued to shut down the Rapids midfield and keep possession at will. In the 55th minute, Ali Curtis darted behind the defense to create a one-on-one versus Garlick. Curtis dribbled left to get around Garlick, but the move allowed Robin Fraser to cover back and deflect Curtis’ chip shot from eight yards out over the end line. The biggest roar of the night might have come in the 63rd minute, when former United member Roy Lassiter made his return to the RFK pitch in a Black-and-Red kit, subbing into the match for Ali Curtis. Lassiter would later find his way into the books, but not in the fashion he wanted, after picking up a yellow card in the game’s 80th minute.

Jaime Moreno doubled United’s lead on a penalty kick in the 72nd minute. Moreno created the PK opportunity by being taken down by Garlick on the left side of the Colorado penalty area. Garlick guessed right, but Moreno struck a confident shot Garlick’s left, giving United an insurmountable 2-0 lead. The goal was Moreno’s third of the season, giving him a share of the team lead in the category with Nelsen and forward Santino Quaranta.

United’s defense gave up only three shots on goal and allowed Rimando to remain mostly untested until a late rush by the Rapids. United became only the second team this season to hold Colorado scoreless and gave Rimando his second clean sheet of the season.

The win moves United to within one game of the .500 mark for the fourth time this season (after a 1-1-0 start to the campaign). The Black-and-Red’s record improves to 5-6-1, good for 16 points and third place in a crowded Eastern Conference, just one point behind Chicago and two points behind first place Columbus. Colorado appears headed in the other direction, with tonight’s loss moving their losing streak to three matches and their record to 6-6-1. United’s next action comes this Sunday at 4:00 p.m., when they square off in an international club friendly against legendary Argentine side Boca Juniors at RFK Stadium. United’s next MLS match will be on June 29th, when they host the Los Angeles Galaxy.

Last Match: United And Fire Shoot Blanks

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The last two matchups between the Chicago Fire and D.C. United resulted in scoreless ties and their matchup on Saturday night at RFK Stadium produced the same result - the first 0-0 result in MLS in 2003. The Fire (0-0-2) registered their second consecutive tie to start the campaign while D.C. United (0-1-1) picked up their first point of 2003.

"It's strange to know how to feel after a game like that," said United Head Coach Ray Hudson. "We couldn't find a way through or behind them. They put up a hell of a wall for us to get through. It's a lesson for us, but we needed a bit of magic. I credit our team to sticking to the task."

Fire goalkeeper Zach Thornton registered the 37th shutout of his career, which moves him into a tie for second all-time (tied with the Los Angeles Galaxy's Kevin Hartman) and seven behind Kansas City Wizards' keeper Tony Meola (44). It was the 15th career shutout for D.C. United's Nick Rimando, who was making his 77th regular season appearance.

The teams were deadlocked in the middle of the field and created few scoring opportunities. The match was a physical one on both ends with players remaining on the ground for extended periods after harsh challenges. In one instance D.C. United rookie Alecko Eskandarian, who was making his MLS debut, was knocked out of the match after a head-on-head challenge only 15 minutes after coming into the game in the second half.

In the first half D.C. United controlled the pace of the game with midfield veteran Marco Etcheverry leading United's

attack and firing wide left on a cross from Bobby Convey from the left. The home team's best scoring chance came on a play which was whistled for offside in the second half. Ryan Nelsen's cross from the left was met by an Etcheverry header which finished in the back of the net but a previous offside position by forward Eliseo Quintanilla cancelled the play. Fire midfielder Chris Armas had a breakaway opportunity late in the first half but his finish from 10 yards out went wide right of the goal.

The deadlock persisted in overtime when the only real threat coming off a 25-yard blast by United's Jose Alegria which proved difficult to handle for Thornton.

The two teams return to MLS action next Saturday, April 26, as D.C. United travels to Invesco Field to meet a rested Colorado Rapids team at 9:00 PM ET (HDNet). Chicago also hits the road to face the Kansas City Wizards at Arrowhead Stadium at 7:30 p.m. ET (FOX Sports World).

Series History: United Leads, 9-5-2

D.C. United has an impressive record against the Rapids, both at home and on the road. United is 4-2-2 against the Rapids at RFK Stadium, and is 5-3-0 in Colorado. This is the first of three meetings between the two sides this season, with the second being held in Colorado on June 11th and the final match-up taking place at RFK on August 13th. The sides split the two-game series last year, with the home team winning 2-0 both times.

United's largest margin of victory over the Rapids came on June 7, 1997 when the Black-and-Red thrashed the Rapids 5-0 at RFK. Colorado's best victories over United carried 3-1 score lines. Those games were June 25, 1998 and July 4, 2001.

Quick Restarts

In the all-time series history between these two sides, D.C. United has scored nine goals in the opening 15 minutes of the second half all time against the Rapids. Colorado has only managed two in that same time span.

On the Rebound?

D.C. United's last three matches against the Chicago Fire have ended scoreless. The two teams finished their 2002 season series with a pair of 0-0 stalemates in Naperville, IL. The two teams played to a third consecutive scoreless draw last week at RFK Stadium. United and the Fire also played a scoreless 90-minute scrimmage during a pre-season exhibition this spring in Florida.

Dazed and Confused

United forward Alecko Eskandarian will miss the Colorado match while he recovers from a concussion sustained last

weekend against Chicago. Eskandarian and United teammate Bobby Convey collided while trying to get to the end of a crossing pass. Eskandarian flipped in the air and slammed to the ground, landing on his head and neck. He also broke his left middle finger on the play.

Share and Share Alike

Defender David Stokes is currently on loan to the Hampton Roads Mariners. The P-40 product from the University of North Carolina made his debut with the A-League side in a 2-0 exhibition victory over Old Dominion University. United officials are hoping to see their defender move between the two clubs throughout the season to speed the transition to the pro game for the Dumfries, VA native.

On the Road Again

United will be looking to improve upon their dreary road record this weekend in Colorado. Despite one of the better home records in MLS last season, United managed a meager 1-10-3 mark away from the friendly confines of RFK Stadium. The Black-and-Red fell in overtime in Kansas City in the first road match of the 2003 campaign.

Who's on First?

Due to injuries and tactical changes, United boss Ray Hudson has fielded a different First XI in United's first two matches of the season. That trend is likely to continue this weekend as Brandon Prideaux has returned to help bolster the back line and Hudson seems likely to tap a more defensive-minded Jose Alegria in place of forward-thinking Eliseo Quintanilla.

Head Coach Ray Hudson

A South Florida soccer legend for more than 20 years, Ray Hudson was named the head coach of D.C. United on January 8, 2002. Hudson joins United from Fusion F.C., where, in his first full year as head coach of the club, he led them to the best regular season record in MLS and to the semifinals of the 2001 MLS Cup.

Hudson was named head coach of the Fusion on May 8, 2000 and instilled an exciting offensive attack that netted more than two goals per game and narrowly missed the playoffs by two points. The team that had just one win in its first eight games of the season before Hudson's hiring, immediately recorded three straight victories on its way to an 11-12-1 mark the remainder of the year. The team also advanced to the 2000 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup final, winning four consecutive contests before falling to the Chicago Fire 2-1 in the Championship game on October 21.

In 2001, Hudson molded Fusion F.C. into a championship contender by bringing in talented players such as Carlos Llamasa, Chris Henderson, Preki, Ian Bishop and Alex Pineda Chacon. The results were new Fusion club records for wins (16), points (53), goals (57), assists (89) and fewest goals allowed (36) in a season that also netted the first division title in club history and the 2001 MLS Supporters Shield.

Known as one of the most quotable personalities in American sports, the colorful Hudson previously served as Fusion F.C.'s television color analyst on Sunshine Network from its inception in 1998 until he took the reigns as head coach. He also worked in the office as the community outreach manager for seven months.

Hudson, 47, brings to United an unparalleled level of passion, grit and determination gained over a long and stellar relationship with the world's most popular sport. As a crafty playmaker, his list of teammates and opponents reads as a "who's who" of soccer history. German World Cup hero Gerd Muller, English goalkeeper Gordon Banks and Peruvian legend "Nene" Cubillas all played with him. The great Brazilian Pele, Dutchman Johan Cruyff and Ireland's George Best battled against the native of Newcastle England.

"Rocky," as he was affectionately known during his playing days, captured the hearts of South Florida sports fans as captain of the Fort Lauderdale Strikers from 1977-84. He was a five-time NASL All-Star midfielder who led the Strikers to the Soccer Bowl in 1980. Former Strikers and Kansas City Wizards head coach Ron Newman said in 1978, "Ray is the finest midfielder in the league. I wouldn't trade him for Franz Beckenbauer or any other midfielder in the NASL."

When the team moved to Minneapolis, Hudson played three years for the club (1984-87) and finished his NASL career with 197 games played, 44 goals and 99 assists (third in NASL history). He then returned to South Florida to play for the Fort Lauderdale Strikers of the APSL (1988-91).

Hudson began his professional career with Newcastle United of the English Premier League in 1973 at the age of 17. He made over 40 appearances for the first division club from 1973-77 before joining the Strikers.

After retiring from soccer in 1992, Hudson stayed active in the sport as director of coaching for the Hollywood Wildcats youth program (1993-97) and coach at University High School at Nova Southeastern (1998) in Davie.

Hudson returned to Lockhart Stadium in 1998 as the Fusion's color commentator on Sunshine Network. As a television analyst, his enthusiasm and knowledge of the game earned him critical praise. *City Link* magazine named him the area's best color analyst, and a CNN/SI web site poll selected him the best analyst in MLS. As the Fusion's community outreach manager, Hudson entertained an average of 20,000 children a month with energetic soccer assemblies at elementary schools and clinics involving local youth teams.

A 2003 SuperDraft pick, Doug Warren was a standout goalkeeper at Clemson University where he earned NSCAA All-American first team honors and posted a 1.33 goals against average. Has not yet made an appearance during the 2003 season.

2 **David Stokes** D Ht: 6'3" Wt: 203 Dob: 5.28.82

A hard-working defender was selected fifth overall in the 2003 MLS SuperDraft. Stokes was one of the top defenders at the University of North Carolina. He saw action with the U.S. U-23 National Team in 2002. Has not yet made an appearance during the 2003 season.

3 **Galin Ivanov** D Ht: 6'1" Wt: 170 Dob: 6.4.75

The Bulgarian international is a very talented defender who spent the past six years with CSKA Sofia in his native land. One of the game's most astute defenders, Ivanov's presence in the D.C. United back line will be a key element in the team's success in 2003. Has not yet made an appearance during the 2003 season due to an abdominal injury.

4 **Brandon Prideaux** D Ht: 6'0" Wt: 170 Dob: 8.18.76

Prideaux returns for his second season at D.C. United after playing three seasons with the Kansas City Wizards. Prideaux is a strong defender who will be called upon to mark some of the toughest opposition that MLS has to offer.
