

INTER MIAMI CF TO HOST CHICAGO FIRE FOR FIRST FULL CAPACITY HOME OPENER

Inter Miami enters its third MLS campaign following a busy offseason, including 14 new players joining the First Team as well as key personnel changes. Following careful player identification methodology to make a number of important signings, Inter Miami has acquired DeAndre Yedlin, a 28-year-old U.S. Men's National Team defender and former MLS All-Star returning to the league, Jean Mota, a 28-year-old midfielder with more than 250 matches under his belt at South American powerhouse club Santos FC. The team has also added Christopher McVey, a versatile defender with experience in European competition and Damion Lowe, a Jamaican international captain, as well as Emerson Rodríguez, a Colombian U22 Initiative signing, and Leonardo Campana, a young Ecuadorian international coming from the English Premier League, and Robert Taylor, a Finnish national team attacker. A trio of in-prime players with notable MLS experience - Mo Adams, Ariel Lassiter and Clément Diop - have also joined the club ahead of the 2022 season. Young talents George Acosta, CJ dos Santos, Bryce Duke, Aimé Mabika and the integration of standout young international center back Jairo Quinteros wrap up the offseason signings to date.

A number of standouts will return in 2022, including leading scorer Gonzalo Higuaín, midfield stalwart and team captain Gregore, starting goalkeeper Nick Marsman, versatile midfielder and 2021 MLS Humanitarian of the Year nominee Victor Ulloa, and the veteran left back trio of Kieran Gibbs, Brek Shea and Joevin Jones.

Inter Miami enters the match following an intense preseason in which the team played seven total games, including the club's first-ever international friendly at DRV PNK Stadium in a 4-0 win over Club Universitario de Deportes, three closed-door matches against MLS opposition in South Florida, and a week in Charleston, South Carolina for the Breeze Airways Carolina Challenge Cup - where the squad won the title.

The exciting 2022 squad will be sporting the new Heartbeat Kit on Saturday, the club's primary jersey for the 2022 and 2023 seasons. The jersey was inspired and designed for the fans, including an M-shaped EKG line embossed into the fabric of the cuff to represent the fans, who are the heartbeat of the club. Fans can purchase the new jersey on MLSStore.com and at the DRV PNK Stadium team store on matchday.

Familiar Faces

The match may feature reunions between former teammates or known rivals for several Inter Miami and Chicago Fire players. Defenders Yedlin and Kieran Gibbs may face Swiss rival Xherdan Shaqiri. Yedlin faced Shaqiri multiple times in the Premier League between 2015 and 2020 during his stints with Sunderland AFC and Newcastle United. Gibbs also faced Shaqiri in previous Premier League matches during his time with West Bromwich Albion.

Additionally, defender/midfielder Brek Shea may face former teammate Spencer Richey. The duo played together for the Vancouver Whitecaps in 2017. Yedlin may face Jonathan Bornstein after facing him in the 2013 CONCACAF Champions League quarterfinals during his tenure with the Seattle Sounders.

Chicago Fire in 2022

The Chicago Fire will enter this weekend's season opener after an offseason that saw them add Shaqiri as a Designated Player and striker Kacper Przybylko. The team is also coming off of a 1-0 win over Austin FC in its most recent preseason friendly. Inter Miami looks to open the season with a win and continue its positive streak against Chicago after defeating the Fire 3-2 at home on Aug. 18, 2021. This will be the third time in club history the two teams meet on the pitch.

Forward Adam Buksa, who has registered 16 goals and three assists, has led the side this campaign.

"The pleasing thing at the end was how all the players had a massive big smile on their faces and the enjoyment they had of winning together and being together all week which is pleasing, that's the most important thing. We got all the team together, that's headed in the right direction and know where they want to go and they know they've got improvements to do but you know it was a nice week." - Phil Neville

"I think we have a board room on the training grounds that's got a trophy cabinet that is empty at this moment in time so this is the first trophy that we are going to really enjoy putting in it. We have meetings in it every single day and it's something that we talk about a lot. It's something that the ownership all the way through the week, Jorge [Mas]... rung me up on Tuesday and said let's bring this trophy home. That's what a winning mentality does, winning breeds confidence and even though it's a preseason tournament I think it's a little baby step forward for us in terms of positivity. "I think this year going into the season where everybody's got major minutes, we've played MLS sides, we've played sides from the USL championship, which has been a really good experience for us and obviously we played the Peruvian side. MATCH RECAP: INTER MIAMI CF CLAIMS BREEZE AIRWAYS CAROLINA CHALLENGE CUP TITLE WITH 2-1 VICTORY OVER CHARLOTTE FC

Inter Miami CF (0W-0D-0L, 0 points) Inter Miami CF earned its first trophy tonight, winning the Breeze Airways Carolina Challenge Cup with a 2-1 victory over Charlotte FC in the final match of the tournament. The team was led to the final result by goals from the starting forward combination of Leonardo Campana and Gonzalo Higuaín, with assists from the starting wingback duo of DeAndre Yedlin and Academy product Noah Allen. Inter Miami concluded the tournament with two wins and one draw to earn the title in its last preseason test ahead of its highly-anticipated 2022 MLS campaign.

Inter Miami lined up for the match with a strong starting XI for the final preseason match before the team's home opener. Clément Diop started in goal; Yedlin, Jairo Quinteros, Damion Lowe, Christopher McVey and Allen formed the team's defense; Jean Mota, Gregore and George Acosta started in midfield; Campana and Higuaín led the attack. The team also honored defender Ian Fray before the game, who suffered a season-ending injury this week, holding up his jersey for the pregame lineup picture.

In the 25th minute, Inter Miami found its breakthrough goal. Yedlin beat his defender down the right wing and played a low cross into Campana, whose first-time shot hit the near post. The forward then latched onto the deflection and slotted his second effort into the back of the net for his first goal in Inter Miami colors and the 1-0 lead.

The second half offered much of the same, with Inter Miami doubling its lead in the 50th minute. A great team buildup saw Mota play a long switch to Allen on the left side of the box, who cut a pass back to Higuaín at the top of the box; the Argentine then met the pass in stride and struck a left-footed shot inside the near post and past the keeper for a 2-0 lead.

Higuaín's goal proved to be the winner as Charlotte scored one of their own in stoppage time. The referee pointed to the spot for a penalty, and former Inter Miami defender Christian Makoun stepped up and scored the penalty in the 92nd minute to make it 2-1. The scoreline, however, held from there, resulting in a trophy for Inter Miami.

The match concluded an intense preseason for the team with seven total games, including the first-ever international friendly for the team at DRV PNK Stadium (a 4-0 win over Club Universitario de Deportes), and a week in Charleston, South Carolina for the Breeze Airways Carolina Challenge Cup.

"I'm really pleased with the preseason work that we've done. We still got an awful lot of work to do. We are still building every single day...The pleasing thing at the end was how all the players had a massive big smile on their faces and the enjoyment they had of winning together," said head coach Phil Neville. "Winning breeds confidence and even though it's a preseason tournament, I think it's a little baby step forward for us in terms of positivity."

Inter Miami will now head into the MLS regular season with a trophy in hand, beginning with the team's highly anticipated 2022 home opener. The new season will kick off at DRV PNK Stadium next Saturday, Feb. 26 at 6 p.m. ET when Inter Miami takes on Chicago Fire FC.




