 Dynamo FC at BBVA Stadium on Saturday evening. Michael Barrios netted his fifth goal of the season
 for the game-winner.
- The teams met once a season ago. **Cole Bassett** and **Jonathan Lewis** scored on either side of halftime as the Rapids took a 2-0 win Sept. 19 Dignity Health Sports Park.
- The Rapids have come away with points in the last five meetings between the teams, with four victories, including three in a row. The Rapids' victory in the first meeting in 2018, a 2-1 win on Aug. 4 at Dick's Sporting Goods Park, snapped a four-game winless streak, and two-game losing streak, in league play in the series, their first vs. the Galaxy since March 12, 2016.
- The Rapids have won the last two meetings in Carson, snapping a six-game Galaxy undefeated streak there in the series, with two wins and four draws over the span. It was the first Rapids win there since Sept. 7, 2013, a 1-0 victory.

<u>GALAXY:</u> Jonathan Klinsmann was credited with six saves in recording the shutout in his first start of 2021, the second shutout of his MLS career in five starts. ... **Dejan Joveljic** recorded an assist, making his MLS and Galaxy debut, starting and playing 57 minutes in a forward role.

<u>RAPIDS:</u> Braian Galván scored his second goal of the season, both coming in the last seven games. ... Lalas Abubakar scored his second goal of the year, both coming in the last five games. ... Jack Price recorded his sixth assist of the season, his second in the last five games. ... Mark-Anthony Kaye collected an assist, his first since coming to the Rapids via trade from LAFC.

Each team has won on the road in the last two meetings, MNUFC taking a 5-2 win in San Jose in 2019. The Quakes had won the first four meetings between the teams over the previous two seasons, with a pair of wins in both San Jose and Minneapolis.
